

Critics slams selective Storm aid

MANILA- THE United Nationalist Alliance denounced the Aquino administration for not extending relief to towns damaged by Typhoon "Lando" where mayors did not belong to or were not allied with the ruling Liberal Party.

"The reports we are receiving are lamentable. The mayor of San Miguel, Bulacan himself told us that the [Department of Social Welfare and Development] did not give them any help for those affected by Typhoon Lando," said UNA spokesman Mon Ilagan.

"Even the citizens of Baler and the towns of Cabiao and Bongabon in Nueva Ecija were also not given any help because their mayors are members of parties not allied with the administration," he added. "Is this how things should be done? Selective relief? If you are not an ally, you don't get government aid?"

San Miguel Mayor Roderick Tiongson, who ran under the Liberal Party in 2013, is now vying for the governorship of Bulacan under UNA. Baler Mayor Nelianto Bihasa belongs to PDP-Laban.

"This is Yolanda all over again.
Politics has sadly reared its ugly head in times of distress. We are certain that the situation would be different if the mayors are part of the LP," Ilagan said.



Despite an internal PIDC audit that showed PIDC in fact owed Enverga from the pageants in question, Neri had not issued an apology.

Neri's statements became the fodder for a string of derogatory news reports and commentaries written by Romeo

Marquez about Enverga which were published in Balita.

Balita's editor and publisher, Teresita Cusipag, manages a competing beauty pageant, Miss Manila, and is a rival of Rosemer Enverga in the beauty pageant business.

Marquez testified as a witness for Neri.

After Marquez's testimony, Neri's lawyer summed up Neri's defense and argued that it was not Neri's statements that were defamatory but the subsequent writings of Marquez and that Enverga failed to include or did not have the proper defendants in her

In his decision, Judge Chris Ashby found that Neri had failed to establish the defences of truth, fair comment or responsible communication.

On the defence of truth, Judge Ashby ruled that there was no basis for suggesting that Enverga had failed to report as required, alluding to Neri's own testimony that it was the Treasurer's responsibility to make financial reporting to the board and to the fact that Enverga had no control over PIDC's bank account.

On the defence of fair comment, the judge ruled that Neri's statements were not comments but statements of facts which were not true, therefore, that defence failed.

On the defence of responsible

communication on a matter of public interest, Judge Ashby cited the Supreme Court ruling in Grant v. Torstar Corp: "The publication must be on a matter of public interest and the defendant must show that the words published were responsible in that she was diligent in trying to verify the allegations". The judge ruled that Neri was not diligent in verifying that it was the fault of the plaintiff, knowing the PIDC structure and knowing that the Treasurer was responsible for providing financial information.

The judge wrote:

..."Her good reputation is presumed. She is well known in the particular community that she lives and works in....There was no apology even though a Libel Notice was served.... the plaintiff did hold her own press conference. Part of the harm has been created by some shocking articles in Filipino press that are not related to the actions of the defendant."

"I am relieved" says Enverga. "The last 3 years has been very stressful, having been constantly subjected to public ridicule by a certain tabloid as a result of reckless statements made against me by Neri", she added.

Balita, Teresita Cusipag and Romeo Marquez are defendants in libel lawsuits filed in Ontario Superior Court by Oswald Magno, Voltaire de Leon, Jeff Rustia, Melinda Rustia, Tobias Enverga Jr., Philippines Canada Fashion Week and The Kol Hope Foundation seeking damages in the millions.

How do you solve Metro Manila traffic?

YOU DON'T BY EFREN PADILLA



MANILA - A Filipino overseas who specializes in urban planning says 'no amount of urban revitalization or urban renewal can remedy the unsustainable and cancerous growth of our leading primate city'

Let's be realistic. There is nothing that anyone can do to solve the traffic woes of Metro Manila, even with the ingenuity and hard work of the MMDA chairman.

Here's why:

With its current population of more than 12 million that swells to about 15 million during the daytime, Metro Manila is the undisputed primate city in the country whose close competitors such as Metro Cebu (2.5 million) or Metro Davao (2.2 million) pale in comparison in terms of population size. (READ: Can the police fix EDSA traf-

According to the World Bank report, Metro Manila currently houses 56 percent of the total urban land development and more than 70 percent of the total urban population of the country. Worse, three of its 16 cities – Manila's 42,857 people/sq km; Pateros' 30,456 people/ sq km; and Caloocan's 27,916 population/sq km – rank as the top three most densest cities in the world respectively dwarfing Mumbai's 23,000 people/sq km; Paris' 20,150 people/sq km; or Toyko's 10,100 people/sq km. (READ: Our collective guilt over Metro Manila traffic)

Now tell me, how do you manage that?

The incidence of thousands of commuters and motorists spending long hours stuck in a traffic jam especially after torrential rains and consequent flooding is a given. We should not have the illusion that our existing and ongoing efforts will ameliorate our traffic problem once and for all. Our state of urban affairs is like what the legendary Yogi Berra used to quip. "It's déjà vu all over again." By now, we should already have learned our lesson that no amount of urban revitalization or urban renewal can remedy the unsustainable and cancerous growth of our leading primate city. Short of wiping out the entire metro area and starting from scratch, there is no other way but to find the solution for its problem somewhere else. That is, the key to solving its overdevelopment is the development of other provinces.

