The beautiful Filipina who stole Mario Vargas Llosa's heart

Nobel laureate Mario Vargas Llosa and his partner, the Philippine-born Spanish socialite Isabel Preysler, slipped quietly into the country last week.

Only the Spanish celebrity journal "¡Hola!," which dutifully chronicles the couple's every move, came out with a report.

For his part, the 80-year-old Peruvian-born novelist, who is in the Philippines upon the invitation of Instituto Cervantes, and is scheduled to receive honorary degrees from the University of Santo Tomas and De La Salle University, chose to keep a discreet silence about their relationship.

The writer's romance with the 65-year-old Preysler, perhaps best known outside Spain as the former wife of pop singer Julio Iglesias and mother of singer Enrique, caused a public stir last year when he left his wife of 50 years for her, declaring "now I feel what happiness is." What time he had left, he said, he needed to spend with

Preysler had been widowed only months before, after the death of her third husband, former Spanish finance minister Miguel Boyer, to whom she was married for 27

The couple have been inseparable since Vargas Llosa's divorce, with Preysler often accompanying the writer to his international commitments as a Nobel Prize winner.

Celebrated as much for her unfading exotic beauty and a jetset lifestyle that has her rubbing elbows with European high society and celebrities such as David and Victoria Beckham and George Clooney, Preysler has lived a very public life ever since her marriage to Iglesias in 1971.

The former beauty queen and model has been a journalist and television host. She is also a wellknown celebrity endorser in Spain, for Manolo Blahnik shoes and the

design house Porcelanosa, among others.

The couple's Philippine visit could turn out to be a well-earned respite from the limelight.

"This is a very, very lowprofile trip," says Inquirer columnist Maurice Arcache, a family friend of Preysler since childhood. "A big SABEI cocktail party for the Spanish community was canceled in favor of a more intimate dinner for 10."

> As far as he knows, says Arcache, the trip is a chance for Vargas Llosa to learn more about Preysler's early life in the Philippines.

In her teens and studying at Assumption, Preysler won a beauty contest. She was also dating Louie Ysmael, among other eligible bachelors, when she fell hard for future environmentalist Junie Kalaw, who was 10 years her senior, says Arcache.

"Her mother shipped her off to Spain because she was not too keen on Kalaw, who had the reputation of being a playboy," he adds. "When she arrived in Madrid, there were two or three dozen roses waiting for her as she came down the gangplank. But, of course, that romance died and she started meeting people."

One of them was a recently retired Real Madrid goalie named Julio Iglesias, who had just embarked on a new career as a singer.

"Then it was goodbye Junie, hello Julio," says Arcache. "That was when her world changed. She fell in love with one of the biggest pop singers in Europe, adored by all the women around him, although only for a moment, him being the playboy that he was. That started the ball rolling."

After eight years and three children, the couple divorced in 1979.

The following year Preysler married Carlos Falco, the Marquess de Grignon. The couple had a daughter, but the marriage was short-lived.

In 1987, she married Miguel Boyer, the socialist finance minister of Spain, who also left his wife for her. The union produced another daughter, and was apparently a happy one.

As for Preysler's current relationship with Vargas Llosa, Arcache speculates:

"This time around it looks like a different thing," he says. "Apparently he's very, very charming. I guess he has that golden tongue. I told her sister, 'Tell her this time I wish her all the happiness she can

Parking fees on private lots aren't tickets

You don't need to pay them

It's one thing when you get a ticket on city streets. But what about privately owned parking lots?

"It's not a parking ticket," Toronto lawyer John Weingust says.

They're issuing tickets that look like the same as the [real ones]," he says, "People think it's from the city ... and they get frightened of it and they pay it." But if you get one, "you can throw it in the garbage," he confidently

Credit-monitoring firm Equifax confirm an unpaid parking ticket — as long as it's from a private lot — won't ruin your credit history.

The main issue with private tickets versus official ones, Weingust says, is that while the latter will make it very clear how to pay the fee or dispute the charges and the former often do no such thing.

"I say don't pay it," Weingust says. "You'll never hear from them again."

Age gap not a hindrance to Christian and Julie Anne's unlikely partnership

Style-wise, Christian Bautista and Julie Anne San Jose seem to make an unlikely pairing for a concert: He's a balladeer with a strong theater background; she is a pop-R&B singer who has no qualms spitting bars.

are very different, so the challenge for us is to make sure that things do not [become] chop suey," he said at a recent press conference.



"It boils down to complementing each other's sound and finding a strong middle ground," Christian told the Inquirer. "I want to do songs like 'Closer' without looking like a tito trying to be young!"

