When Mary Ann San Jose moved to Sitio Pariahan more than two decades ago, she could walk to the local chapel. Today, reaching it requires a swim.

The main culprit is catastrophic subsidence caused by groundwater being pumped out from below, often via unregulated wells for homes, factories, and farms catering to a booming population and growing economy.

The steady sinking of coastal towns and islets like Pariahan in the northern Philippines has caused Manila Bay's brackish water to pour inland and displace thousands, posing a greater threat than rising sea levels due to climate change.

"It was so beautiful here before... Children were playing in the streets," San Jose said, adding: "Now we always need to use a boat"

Most of the former residents have scattered to other parts of the region. Just a handful of families remain in Pariahan, which had its own elementary school, a bas-



PHL Senate creates a Space Agency

MANILA - The Senate has approved on third and final reading a bill that will establish the Philippine Space Agency (PhilSA).

Sen. Benigno "Bam" Aquino IV, who sponsored Senate Bill No. 1983 or the Act Establishing the Philippine Space Development and Utilization Policy and Creating the Philippine Space Agency, said the launching of a space program would give Filipinos a new perspective and valuable insights that could help solve some of the country's biggest problems.

"Satellites can improve disaster management from providing accurate information that allows early warnings and predicting of disasters to reliable and quick communication during relief

and recovery operations," Aquino said in his sponsorship speech.

Aquino said the space agency could also enhance production and profitability of agribusinesses due to soil and weather monitoring and assessment, and help conserve and preserve the environment, improve urban planning, transportation and communication

Aquino hopes the proposed legislation would propel the Philippines to be space-capable in the next decade.

"A solid space program can improve disaster management, enhance the lives of Filipino farmers, speed up our internet and telecommunications systems and help us build better, more livable cities," Aquino said.

"Let us continue to dream big for our country and let us never tire of finding better solutions

Once the bill is enacted into law, a Philippine Space Development and Utilization Policy would be established to serve as the Philippines' strategic roadmap for space development.

Under the bill, an initial P1 billion funding for the space program will be taken from the current fiscal year's appropriation of the Office of the President.

The amount for the subsequent operation and maintenance of the PhilSA will be included in the General Appropriations Act.

Additional funding amounting to P10 billion will come from the gross income of the Philippine Amusement and Gaming Corporation and the Bases Conversion and Development Authority for five years after the effectivity of the act, with P2 billion to be released to PhilSA yearly.

Sanction lawyers for frivolous cases

'The time for imposing sanctions on such litigants and lawyers may soon be around the corner,' says the Chief Justice

MANILA, Philippines – Chief Justice Lucas Bersamin threatened lawyers with sanctions if they file "clearly frivolous" petitions that would clog the Supreme Court dockets.

"The filings made with the Supreme Court on a monthly basis has simply bloated in recent years, and this has been mainly attributable to the irresponsibility of litigants and their lawyers who have ignored the warnings regularly issued against bringing clearly frivolous or unsubstantial or dilatory petitions," Bersamin said.

Bersamin added: "The time for imposing sanctions on such litigants and lawyers may soon be around the corner."

Bersamin cited a recent decision of the en banc that junked the petition of Visayas fishermen against the bundling of contracts for airport construction in the region.

The en banc zeroed in on the failure of the petition to comply with the rules of constitutional litigation, such as the proper use of transcendental importance.

The case involved the fishermen from Samar, who identified themselves as victims of Yolanda and who said they have a stake as taxpayers in the project they deemed illegal.

The SC en banc denied the petition mainly because of violation of hierarchy of courts, saying that they are not a trier of facts.

"To end, while reflective deliberation is necessary in the judicial process, there is simply no ample time for it given this Court's massive case load," said the en banc in a decision promulgated March 12.

Bersamin repeated the warning and said "well disguising causes as raising a constitutional question will no longer be tolerated."

"The ruling also announces the basis for the Supreme Court to be stricter in rejecting misfiled or unworthy petitions, and to be readier in sanctioning irresponsible litigants and lawyers," said Bersamin. Other efforts

As if cracking down on the legal profession, Bersamin boasted of his efforts to discipline judges, court officials, and lawyers.