I share the frustration of MMDA chief Francisco Tolentino because he bears the flak despite his best efforts to solve a problem that requires a different solution. I think the undue criticism is not only unfair but also misdirected. And yet, I thought he was quite intuitive and on the right track when he intimated a political solution to depopulating Metro Manila via the creation of well-planned urban centers in central, northern and southern Luzon, Visayas and Mindanao.

I say political solution because the master planning, engineering, or architectural components to development are the easiest tasks to do. For me, it's not difficult to plan and design a medium-range or long-range growth center plan. It's not a problem at all. But engaging in a political solution is. And that's an entirely different ballgame. Both in my academic work and urban planning consultancies, I have consistently espoused the re-rooting of our development to the origins of the city-state that the classical Greeks talked about. And I advocated the role of growth points and maritime development employing innovative and sustainable urban designs consistent to the natural and social characteristics of our island nation.

What is interesting about city-state planning is that, we don't have to reinvent the wheel. Already, we have successful models to learn upon. In fact, the successes of Monaco, Macau, Hong Kong, or Singapore can be traced to the application of the city-state model of development. Unfortunately, there are people who have the planning skills and expertise like me but do not possess the motherboard of urban or town planning. In short, someone has to exercise the political will to fulfill the vision of a new development from the beginning to

It'll be interesting to find out in the coming election. Who among the political contenders – local as well as national – possess and can articulate the vision and the determination to finally implement the long overdue, serious, no-nonsense, and non-distracted development expansion throughout the archipelago?

Anyone?

Why we need more storms

Kabayan came too fast, left too soon

MANILA - While most Filipinos breathed a collective sigh of relief at Tropical Storm Kabayan's departure Friday morning, experts have expressed concern that it came too fast and left too soon.

Even before it made itself felt, Kabayan was forecast to do little for the country's looming water crisis.

PAGASA hydrologist Edgar dela Cruz said that the rain from Kabayan was expected to bump up Luzon's precious water reserves, but not by much.

"Sa forecast namin tataas lang ng halos 1.5m ang water reserve natin (sa Angat Dam, na siyang nagsu-supply ng tubig sa Metro Manila). Hindi ganoon ka-significant ang pagtaas na ito," he forecast.

The reason for this, according to GMA resident meteorologist Nathaniel "Mang Tani" Cruz is that Kabayan was just too weak and moving too fast to bring enough rain to sufficiently replenish the country's water reserves.

"Kahit na malakas ang ulan, dahil sa bilis ng kilos ni Kabayan, hindi magtatagal ang mga ulan na dala nito," Mang Tani said.

He added that the rain was a welcome respite from the scorching El Niño, but was just too short to have any lasting positive

"Yung ulan sa ibang bahagi ng Luzon ay nakatulong kahit papaano makadagdag sa kulang na tubig, pero hindi pa rin ito sapat dahil napakababa na nga ng reserves natin," Mang Tani explained.

Experts agree that the ongoing strong El Niño will last until the middle of next year, and no more than two cyclones may be expected to enter the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR) within any given

In contrast, in a regular year, as many as 3 or 4 typhoons may pass within the PAR in a month—usually in July to September, the peak of the typhoon season.

In light of the calamitous floods and damage brought by typhoons in recent years—2014's Ruby and 2013's Yolanda come to mind—it seems almost ironic that we would wish more typhoons upon

However, typhoons are essential for more than just bringing much-needed rain to parched areas: they usually form above warm ocean waters, as heat is dissipated outward from the Earth. As such, they are also an important means for regulating the Earth's life-sustaining atmosphere.

Import more rice

MANILA - The Philippines should import more rice to cover losses in the production of the staple food due to damage inflicted by typhoon Lando in Northern and Central Luzon, the Finance Department said.

> Finance Undersecretary and chief economist Gil Beltran said more rice imports were needed to avoid a sharp increase in the domestic price of the commodity.

"The country may have to import more rice to replace these losses in

domestic production and avoid triggering an inflationary spiral," Beltran said in the latest finance economic bulletin. Beltran said the rice buffer could drop below 50 days if

the losses from the typhoon were not replaced. Rice buffer of close to the September 1 level of 58 days is needed to ensure rice price stability," Beltran said.

3M Pinoys may lose vote

At least three million voters may not be able to participate in next year's local and national elections if they fail to have their biometrics captured until October 31, 2015, the deadline for the registration of voters, Sen. Francis Escudero warned on Sunday.

He urged voters to validate their registration while there is still time.

At the same time, the senator called on the public to help the Commission on Elections (Comelec) boost its information drive and encourage registered voters to have their biometrics captured.


Pursuant to RA 10367, registered voters whose photographs, fingerprints and signatures have not been captured must submit themselves for validation before the city or municipal election officer.

Those who fail to validate their registration before the deadline shall be taken off the list of voters and shall not be able to vote in May 2016.

"We are running under a platform of inclusiveness. Yet at least three million qualified voters will be left behind and will not be able to vote in 2016 if we will not help the Comelec," Escudero said.

Duterte backs Ople's senatorial bid

Davao City Mayor Rodrigo Duterte is backing the senatorial bid of labor and OFW (overseas Filipino worker) advocate Susan "Toots" Ople and vowed to campaign for her in Davao City and the rest of Mindanao. The popular mayor expressed his admiration for millions of OFWs and said he was very well aware of Ople's advocacy, particularly on the fight against human trafficking.