"I don't sing as many love songs these days, so doing this show will be a good way for me to explore that kind of music again," added Julie Anne, who feels that the age gap will not be a hindrance to onstage rapport.

The concert, mounted by Dreamstar Events and GMA Network (call 911-5555), will feature a repertoire that will reflect the progression of a relationship—courtship, romance, arguments, breakup and reconcili-

"It is great, actually! He (Christian) said he felt younger when he was singing with me. I, on the other hand, feel more mature when



I am with him," Julie Anne told the Inquirer. "We love singing harmonies, and have always maintained a good working relationship.'

What these singers have in common is the distinction of having diamond-selling records (150,000 units sold or 10 times platinum)—a feat that has become increasingly difficult to achieve in the age of online piracy.

In fact, in the past five years, Christian and Julie Anne are two of only four recording acts who managed to rack up the numbers. The other two are pop-rock band Sponge Cola and, just this month, actor Alden Richards.

Christian received his diamond certification for "A Wonderful Christmas" in 2010. Julie Anne, meanwhile, did it with her eponymous album in 2014. Though they both believe that selling that much is still doable these days, neither knows if there is an actual recipe for replicating the achievement.

"In my case, I guess it was simply one of those magical moments where everything just fell into place. It was the right time, the right kind of promotion, tours, music videos, producers," Christian said. "I know it is all about upbeat or electronic music these days, but I think ballads still have a place in today's

Julie Anne stressed that having quality material was still crucial, but added that being internet-savvy also helped a great deal. "You have to have great songs, but you also have to know how to promote it, especially on social media," she said. "Everyone is online now."

Richard, A Big Revelation

RICHARD Yap admits he feels so sad that "Mano Po 7" Chinoy" was not accepted as an entry in the coming Metro Filmfest. 

Duterte has to be more careful with tirades vs US'



Trump's not gung-ho stance on human rights may be good for PH-US ties, says Heydarian

MANILA - A political analyst believes that Philippine President Rodrigo Duterte has to be more careful with his tirades against the United States, now that it has elected a more temperamental president.

Speaking on ANC, political analyst Richard Heydarian said Duterte should watch what he says against the US, since its incoming president Donald Trump is known as someone who does not take insults lightly.

"I'm worried with Trump because unlike Obama, he's not known for someone who has a very good temperament. He's known to be very prickly. I'm not sure Donald Trump will take the tirades of Duterte, if not personal insults of Duterte, the way that Obama has taken it," he said.

"So President Duterte has to be much

more careful when dealing with United States under a Trump presidency," Heydarian added.

Heydarian also said that Trump, who promised to "make America great again," will most likely react negatively should Duterte insult him or the US.

"Do you think a person running on that campaign slogan will just sit back when a person from a small allied country like the Philippines insults him?" he said.

Transactional Relations?

On the other hand, Heydarian said Trump is "very transactional," which may make dealing with Duterte easier.

"Donald Trump is very transactional, in terms of how he views international relations, and I think he's not a person who's very gung-ho in advocating human rights and democracy, I really doubt that. So this could actually be a good point for the Philippines because Duterte and Trump may not need to waste so much time, or may not engage so much on his war on drugs or human rights record. So Trump will approach Duterte from a much more transactionalist point of view,

like, what is there out for us in dealing with the Philippines," he said.

He added that Trump also does not have a very strong position against China.

"Probably he will not try to push Duterte against China or in favor of US. I mean, probably Trump, if he feels that the South China Sea is not something of core interest or of national interest for the United States, he may develop a much more isolationist and disengaged policy towards Asia," Heydarian added

"So probably that would be a good thing for the Duterte administration because the last thing the Duterte administration wants at this point is US interference in his policy towards China," also said.

Trump, the 70-year-old Republican nominee, was elected the 45th president of the United States after securing 289 electoral votes over Clinton's 218, according to CNN's count.

In his congratulatory message, Duterte said he "looks forward to working with the incoming administration for enhanced Philippines-US relations anchored on mutual respect, mutual benefit and shared commitment to democratic ideals and the rule of law."

DOT eyes visa-free for Chinese tourists

DAVAO CITY - The Philippine government is looking at the possibility of granting visa-free travel to Chinese tourists in a bid to increase tourist arrivals in the country, a tourism official said. "China is considered as our low-hanging fruit. This is where the (tourist) volume in Asia will be coming from. In fact, (they had) 120 million outbound tourists last year and we only got around 491,000. Napakaliit," Department of Tourism (DOT) Route Development Head Erwin Balane said.