"The mayor and I share a common cause: the fight against human trafficking. He was very emphatic in saying that no Filipino overseas worker should end up as a modern slave on a foreign soil," Ople said. She noted that Duterte considers human trafficking to be at par with the illegal drug trade in terms of severity as a transnational crime. Ople received the Trafficking-in-Persons Hero Award from US State Secretary John Kerry in 2013.

She also received the Harvard Kennedy School of Government Alumni Achievement Award in 2010 for her work in rescuing victims of human trafficking from Syria.

Her non-profit organization, the Blas F. Ople Policy Center, works closely with the Inter-Agency Council Against Trafficking (Iacat) and other government agencies to address cases of human trafficking involving overseas Filipinos.

Comelec eyes 590 bets for perpetual disqualification

MANILA - In an unprecedented move, the Commission on Elections (Comelec) tagged nearly 600 candidates "for perpetual disqualification" after they failed to report their campaign expenses in two previous polls.

It was not clear if this would be immediately executory.

The Comelec on October 23, released the names of 597

candidates who failed to submit their statements of contributions and expenditures (SOCEs) in two or more previous elections.

The Campaign Finance Unit labeled each tally as a "list of candidates subject to perpetual disqualification due to 2nd and 3rd failure to file SOCE."

Prominent names "for perpetual disqualification" include former

Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao governor Nur Misuari, former Caloocan City mayor Macario Asistio Jr, and former Quezon City congressman Ismael "Chuck" Mathay III.

The recently uploaded lists didn't include candidates for national positions.

NPA Lies on Killings

CAGAYAN DE ORO CITY, Philippines – Captain Patrick Martinez, spokesperson of the 4th Infantry Division of the Philippine Army on Sunday said that the New People's Army statement on the killing of Loreto, Agusan del Sur Mayor Dario Otaza is deceitful and superficial.

Otaza was murdered together with his son Daryl after they were forcefully abducted on October 19, 2015 from their home in Barangay Baan, Butuan City.

Otaza and Daryl were later found the following day, hog tied and riddled with bullets. Martinez said the NPA's Southern Mindanao command spokesman Rigoberto Sanchez's point-by-point accusation against Otaza and his son and their alleged crimes against humanity are superficial.

Sanchez alleged that Otaza is the mastermind of the "brutal murder" and "acts of torture" of Lumad and ordinary civilians, including the deaths of Benjie Planos and Gabriel Alindao, last September 2013.

"Ironically, these accusations are all coming from the number 1 Human Rights Violator and a criminal himself," Martinez said.

Martinez said that both Planos and Alindao are NPA rebels and were "Sangay sa Partido sa Lokalidad" or main recruiters, organizers, and points of contact inside the barangays.

"It was the NPA that killed Planos and Alindao in 2013, after they turned their back against the NPA (and) after Otaza urged them of a better future." Martinez said.

"Just like what Otaza did in 1986, (he) turned his back against the NPA," Martinez added.

He added Planos and Alindao were killed by the NPA because of their betraval.

"They were killed in September 2013 by the NPA and (the crime was) charged to Mayor Otaza." Martinez said.

Martinez added that the other killings mentioned in Sanchez' statement suffered the same fate with the NPA's "inhumane and brutal" Kangaroo

Bill allows Bangko to snoop

The House of Representatives has passed a bill that will authorize the Bangko Sentral ng Pilipinas (Bangko Sentral) to snoop into the financial records and gather pertinent information from individuals as government and nongovernment entities.

House Bill 5875 or the New Central Bank Act was passed on third and final reading. The measure gives the Bangko Sentral the power to require any person or entity—including government offices and instrumentalities as well as government owned and controlled corporations—to provide the Bangko Sentral any data or information for statistical and policy development purposes in relation to the proper discharge of its functions and responsibilities.

At present, the Bangko Sentral is only allowed to request for such records.

LJ from Paulo to Paolo: He makes me happy now

Manila traffic is worse in the world

Senator Nancy Binay deplores anti-OFW policies

MANILA - Metro Manila has been reported to have the worst traffic on Earth on a city level, closely followed by Rio de Janeiro and Sao Paulo in Brazil, and Jakarta in Indonesia, according to the community-based traffic and navigation app Waze in its latest Global Driver Satisfaction Index.

The roads of the Philippines have also been reported to be one of the worst to drive on because of the frequency and severity of traffic jams, poor road infrastructures, among other reasons. Latin American countries, including El Salvador and Guatemala, are also among the lowest on the list.

While Manila got the worst traffic, Indonesia had eight cities on the list of cities with the worst traffic all over the world, implying a dreadful driving experience country-wide.

The evaluation was made through 50 million users in 32 countries and 167 metro areas, and from a 10 (satisfying)



to 1 (miserable) grading system, the Philippines got 0.4, followed by Guatemala and Venezuela, El Salvador, Ecuador, and Colombia, as well as Indonesia, Romania, Costa Rica, and Panama.

On the other hand, Netherlands, Slovakia, Sweden, and Czech Republic reported an easy and satisfying driving experience, as well as the United States and France which are aided by smaller cities with appropriate infrastructure that is easy to navigate.


The average commuting time in Manila has been estimated at 45.5 minutes, making it the longest commute time in most major cities all over the world.

As a country, the Philippines also scored low in the Road Quality Index, and the Socio-Economic Index which is based on the access to cars and impact of gas prices.

Meanwhile, the Safety Index by Waze reported that the Philippines have the safest roads based on number of accidents, road hazards and weather. The Philippines scored 9.3, preceded only by Costa Rica, Netherlands, and Argentina.

The country also got the highest rank on the Drivers Services index based on access to gas stations and easy parking.

As of posting time, the Metro Manila Development Authority and the PNP Highway Patrol Group have yet to give their reactions on the matter.



MANILA - A security officer at the Ninoy Aquino International Airport (NAIA) was arrested in an entrapment operation for allegedly asking a woman for sex in exchange for clearing her travel papers.

Benedict Larcibal, 29, was arrested by the Anti-Human Trafficking Division of the National Bureau of Investigation inside a motel in Pasay City after his victim agreed to work with the authorities to entrap him.

According to the victim, who was offloaded from her flight to Singapore, Larcibal presented himself as an immigration officer and offered to remove the red marks on her papers in exchange for P35,000. The red marks indicate that the passenger has been offloaded due to questionable documents.

"Continuous yung calls niya, communicate niya na ine-explain niya 'yung pag-proseso. Nagbigay na siya ng price na P35,000 para ma-clear na 'yung lahat, para makaalis na kami," the victim said.

Larcibal, however, changed the terms of the agreement later on and asked for sex in addition to the money. He even assured the victim that she would not get pregnant even if he didn't use a condom.

"Hindi ba kita pwedeng masolo and mahihirapan na ko kung next week kasi mapapatungan na yung ibang records mahihirapan na call me para ma-explain ko ulit ng maayos," read one of Larcibal's text messages to the victim.

Larcibal denied the transaction upon arrest, despite authorities catching him in bed and in possession of P10,000 in marked money.

"Wala po sir, wala pong katotohanan, sir," Larcibal said.


Lawyer Abdul Jamar Dimaporo of the NBI asked victims of similar schemes to approach their office so they could help them seek

The son of an OFW shares why there is a need for strong OFW advocates in the Senate

MANILA - I am the son of an overseas Filipino Worker (OFW). In 1984, the year I was born, my family was whisked away to live in Kuwait where my father worked as an engineer. In the context of growing unrest and the economic downturn of the Marcos Era, it was a decision of desperation and survival.

Eventually, our family had to leave again in the same circumstances, desperation and survival. Saddam Hussein had invaded Kuwait, and our family's choice was either biological weapons or the desert. We struck out for the border in the desert, only to be halted by Iraqi troops. My father was separated from us. The rest of the family was turned over to the Red Crescent, and was eventually repatriated back to the Philippines. By her generosity, we settled into our aunt's home in Pangasinan in 1990.

We never knew if Papa would come home. I can remember how my mother got into a deep depression. She cried sometimes, but always tried to remain strong for us, 5

One day, my father finally turned up at

our doorway in Pangasinan. It was a blissful reunion, and it seemed like everything was back to normal.

But economic realities and financial need led my father to apply once more for a job in the Middle East. It was Kuwait again for him, a country now needing more engineers to rebuild the destruction wrought by war.

It was his sweat and tears that brought all 5 of us siblings all the way through college, that supported us until we finally became financially independent. I got to be a doctor because my father was an OFW. One can only imagine the gargantuan sacrifice of my father. Just last year, there were 2.3 Million OFWs who made the same decision to leave the Philippines.

Impact of OFWs

Now I find myself abroad once again, this time studying for a year in London. During the past month, I have met many OFWs and students in the United Kingdom, all dreaming of a better future.

In my homesick moments, I look back at all the things we take for granted back home, the special amenities and small luxuries we forget to be grateful for, paid by the price of

In a practical sense, OFWs have had an

enormous impact on the Philippines. Over the past 4 decades, OFWs have poured trillions of pesos in remittances into our nation. In 2014 alone, the Central Bank of the Philippines reported that a total of Php 1.20 trillion has been sent back by OFWs through official remittance channels. To give that amount more perspective, the budget allocation of the government in the same year (through the General Appropriations Act of 2014) was pegged at Php 2.265 trillion.

It was that hard-earned money that allowed OFWs to send their children to school, to buy food, to build businesses, to purchase the latest gadgets.

OFWs have singlehandedly uplifted the quality of life of millions of Filipinos. It is their remittances that are fuelling continued domestic consumption which, in turn, is helping businesses in the country get through the economic slump facing the region since the past decade.

Toots Ople: Leading by serving

This is precisely why the upcoming elections are of vital importance: We need OFWs to be in the electoral agenda. We need someone who can look after OFWs and their welfare. We need an ally who can reliably take care of the interests of mothers and fathers risking their lives abroad for our own welfare.

We need Susan Ople in the Senate.

For many decades, Susan "Toots" Ople has been working tirelessly to protect OFWs. Toots Ople has brought her Harvard education to good use for the country. She heads the Blas F. Ople Policy Center and Training Institute, managing daily distress calls from OFWs the world over, and helping them reintegrate as productive members of society. Toots Ople uses her voice in broadcast, print and social media to consistently promote her advocacy.

for all of us, to realise our rights," Jailani was quoted as saying. "Girls want to say to world leaders that they have the potential to do well."