Travel requirements, such as visas, are among the "barriers" that keep leisure travelers from China from choosing the Philip-

pines as a vacation destination, Balane said.

"If you look at Cambodia, Thailand, Malaysia, Singapore, and even Vietnam, Chinese tourists are all visa-free entry. That's why they are getting the volume of Chinese tourists," he said.

Around 50 nationalities have visa-free privileges in the Philippines.

Though the DOT is still discussing the proposal with the Department of Foreign Affairs, Tourism Secretary Wanda Teo "has already given marching orders to have one million Chinese nationals visit the Philippines by the end of 2017," he said.

"We're already at around 500,000 as of September," Balane said.

The surge of tourists from mainland China came as the Chinese government lifted the travel warning it had issued against the Philippines.

The development came shortly after President Rodrigo Duterte's four-day state visit to China last October.

There has been a 64-percent increase from 257,014 arrivals between January and July last year to 422,801 during the same period this year, the DOT earlier said.

Scarborough lagoon to become a no-fish zone

LIMA, Peru – President Rodrigo Duterte will declare the lagoon portion of Scarborough Shoal as a "marine sanctuary and no-fish zone," according to Cabinet secretaries accompanying the him to the Asia Pacific Economic Cooperation (APEC) Leaders' Meeting here.

Duterte relayed this "unilateral decision" to Chinese President Xi Jinping, during their bilateral talks Saturday at the sidelines of the economic gathering. Xi's reaction was not immediately known.

National Security Adviser Hermogenes Esperon Jr. said this means fishermen – both Filipino and Chinese – will not be allowed to fish in the lagoon part, which is now being guarded by Chinese Coast Guard ships.

Filipino fishermen who went to the area after the President's state visit to China were

able fish in the periphery but could not enter the lagoon on account of the Chinese ships.

"It is our position not to have fishing activities inside the triangle," said Esperon. "Diyan tayo may congruence: kung ayaw nila (China) magpa-fishing doon, ayaw din natin magpa-fishing doon."

Esperon said the lagoon is a spawning area, which means the fishes there are small.

Trade and Industry Secretary Ramon Lopez said the two countries have also agreed to conduct joint Coast Guard patrols in Scarborough and nearby areas.

He said the president also made it clear that "if we are going to send ships there, it's to take care of our fishermen."

Lopez said the Philippines owes this détente in relations with China to the respect both leaders have for each other.

"During the bilaterals, sa umpisa pa lang (Xi) praised agad PRRD [President Rodrigo Roa Duterte]," the secretary said. "Sabi niya (Xi), he's a man who does what he says."

The Cabinet security cluster is set to meet next week to draft an executive order for the declaration of the Scarborough lagoon area as a marine sanctuary.

During the Duterte-Xi talks, China also confirmed that Filipinos are free to return to their traditional fishing grounds in the Scarborough Shoal.

For its part, the Philippines said it will set aside for the meantime its territorial claims and sovereignty issues until a final solution is found.

NEW DIRECTOR PRAISED

MEANWHILE, didn't Direk Ian Lorenos have a hard time directing such a big cast, considering that it's his first mainstream movie after directing two acclaimed indie films, "The Leaving" and "Alagwa"? "Noong una, kabado ako, kasi most of them are A-listers at kilalang celebrities," he says. "But I gained confidence when I talked to them and realized they're dedicated artists, not just celebrities. We all collaborated and they gave a very good performance."

Eric Quizon, who's the most experienced member of the cast and is a director himself, says Direk Ian acquitted himself well for a new director. "He has a

clear vision of what he wants for his film. He is good with his visuals and is also a good storyteller. May puso ang pagdidirek niya," says Eric, which flattered Direk Ian to no end.

cavalry of persons who realized, who implemented martial law, then point your fingers on all these people and make them accountable, including the cronies for that matter."

Carlos also advised millennials to research on martial law from different perspectives and not just "skewed" literature, following protests sparked by the burial of late dictator Ferdinand Marcos at the heroes' cemetery.

"The millennials, please read, do not be lazy. Scholarship and laziness do not come together. Read, and read a lot and then make your determination. You cannot be reading 'skewed' articles... I, as a scholar, I don't want data to be skewed, I don't want stories to be skewed, I want all array of data and (so I can) come up with my own predicate," Carlos said.

Hundreds of young people, including students from different universities and schools across the country, took to streets to show their dismay over the hurried burial of Marcos at the Libingan ng mga Bayani last Friday.

Asked on her opinion on the large number of millennials who joined anti-Marcos protests last Friday, Carlos said they are entitled to their own views but questioned the kind of research materials millennials used in reaching the conclusion to join protests.

'What kind of research data were available to them? And because I am familiar with that literature, I am telling you they are skewed in a particular direction. And so, yes, history must be told from many, many perspectives."

Carlos, however, clarified that she is not apologizing or justifying the acts of the late dictator but is simply speaking from a scholarly point of view.

"This is not to apologize or justify anything. Let as many stories be told."

She explained that though military atrocities during the Marcos regime have been well documented, no non-partisan scholar has been able to "really assess"

the 21-year regime of Marcos, given that the public allowed him to rule the country for two decades.

"We have to deal with this, I mean the full array of the 21 years and why? We were, I was living already at the time, I was teaching. We allowed him to govern us for 21 years so we were also in collusion with what was happening at the time so let's not jump up and down and continue to demonize the person," she said

Carlos also expressed dismay over proposals to exhume Marcos' body from the heroes' cemetery, noting that a wrong cannot be corrected by another wrong.

"Don't we have any more respect for dead people? It's so sad really," she said.

"If you're going to put all the blame on one person when there were in fact you have a whole cavalry of persons who realized, who implemented martial law then point your fingers on all these people and make them accountable, including the cronies for that matter."





US elections:

Filipinos wonder if President Duterte and Donald Trump will create sparks or stability

MANILA - When two equally volatile and unpredictable presidents are put in the same room, will they hit it off or will sparks fly?

The question is being asked here with brash billionaire businessman Donald Trump's election as the next President of the United States. Most Filipinos had hoped to see Democrat Hillary Clinton elected, as she was supposed to represent continuity and stability.

There is also a palpable sense of uncertainty about relations between Manila and Washington, already frayed by Philippine President Rodrigo Duterte's anti-US tirades.

In a statement read out by his communications minister subsequently, Mr Duterte said he "looks forward to working with the incoming administration for enhanced Philippines-US relations anchored on mutual respect, mutual benefit and shared commitment to democratic ideals and the rule of law".

Said political analyst Richard Javad Heydarian, of De La Salle University: "Clinton would have been a far better option."

With Mr Trump now at the helm, the Philippines can expect a few surprises, both good and bad, he added.

"A Trump administration would most likely not be concerned with human rights issues," said Mr Heydarian.

He added he also does not see Mr Trump pressuring Mr Duterte to adopt an anti-China policy.

"We might see an America that is more concerned with striking a grand bargain," he said.

But Mr Trump can call Mr Duterte's bluff if the Philippine leader remains relentless in

insulting the US, and pull out US troops in the Philippines.

Mr Trump had said Mr Duterte showed "lack of respect" in calling the outgoing US President Barack Obama a "son of a whore".

Mr Duterte has said he wants an end to all US-Philippine war games, and for all remaining American forces to leave the Philippines in two years.

His defence minister Delfin Lorenzana, though, has

clarified that the military drills will just be scaled back, and that Mr Duterte has signed up on a 10-year defence pact allowing the US to rotate its troops in at least five military bases in the Philippines.

Mr Heydarian said the "transactions-oriented" Mr Trump could look at a "poor, developing country" like the Philippines, the US' treaty ally since 1951, as a "liability".

"Trump has consistently made the argument that if allies are not standing up for themselves, then what's the point of America standing up for her allies?" he said.

Defence analyst Jose Antonio Custodio does not expect a big shift in US foreign policy, despite Mr Trump declaring that the US should be compensated for the protection it gives its allies.

He said the US, under Mr Trump, would continue to defend its interest in the South China Sea and push back against efforts by China to exert greater influence in the region.

Among call centres, meanwhile, there is a sense of unease.

The government's chief economic manager Ernesto Pernia said the Philippines' burgeoning business process outsourcing (BPO) industry, a key economic peg, could take a hit under Mr Trump, who has vowed to bring jobs outsourced by American companies abroad back to the US.

Nearly three-fourths of the BPO industry's earnings come from the US.

BPO companies, many of which are American-owned, brought in US\$22 billion (S\$30.8 billion) in revenues and employed over a million workers in the Philippines last year.

But for economist Peter Wallace, Mr Duterte and Mr Trump will surprisingly get along well.

"I think President Duterte will understand the kind of person Mr Trump is and be able to work with him. I think it may be good," he said.

Jihadists occupy Lanao town hall

LANAO - At least eight Islamic militants were killed while two government troops were wounded after extremists fled to the abandoned town hall of Butig town in Lanao del Sur amid a military operation to capture the leader of the Maute jihadist group.