Aside from Jailani and Obama, American actress and girls advocate Charlize Theron and former Prime Minister of Australia Julia Gillard was also at the panel.

HONG KONG—In just one night last month, affluent businessmen here raised P90 million to help the "ultrapoor" in the Philippines who live on P13 or less a day.

Behind the effort was the International Care Ministries (ICM), a nonprofit organization that held its annual auction and charity banquet on Oct. 8 at the Hong Kong Convention and Exhibition Centre to raise funds for 1.7 million extremely poor people scattered in 17 provinces of the Philippines.

"We concluded that the underlying cause of poverty is rooted on fatalism. And the antidote to fatalism is hope," said David Sutherland, ICM board chair and the former chief financial

officer of Morgan Stanley Asia-Pacific.

"If you want to address ultrapoverty, hope is the key. People living in extreme poverty, they experience extreme stress," Sutherland said.

ICM is present in the provinces of Palawan, Aklan, Capiz, Iloilo, Guimaras, Negros Occidental, Negros Oriental, Cebu, Bohol, Zamboanga del Norte, Zamboanga del Sur, Zamboanga Sibugay, Sarangani, Cotabato, South Cotabato, Sultan Kudarat and Maguindanao.

Filipina in terror plot?

RIYADH-A Filipina, held along with a Syrian national for involvement in terrorist activities, was wearing a suicide vest at the time of her arrest.

"She would wear an explosive vest when the Syrian man was out of the house to threaten any intruders," the Saudi Interior Ministry spokesman said.

The man, identified as Yasser Mohammed Shafiq Al-Barazi, had bobby-trapped his home in Al-Fayhaa district. It took security forces 12 hours to defuse the explosive devices and secured the premises.

Al-Barazi, who entered the Kingdom in 2010, is believed to have forced the Filipna, identified as Lady Gioi Aban Bali Nang, to live with him after she ran away from her sponsor more than 15 months ago. Malacanang said it will be giving legal aid to the Filipina

"She helped him (Al-Barazi) in assembling the explosive devices and sewing suicide vests," said the spokesman. "The house was booby-trapped and explosive devises were planted inside and outside.

The raids were the second major security operation in the capital in the past month. Security forces captured two militants and seized weapons and a explosive yest in raids on Sept. 15.

The Security authorities said that they have arrested a total of 135 Syrian expatriates for being involved in terrorist activities during the past 12 years. This year alone, 62 terrorists and supporters of Daesh (the so-called IS) were arrested. Most of the terrorists were Saudis, Yemenis and Syrians.

Filipino in Crazy Ex-Girfriend

After his remarks, Senator Enverga presented the organization with a certificate of recognition to honour their charitable contributions and good work, and he wished them all the best in their future endeavours.



Philippines needs 200 new cities

Philippines is not part of Trans Pacific Partnership

MANILA - Architect Felino Palafox has broadened his field of interest, from urban planning to nation-building, in search of fresh insights into the situation of the Philippines, which will celebrate its 500th year as a country by 2021.

Today, he is now more interested in discussing corruption, criminality, climate change, poverty, pollution, traffic congestion and incompetence, instead of just designing buildings.

Palafox, one of the panelists during the recent launch of the fourth Philippine Trust Index by public relations firm EON The Stakeholders Relations Group at Makati Shangri La Hotel, expressed his frustration over government's inefficiency, such as the fact that the Philippines missed the boat in regional efforts to build a new economic bloc.

The Philippines, this year's host of the Asia Pacific Economic Cooperation meetings, was left out of the 12-nation Trans-Pacific Partnership, which recently signed an agreement to redefine global trade.

Palafox described this as an embarrassing situation for the country,



a known ally of the United States which is leading the TPP, a new powerful group within Apec.

"The government is suffering not just from corruption, but also from analysis paralysis. Like in the case of TPP or Trans-Pacific Partnership, how come Vietnam, Brunei, Singapore went into the 12 while the Philippines, which is an ally of the US, is still analyzing whether to join or not," Palafox says.

The Philippines is still in talks to join TPP, according to the Trade Department. TPP's member countries cover about 40 percent of the world economy and include Australia, Brunei, Japan, Malaysia, New Zealand, Singapore and Vietnam in the Asia-Pacific region as well as the United States, Canada, Mexico, Peru and Chile.

The pact includes provisions to bring down barriers to trade in services and remove foreign investment restrictions, in addition to lowering tariffs on goods, according to Fitch Ratings.

Palafox says the Philippines missing the boat to TPP illustrates the lack of foresight among leaders, a reason why Filipinos have little trust in the government. He says nobody in the government thinks about traffic congestion, which translates into P2.2 billion worth of man-hour losses a day.

Palafox, who went to Harvard University for graduate courses, says a study done by the US Ivy League school as early as 2000, showed that Metro Manila was the fastest growing metropolis in the world.

"A projection showed there would be 54 million more Filipinos by 2050. Computing it at 250,000 per city, we need more than 200 new cities. Who among the government is thinking about that? Most of the government programs and policies are short-term and opportunistic," he says.

Recycled drugs' flooding streets?

Sotto reveals flaws in PDEA ops

MANILA - A lawmaker on revealed faults in the operations of law enforcement agencies which may have led to the reported oversupply of illegal drugs in the market and the alleged reuse of confiscated drugs.

Senator Vicente "Tito" Sotto III said the Philippine Drug Enforcement Agency (PDEA) has failed to follow the provisions of the Comprehensive Dangerous Drugs Act of 2002 on drug disposal.

Under the law, the agency is required to destroy the illegal drugs seized from their operations within 72 hours, after filing the case before a court.

"Ang nangyayari kasi kapag hindi pa nafa-file yung kaso, hindi pa nila sinusunod yung utos natin na kukuha lang ng certain quantity at quality tapos sisirain na dapat at magtitira na lang para sa korte. Ngayon, dahil hindi pa nafa-file ang kaso, ang sistemang nangyayari is hawak pa," he told radio dzMM.

The senator added that PDEA also typically waits for seized drug samples to pile up at their office before seeking the services of private incinerators for disposal.



"Ang sistema ng PDEA iniipon muna nila daw, dahil namamahalan doon sa mga waste management company na pinagsusunugan. Mahal pala bayad doon e, sa incinerator," Sotto said.

The PDEA has been allocated funds to purchase its own incinerator in 2015 but the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) has yet to issue a Certificate of Environmental

Compliance Commitment (ECC) for the equipment.

Anti-drug units also face accusations of pilfering confiscated drugs which are released back to the market for profit. Sotto has promised to hold a hearing on the allegations.

Sotto has also started drafting a bill that aims to overhaul the country's antiillegal drug system and elevate PDEA as the Presidential drug enforcement authority.

"Mayroon akong nakikitang sistema na dapat na nating gawin eh; gawin nang Presidential drug enforcement authority itong PDEA. Talagang [dapat] may sarili siyang prosecution, may sarili siyang enforcement arm," Sotto said.

The senator believes that the PDEA should perform a supervisory function, and have its own offices for preventive drug education and rehabilitation.

"Sa ngayon, sabog e. Ang rehabilitation, kailangan accredited ng DOH (Department of Health), ang prosecution, nasa DOJ (Department of Justice). Wala pang 10% ang conviction rate," Sotto pointed out.



Tessie takes lead role in new movie

Only 5 passed for nuisance bets?

MANILA - Commission on Elections (Comelec) chairman Jose Andres Bautista declined to comment on reports that only five presidential candidates have hurdled the initial screening of the law department for nuisance candidates.

Asked by reporters, Bautista said: "Dapat pagbigyan ng pagkakataon sinuman na mapadalhan ng sulat na magbigay ng pruweba na sila ay di dapat maituring na nuisance candidate. [It's] part of due process."

For the purpose, Bautista said they are looking at jurisprudence set by the Supreme Court as well as Comelec Resolution 9523 issued in 2012.

Comelec Resolution 9523 issued in 2012.

He said the candidates will be subjected to hearings for a preliminary conference.

"lpatatawag sila, magkakaroon ng preliminary conference where the clerk of court will be the ones interviewing the candidates," he said.

Bautista said the clerk will submit a recommendation to the divisions where the candidates' cases were raffled.

A total of 130 candidates for president, 19 for vice president and 172 for senator filed during last week's filing of certificates of candidacy at the Comelec office in Manila.

Bautista declined to answer anymore questions about the nuisance candidates.

Binay still Tops

MANILA (2nd UPDATE) - Vice President Jejomar Binay remains the top presidential contender in the 2016 elections, but Senator Grace Poe's popularity level is catching up with the vice-president's, the latest survey from the Social Weather Stations (SWS) said.

A March 20-23 survey, results of which were first published by BusinessWorld, shows that Binay's numbers barely changed from the previous presidential preference poll last November 2014.

SWS said Binay got 36%, just a percentage-point drop from the previous SWS survey last November.

SWS noted that while Binay's numbers barely changed, Poe – who has not yet declared her intention to run in 2016 – saw her numbers jump by 10-percentage points to 31%.

Given the survey's margin of error of plus/minus 3%, Binay and Poe were actually statistically tied in the March survey.

The independent pollster said the respondents were not given a list to choose from and were instead asked to give names of up to three persons whom they thought should succeed President Benigno Aquino III.

Davao City Mayor Rodrigo Duterte, who had said in February that he had no intention of seeking the presidency, also saw a 10-point jump in his figures to 15%.

Duterte is tied for third place with Interior Secretary Manuel Roxas II, who lost four points to 15% from 19%.



Congress urged to pass VAT exemption bill for PWDs

The House Independent Bloc called on both houses of Congress to finally approve a measure seeking to exempt persons with disabilities (PWDs) from paying the 12-percent value added tax (VAT) on certain goods and services.

Leyte Rep. Martin Romualdez, who heads the bloc, appealed to the House of Representatives and Senate leaderships to convene the bicameral conference panel to pass the bill. "The Aquino administration and Congress leaders can further show its care and compassion to PWDs by finally approving the bill upholding the rights and promoting the welfare of PWDs in the country," he said.

The House and Senate have already passed their own version of the measure.

"I appeal to the national government to consider my proposal so that we can extend additional genuine assistance to PWDs. This is very important to help their plight," said Romualdez, the principal author of House Bill (HB) No. 1039 which "seeks to amend Section 32 of Republic Act (RA) No. 7277, otherwise known as the Magna Carta for Persons with Disability.

KathNiel enjoins public to vote wisely

Teen stars Daniel Padilla and Kathryn Bernardo look forward to exercising their right to vote in 2016. The two have officially registered as voters at the Quezon City Hall recently.