Armed Forces of the Philippines spokesperson Brig. Gen. Restituto Padilla said about 200 Maute group members fled to the abandoned town hall after the military mounted an operation to capture their leader Abdullah Maute, a Jordanian-trained terrorist who formed the jihadist Dawlah Islamiya.

"We launched an operation more than two days ago with the aim of capturing the leader of the group that is sowing chaos in parts of Lanao, Maguindanao and Cotabato," Padilla said in a radio interview. "They are also responsible for the bombing in Davao."

"They fled and occupied the abandoned town hall of Butig which is located in an area where they have relatives and supporters," Padilla said, adding the military also launched artillery fire and air strikes against the group.

Padilla said the clash took place just five months after the military captured the Maute group's Darul Iman stronghold in June.

Padilla said the fighting began around 10 a.m. Saturday after troops of the 49th Infantry Battalion engaged 15 Maute group members in a 45-minute gun fight at Barangay Bayabao Poblacion after which the terrorists

Government troops pursued the fleeing rebels and eventually caught up with them at the old municipal hall where they sought cover against the attacking security forces.

The rebels even raised an Islamic State flag at the old town hall and positioned themselves in the nearby national high school and mosque.

Major Filemon Tan, spokes-

Duterte wants to open PHL telecoms, airwaves, energy sectors

MANILA - President Rodrigo Duterte said he wants to open the communications, media, and energy sectors to foreign players after attending the Asia Pacific Economic Cooperation (APEC) Summit in Peru.

"My decision now, this moment, is bubuksan ko ang Pilipinas," Duterte said upon arriving at the Davao City International Airport.

He said he wanted to open these sectors "to new players to improve quality of service."

"I don't want to have a quarrel with the Ayalas and Pangilinan," Duterte said, later adding that he would walk back from his comments if the conglomerates running the country's telecommunications companies drove their prices

"Kung i-dive ninyo ang presyo ninyo, walang

problema. I will forget my statement."

ERC issue

Duterte's comments come on the heels of his demand for officials of the Energy Regulatory Commission to resign after the suicide of director Francisco Villa Jr.

The late ERC director revealed the corruption activities within the ERC in his suicide notes.

"Corruption, unahin ko na lang. I'd like just to send this strong message. It's about time that we share the money of the entire country. To move faster, make the competition open to all," he said.

ERC officials have refused to heed his call. In his speech, Duterte threatened to abolish RC.

man of the Western Mindanao Command, said they are carefully analyzing the current situation in Butig to prevent collateral damage.

Tan said Maute renamed the group Dawla Islamiya to impress foreign terrorists so that they could get funding. The group was responsible for the Davao City bombing last September that left 14 people dead and wounded 70 others.

The Maute group, which operates mainly in the Lanao provinces, is also believed to have links to the Parojinog narcotics ring based in Ozamis City.

Many members of the Maute group are members of the Alkhobar kidnapping ring which used to be led by former lieutenants of Moro Islamic Liberation Front chieftain Hashim Salamat who broke away from the MILF after Salamat's death.

Obama's Prediction of US-PH Ties under Trump

Rekindling of US-PH ties under Trump

Lima, Peru – President Barack Obama believes relations between the Philippines and the United States will be rekindled under the new administration of President-elect Donald Trump because of the two leaders' seemingly similar temperament.

Foreign Affairs Secretary Perfecto Yasay reported this after having an encounter with the outgoing American president who attended his last APEC Leaders' Meeting here.

Yasay represented President Rodrigo Duterte in two APEC activities – the leaders' gala dinner and picture-taking for the traditional APEC family photo. Duterte explained in a separate press conference that he had a bad jet lag and this made him skip the two events. It was in these two events that Yasay had the chance to meet and talk with Obama.

"He told me he is expecting a better and stronger relationship between the Philippines and the United States under the new administration of President-elect Trump because they seem to have the same kind of temperament. And I replied with 'I hope so'," Yasay said.

The firebrand Duterte has been critical of the policies of the US and the west during the political campaign period and even after he assumed office.

Yasay, however, said he had no time to

mention to Obama that the difficulty in the two countries' relations at the moment is more fundamental in nature rather than the personalities involved.

While Obama had no message for the no-show Duterte, perhaps, Yasay said, Obama may have observed that relations of the two allied countries have been a little bit strained at present but the animosities are limited at the leaders' level only.

"With Trump, perhaps he saw a more optimistic prospect," Yasay said.

"With Trump and even into future, our relationships would grow stronger for as long as we are able to manage these fundamentals properly. It will be towards a direction both countries will treat each other as sovereign equals and (with) mutual respect. That is the most (important) basis to carry out a mutually beneficial relationship," he added.

Future of PH-Russia relations

Philippine Ambassador to Russia, Carlos D. Sorreta briefed Russian media practitioners – Nathan Hodge, Moscow Bureau Chief of the Wall Street Journal (WSJ) and Thomas Grove, reporter for WSJ – on the future direction of Philippine-Russia relations.

Sorreta delved on the decision of the Philippine Government to intensify relations with Russia, including possibly in the area of military technical cooperation.

He noted that the President has declared his intention to pursue an independent foreign policy.

"One of the important players in this world is Russia and there are many opportunities for mutually beneficial relations between us," he added.

However, Sorreta said that "this does not mean cutting off bilateral ties with other countries, as the President himself has clarified."

On Philippines-Russia military-technical cooperation, Ambassador Sorreta mentioned that in terms of defense products, Russia has almost everything other traditional partners can offer without political conditionalities and other strings attached.

Moreover, it provides technology transfer and is flexible on the issue of financing.

While no decision has been made yet on the purchase of Russian weapons, the two sides are laying the foundation for robust military-technical cooperation through the exchange of visits and crafting of legal frameworks

DOLE to undocumented US Pinoys:

Come home before Trump takes office

MANILA- The Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE) is urging undocumented Overseas Filipino Workers (OFWs) based in the United States to return home before US President-elect Donald Trump assumes office in January, Palace officials said Tuesday.

The call came amid the threat of massive deportation of illegal immigrants should Trump stay true to his campaign promise of sending undocumented migrants in America back to their home

countries.

Should undocumented workers decide to come home, the DOLE will be ready to provide assistance, presidential spokesperson Ernesto Abella said.

"Labor Secretary Bello said, 'Ang end program of our President is to bring back our OFWs so we already established a mechanism for businesses and employment opportunities," Abella added.

Without providing numbers, DOLE said Trump's policy will only have mini-

mal effect since most OFWs in the US are legally employed, Abella said.

President Rodrigo Duterte earlier said he respects Trump's views on immigration and he hopes the incoming US president will be fair to illegal immigrants.

"I trust in his judgment and that he would be fair [on] the matter of the treatment of illegal immigrants," Duterte said.

"I cannot talk for the illegals because... an illegal is always illegal so he is subject at any time for deportation," Duterte said.

ABS-CBN apologizes to Pagasa

MANILA - Television network ABS-CBN has apologized to employees of the Philippine Atmospheric Geophysical Astronomical Services Administration (Pagasa) for a kids television gag show's joke over unrealiable weather forecasts.

The media giant said the different meaning

given to the acronym Pagasa in an episode of "Goin' Bulilit" "was said in the context of a joke and should not be deemed as a fact or criticism."

The Philippine Weathermen Employees Association, the union of Pagasa employees, the next day demanded a public apology from the producers of the comedy show for belittling the weather bureau and endangering public safety.

"It was not our intention to hurt or demean the agency and we apologize to the employees of Pagasa who may have been offended by the joke that we aired," ABS-CBN said.

DUTERTE DECLARES PANATAG AS MARINE SANCTUARY

China has not delared support



Chinese Foreign Ministry spokesperson Geng Shuang said China and the Philippines have reached an agreement on coming back to the track of dialogue and consultation for the settlement of the South China Sea issue.

MANILA, Philippines – China has not declared its support for an executive order to be issued by President Duterte declaring the lagoon at of Panatag (Scarborough) Shoal a marine sanctuary that will be off-limits to fishermen from any nation.

Chinese Foreign Ministry spokesperson Geng Shuang said China and the Philippines have reached an agreement on coming back to the track of dialogue and consultation for the settlement of the

South China Sea issue.

The Chinese side has also made proper arrangements for fishing activities

by Filipino fishermen around Panatag Shoal in the interest of bilateral friendship.

"China's sovereignty and jurisdiction over Huangyan Dao (Panatag Shoal) has not and will not change," Geng said.

"We hope that China and the Philippines will enhance dialogue and cooperation so as to turn the South China Sea issue into a positive factor for friendship and cooperation," he added.

Duterte will issue an EO declaring the lagoon in Panatag Shoal as a marine protected area in a move that would prohibit fishing inside the breeding ground of marine species.

National Security Adviser Hermogenes Esperon Jr. said the draft EO may be submitted during the next Cabinet security cluster meeting.

Jail for kids?