Daniel related his aim to vote for a presidential candidate that is sincere in his or her effort to uplift the country.

"Hindi pa naman huli ang lahat para makahanap tayo ng magaling na president. Lahat naman iyan magsisimula kung hindi corrupt ang binoto mo. Kapag hindi corrupt, sunud-sunod na 'yan," Daniel said.

High taxes may drive Filipino workers to ASEAN neighbor -**ANGARA**



MANILA, Philippines - Ahead of ASEAN integration to be formalized this year, Senator Sonny Angara has warned that the country's high tax rates may drive Filipino skilled workers to move to neighboring countries where taxes are lower.

"Ibig sabihin ng ASEAN Integration, ay halos magsasama-sama ang ating mga ekonomiya dito at magiging mas mahalaga itong usapin ng pagbubuwis. At kung ikukumpara nga natin ang Pilipinas kung saan ang kinikita mo ay ang lampas ng kita ng P500,000 (\$10,729) kada taon, kapag lumampas ho doon ay 32% o halos 1/3 ang iyong ibabayad sa inyong kita," Angara said.

(ASEAN Integration means all the economies will get together so it's important we talk about tax. If you look at the Philippines, if you earn more than P500,00 annually, you will be taxed 32% or almost 1/3 of your salary.)

He pointed out that, in Indonesia, the highest tax rate is 30%, Malaysia has 26%, and Singapore has 20%. Angara, however, said that that its not always a direct

comparison.

In the Philippines, a person earning P250,00 to P500,000 (\$5,364-\$10,729) is taxed at 32% but in Singapore the equivalent bracket is only 2%, because that level of income is considered low in the developed nation, Angara explained.

Angara added that Thailand is the process of reforming its tax system in a bid to be more competitive. From 40% at the highest percentile, Thailand has slashed it to 30% and is looking at further reducing

"Sa Thailand po kasi nakikita ho nila na kailangan nilang maging competitive o alam ho nila na 'pag dating ho ng araw, I think by next year ay iyong integrated na o magsama-sama na ho tayo," he said.

(In Thailand, they see the need to be more competitive as integration happens next year.)

This, he said, may lead to countries like



The 55,000 strong could not contain their emotions, as most were seen getting teary-eyed. Online, Aldub set yet another record—garnering 29 million tweets as of Saturday afternoon.

From classrooms to libraries

But more than the "kilig" that these two young television stars have been serving to their viewers, Aldub used their popularity to bridge donors and public schools around the country.

It can be recalled that "Plastic ni Juan," a pro-environment movement within Eat Bulaga's All for Juan, Juan for All segment, has been asking contestants in each barangay they visit to donate plastic bottles where funds collected from selling these plastic bottles are used to buy chairs for public school children.

Moving their social project a notch higher, Aldub will now use 100 percent of the tickets—estimated to amass P14 million—from Sa Tamang Panahon to fund public libraries in schools nationwide, majority of which have been devastated by the typhoon.

Eat Bulaga promised that updates on the building of these public libraries would be shown.

Thailand poaching creative talent nurtured in the Philippines.

"Kunwari gusto na ng Pilipino na magtrabaho sa Thailand o gusto ng taga-Thailand na magtrabaho sa Pilipinas ay pwede ho iyon. Pero ang gusto ho nila maakit ho nila iyong magagaling na empleyado at isang paraan ho diyan para maaakit iyong mga magagaling na indibidwal, katulad ng mga manunulat o kaya mga creative people ay sa paraan ng mas mababang buwis. Kaya nakikita nila na mobile po yung tinatawag na labor capital. Iyong nag-iinvest at saka kumikitang tao ay naghahanap ng pinakapabor sa kanya na lugar para magtrabaho."

(Integration will mean that a Filipino can work in Thailand and vice versa. But what these countries want are good, skilled workers and one way to lure these talented individuals, such as writers or other creative people, is lower taxes. They see that there will be a mobile labor force. The people you invest in and earn from will look for more favorable places to work.)

Angara, chairman of the Senate ways and means committee, is the leading proponent of a bill seeking to lower income tax rates.

He also reiterated the need for taxes to be adjusted for inflation, a process known as indexation, as the current brackets have not been adjusted since 1997. (READ: Big business group to Aquino: Reform taxes)

Highest VAT

Angara also pointed out that the country has the highest Value Added Tax (VAT) in the region at 12% while the rest don't

exceed 10%.

He added that he doesn't agree with the Department of Finance's suggestion (DOF) to raise the VAT so as to compensate for the loss of government revenue by lowering income tax as it puts a heavy burden on the people who can least afford it.

"Pagdating naman ho sa VAT, mas malaki po ang porsyento ng ating populasyon dahil kahit ika'y kumikita ho ng minimum wage, ika'y magbabayad parin ho ng VAT sa binibili. Sa Mercury Drug, ... fast food, sa mga restaurants, pag bumiyahe po tayo may VAT ho yun kaya hindi tayo sangayon na dapat taasan yung Value Added Tax na 12%."

(When you talk about VAT, it affects a bigger percentage of the population because even if you are earning minimum wage [and thus exempted from income tax] you will still pay the VAT - at Mercury Drug, fast foods, when commuting we pay VAT - so I don't agree that we need to raise the 12% VAT any higher.)