Proposed Philippine law to jail 9-year-olds raises alarm

MANILA - Children as young as nine could be jailed in the Philippines for certain crimes under a proposed law backed by the president, sparking concern from the United Nations and rights groups.

President Rodrigo Duterte's allies have been pushing to pass laws by December that would restore the death penalty and lower the minimum age of criminal responsibility from 15 to 9.

"Adult criminals knowingly and purposely make use of youth below 15 years of age to commit crimes, such as drug trafficking," Pantaleon Alvarez, one of the proposed law's main backers, said in an explanatory note.

While Duterte wanted the age threshold dropped to 12, his allies want it lowered to nine

The UN children's agency UNICEF reminded the Philippines of its international obligations.

Manila is a state party to the UN Convention on the Rights of the Child, which says criminal responsibility below the age of 12 is not acceptable.

"Jail is no place for a child," UNICEF said.
Rights organizations launched a campaign called #ChildrenNotCriminals to urge

lawmakers to reconsider their support for the law.

One of the groups, Plan International, told AFP that children on the wrong side of the law were often victims of criminal gangs.

"It is unfair that it's always the children who are blamed. This will result in children becoming hardened criminals," said Ernesto Almocera of Plan International Philippines.

The advocates appealed to Duterte to explore factors that led children to commit crimes, such as poverty and lack of parental guidance and education.

"We cannot hold children to the same standard as we hold adult offenders," Melanie Llana of the Philippine Action for Youth Offenders told AFP. "Are we really going to jail 9-year-olds who we know are not fully mature?"

Duterte's hardline approach to criminals has drawn criticism from its ally the United States, the UN and human rights groups.

Nearly 2,800 have died in unexplained circumstances since Duterte took office and critics allege some of these deaths amount to state-sponsored extrajudicial killings, a charge Duterte has rejected.

Why Speaker Supports Jail

MANILA - House Speaker Pantaleon "Bebot" Alvarez said he will ask help from Senate President Aquilino "Koko" Pimentel III in lowering the age of criminal liability to nine years old.

Alvarez has filed a proposal in the lower House to amend the "Juvenile Justice and Welfare Act of 2006", which set the minimum age for criminal liability at 15 years old.

His House Bill 2 or "Minimum Age of Criminal Responsibility Act" would pass into law if the Senate adopts it.

The Senate may also create a similar bill, which would be reconciled by the Bicameral committee with House Bill 2.

He added that lowering the age of criminal responsibility would deter criminal syndicates from using minors as accomplices.

Alvarez also clarified that under the proposed law, young offenders would not be detained together with hardened criminals but would undergo rehabilitation in a separate facility instead.


JERIC KEEPS ENDING SECRET



may be used in public and private transactions in the country.

"Every Filipino, whether residing in the Philippines or abroad, is mandated to register personal information required by the ID system, and upon application shall be issued a non-transferable Filipino ID card with an ID number that shall be valid for life, subject to replacement only under (some) circumstances," Arroyo said.

The proposed law tasks the Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) with overseeing the ID registration through the Local Civil Registry Office and ensuring that all Filipinos, including indigenous peoples and those in the remote communities, are issued a card.

The card, which will be made of tamperproof security material, shall store at least the biometric data of the cardholder and shall also bear the owner's photograph, name, birth date, gender, date of issue, and signature.

The Filipino ID card may be used in all government transactions including applications for passport, driver's license, any services and benefits offered by the Government Service Insurance System (GSIS), the Social Security System (SSS), the Philippine Health Insurance Corporation (PhilHealth) and the Home Development Mutual Fund (HDMF); clearances from the National Bureau of Investigation (NBI), courts, prosecutor and the police; proof of identity, status, age and address for admission in all learning institutions as well as for employment purposes; and availment of benefits or privileges afforded by law to senior citizens.

The same may also be used as proof of identity, status, age and address for transac-

tions in banking and financial institutions. No additional proof of identification shall be required when the Filipino ID card is presented. The initial application and issuance of the Filipino ID card shall be free of charge as part of the government's social service responsibility. A replacement fee shall be paid by the cardholder.

The public may apply for the ID card in their municipality or at the nearest Philippine Embassy.

Why is a National ID needed

MANILA - A Philippine congressman said the country needs a unified national ID system as another form of identification for all Filipinos.

Albay 2nd District Rep. Al Francis Bichara gives Filipinos another ID separate from their passports and driver's licenses.

"We really need a unified ID that will include our SSS number, GSIS, voter's ID number, TIN...All the relevant info," he said.

He added the card will include the person's photograph, name, birth date, gender, date of issue, signature of owner, and corresponding individual serial number issued by the Philippine Statistics Authority.

Under the proposed measure, the Philippine Statistics Authority will be the implementing agency of the program, tasked to create and maintain a Filipino Citizen Registry.

Bichara said Filipinos can get the non-transferable ID card when they reach 18.

He said that when the ID card is presented to any government agency or for identification purposes, no other additional identification card will be required.



Sinasabing monster siya, aswang, but behind the urban legend, there is really a wife abandoned by her husband and a mother looking for justice. It's a good role and although I did 'Dukot' for Direk Paul Soriano na parang indie ang atake, 'Lily' is really my first out and out indie film. This is directed by Keith Deligero, who also cowrote the script. Kasama ko rito si Rocky Salumbides.'

This leads to the killing of eight journalists who mysteriously disappear, but were actually killed and buried on Christmas Eve (shades of the Ampatuan massacre). Bela Padilla as Pam, an honest and hard-hitting journalist, then goes to La Paz from Manila to investigate the case.

It's HOOQ's plan to finish shooting all the six episodes and then release it for viewing in one blow, which is what Netflix is now doing for its series like the big hits "Stranger Things", "House of Cards" and "Narcos". "We in Reality Entertainment are really excited with this project," says director-producer Erik Matti. "Creating a mini-series for video-in-demand is a new challenge for us that will give us the chance to explore new, unique materials that will pull in viewers who are tired of watching the usual stuff on TV. We promise to come up with something new that will be truly worth watching."

Erik has also just finished a new horror-thriller which they entered in the Metro Manila Filmfest, "Seklusyon", about four young priests who are brought to a secluded place to prevent them from being tempted by the devil. "These are Dominic Roque, Ronnie Alonte, Johnvic Guzman and JR Versales. What they don't know is they will encounter a young girl, Red Bustamante, who is brought to the same place and she can be the personification of evil. Kasama rin dito sina Neil Ryan Sese and Lou Veloso."

Here's hoping "On the Job, The Series" will be a hit and that "Seklusyon" will make it as a final entry in the MMFF.

different. The U.S.-spec C-HR receives dual projector-beam halogen headlights with LED daytime running lights. The taillights still protrude from the body but feature different lenses.

Unlike the European C-HR, which offers both a turbocharged 1.2-liter I-4 and a 1.8-liter I-4 gasoline-hybrid drivetrain, the U.S.-spec 2018 C-HR is powered by a naturally aspirated, non-hybrid 2.0-liter I-4. That engine makes 144 hp and 139 lb-ft of torque, up from the hybrid's 122 hp and the turbo's 115 hp. A CVT is the only transmission type offered. Though all-wheel drive is available in Europe, at launch the 2018 C-HR will only be available in front-wheel drive. The crossover can be had in one of two trim levels, XLE and XLE Premium, at launch

Toyota says the engine uses the company's latest technologies, including next-gen Variable Valve Timing and Valvematic systems optimized for fuel economy and smoothness. To cut emissions, the catalyst is warmed up earlier. The 2018 C-HR's new



CVT has redesigned pulley and a new belt structure to improve acceleration and fuel economy and reduce cabin noise. The transmission also uses the world's first coaxial two-port oil pump system, which makes possible continuous oil pressure changes.

Though the U.S.-spec C-HR only offers a CVT at launch, Toyota will let owners feel like they're in control with a simulated seven-speed Sequential Shiftmatic function, which can create artificial "step-up" shifts on command. Toyota says the C-HR's ride and handling was tuned on Germany's challenging Nürburgring track.

The C-HR's interior is driver-centric, and features unique design touches sure to appeal to younger buyers. A 7-inch touchscreen tops the dash, and runs Toyota's

latest infotainment system complete with apps like Aha internet radio. XLE Premium models get puddle lamps that project the Toyota C-HR logo, along with hands-free keyless entry and push-button start. The rear seats are made more spacious by scalloped front seatbacks, footwell cubbies beneath the front seats, and a sculpted headliner that adds a little more rear headroom. The rear seats are 60/40 split folding and can fold flat

All 2018 C-HR models come standard with Toyota Safety Sense P, which includes forward collision mitigation with pedestrian detection and automatic emergency braking, lane departure warning with Steering Assist, automatic high beams, and full-speed radar adaptive cruise control. The C-HR also gets 10 airbags and a rearview camera as standard.

With the U.S. market's insatiable appetite for crossovers, the 2018 Toyota C-HR shouldn't have a problem finding homes as long as buyers can get over—or even learn to love—the small CUV's unconventional design.