The finance department submitted to Congress in August the government's version of a tax reform bill, which includes an all-in income tax exemption to all wage earners with an annual income of less than P1 million (\$21,458).

Along with the proposal is increasing VAT from 12% to 14% and expanding the VAT base by removing all exemptions, except in agriculture, health, banks, education, as well as removing zerorating, except direct exports.

Angara also dismissed the Aquino administrations suggestions that a projected P30 billion (\$643.7 million) loss in government revenue if income tax is lowered would lead to lower credit ratings citing that this amount is less than 1% of the government budget for 2016.

This is in contrast to a single-parent family, to the larger extended family, and to a family with more than two parents."



who is the spokesman of Mar Roxas, has said that it is more important that aid must reach the people. We agree with this. In the end, what is really important is that government aid reaches those who need it most."

"We only wish [Lacierda] made the same remark when the distribution of aid in Casiguran, Aurora was withheld because they had to wait for the arrival of the President," he added.

Ilagan also scored Aquino administration for tacitly allowing members of its Cabinet to use government resources to advance the presidential bid of Roxas in 2016.

"While aid is being withheld from those who are not party-mates, the allies of the administration are riding on the projects of the DSWD for their campaigns," he said.

As Typhoon Lando approached super typhoon strength as it approached Luzon, the LP standard bearers for President and vice president were spotted in a gathering of the government's Pantawid Pamilyang Pilipino Program (4Ps) beneficiaries in Koronadal, South Cotabato. The event was organized by DSWD, was also attended by Secretary Corazon Soliman.

Even Transportation and Communications Secretary Joseph Emilio Abaya made a slip of the tongue when he credited Tourism Ramon Jimenez for providing him a copy of the survey results saying among others the preference of Filipinos to the continuity of Tuwid na Daan.

"What is the business of the DOT in political matters? Foremost in our mind is this question: Will the results of this political survey aid in explaining the failure of the Department of Tourism to get its 10-million tourist target?" Ilagan asked.

He also questioned if Jimenez had used public funds to commission the political survey that was not part of his office's mandate

Opposition candidate for vice president, Senator Ferdinand Marcos Jr., said the government should provide all available assistance to farmers affected by Typhoon Lando to enable them to rebuild their lives as soon as possible.

"Assistance to the victims should not end with just the distribution of relief goods. We should give adequate support to our farmers so they can resume planting and return to normal as soon as possible," Marcos said.

For starters Marcos said the government should provide cheap credit facilities to the affected farmers.

Another vice presidential candidate, Senator Francis Escudero asked why no releases have been made since June 30 from the P1-billion People's Survival Fund that was aimed at boosting long-term mitigation and adaptation programs for local government units in light of climate change.

"Why is that money still there? What is the point of having this special fund if nobody uses it?" he said.

"It's been three years since we passed the law—has the PSF even been useful to anybody? What is stopping the government from releasing the money?" he added.

As local government units continued to grapple with the unmitigated impact of extreme weather, Escudero called on the government to immediately release the special fund.

"You cannot just go from storm to storm, flood to flood. Climate change is behind these frequent and extreme weather events; LGUs should be more proactive in addressing the problems at the root, instead of being merely reactionary," he said.

Budget Secretary Florencio Abad, meanwhile, said allotments continue to keep ahead of last year's rates, with 96.4 percent of funds already released to departments and agencies as of Sept. 30.

The DBM said allotment releases to agencies over the first nine months of 2015 outpaced last year's figures, with P1.29 trillion already released compared to last year's P1.1 trillion, he said.

"While most of this year's national budget has already been released to agencies, we still have around 60 percent of Special Purpose Funds available. For example, only 26.6 percent of the National Disaster Risk Reduction Management Fund has been released to date," Abad said.

"While it may seem like we're lagging in this regard, the availability of these funds for release means we're prepared to address the aftermath of calamities hitting the country like Typhoon Lando," he said.

Fund releases in 2015 as a proportion of the total P2.606-trillion General Appropriations Act reached 90.2 percent or P2.350 trillion, Abad said.

New study says breakfast may not be the most important meal for weight loss



Whether it's a bowl of cereal, eggs, yogurt or a bagel with cream cheese, most Americans believe eating breakfast is the right thing to do, After all, we have heard that breakfast is the most important meal of the day. But recent research makes some wonder whether there's evidence to back up this well-worn saying.

The government currently recommends that people eat breakfast and some research suggests that starting off the day with a meal in the belly actually helps with weight loss. But a recent study challenges this notion.

Last year, researchers at Columbia University asked people to be in one of three groups — one group ate oatmeal for breakfast, one ate Frosted Flakes for breakfast, and one skipped breakfast. Overweight people who skipped breakfast were the only group that lost weight.

"The research right now is a little bit uncertain in terms of skipping versus eating breakfast and obesity and body weight," says Andrew Brown from the Nutrition Obesity Research Center at the University of Alabama Birmingham.

People wondering whether to skip breakfast because they hope to lose weight should remember that there are many reasons people gain weight and breakfast plays just a small part.

"There are many factors that impact weight gain and maybe skipping breakfast or eating breakfast is one of them, but it's not the only one," says Madelyn Fernstrom, NBC News Health and Nutrition editor.



Reports say that Miss Austria regularly jogs at Bergisel Mountain in her hometown in the Tirol region of Austria. She fell into a ravine 30 meters down,