According to the Supreme Court, from January 1, 2019 to March 31, 2019, thirteen judges were fined, reprimanded, or admonished; 38 court employees were either admonished, fined, reprimanded, had benefits forfeited, or suspended; 4 court employees who were dismissed for cause from the service; 14 lawyers suspended, 21 lawyers fined, and 14 warned.

"I am acknowledging that having ethical and competent members of the Bar is an imperative that we cannot ignore," Bersamin said. Bersamin also acknowledged the criticism of the legal education curriculum in the country, and responded to it by holding a legal education summit, the first of its kind in the country.

"As the Chief Justice, therefore, I cannot simply stand by and watch without doing anything. I have decided to call for the holding of a Legal Education Summit in July or early August of this year," Bersamin said.

Appointed chief justice by President Rodrigo Duterte, Bersamin will retire October this year.

In an Instagram post, she said that if she only had her way, she would like to stay longer abroad, or even live there.

Candidate becomes Palawan town mayor after winning 'best of three' coin toss

Some people are just born luckier than most.

A candidate became the mayor of the town of
Araceli in Palawan after she won a coin toss today.

Sue Cudilla, Araceli's former mayor, defeated the incumbent mayor Noel Beronio when they had a coin toss at a little past 3pm, reported Rappler. The toss didn't occur once; it was a best of three, meaning Cudilla won the game twice.

The win was decided by a coin toss because Beronio and Cudilla got the same amount of votes in this week's election — they received 3,495 votes each. The

event was overseen by election officer Emil Alili.

The decision to break the tie via coin toss has a legal basis. The Omnibus Election Code of the Philippines states that if candidates end up having the same number of votes, the tie will be broken either through a coin toss or drawing of lots.

This is the third time that the political rivals fought for the town's mayoralty post. In 2013, Cudilla won against Beronio, but in 2016, it was Beronio who was elected to become mayor, reported Manila Bulletin.

Cudilla is not the only woman who became mayor

for winning a coin toss. Joni Villanueva became the mayor of Bocaue in Bulacan in 2016 when she won a coin toss against her rival Jim Valerio, reported CNN Philippines. The two received 16,694 votes each, which made the coin toss necessary. Joni is the sister of Senator Joel Villanueva and the daughter of an incoming congressman, pastor Eddie Villanueva.

Araceli is an island municipality where various bird species and rock formations could be found. It has a population of 14,909 people according to the 2015 census.

'Cuddle Weather'

a sex film with a heart

"It's a story on lovemaking, but less on the 'making' part and more on the 'love.'"

This was how director Rod Marmol described his film "Cuddle Weather," a finalist in the 2019 Pista ng Pelikulang Pilipino (PPP).

The project, which centers on two sex workers who form an odd romantic setup as "cuddle partners," is one of three selected finalists that are in the "advanced stage of development or production stage," explained Liza Diño, chair of the Film Development Council of the Philippines, which organizes the weeklong festival.

Marmol, who developed the story with filmmakers/writers Antoinette Jadaone and Dan Villegas, said he was currently working on completing his cast.

"So we are looking for people who are unafraid to talk about sex, who swear and show more skin on film. This way, the characters will be more believable," Marmol said.

He admitted to have already experienced being turned down by three actors "They liked the story. It's the political angle they were worried about," the director said.

Marmol came up with the story because "I know that I can't get out of the 'love story box' if I wanted my film to earn money, but I also wanted to present something new.

Also, I have always been fascinated with the lives of prostitutes and call boys. I thought they're perfect subjects for a love story."

He shared with the Inquirer that he was a "hugot writer" before pursuing filmmaking. "I know many artists whose understanding of love is more complex. But I've also gotten to meet so many people,

like grocery baggers, bums hanging out on the streets, and have come to learn that their understanding of love is just as beautiful. I even feel that theirs is better because it's more honest and raw."

"We need a story on people na naiin-love sa laylayan, We're now at a time when the subject of rape and the value of women are being made into jokes by no less than the most influential people in society."

He also observed that there weren't a lot of sex films of late, "and yet, our country is the No. 1 patronizer of [the porn site] Pornhub, and that we have the highest growth rate of HIV cases. Funny because we don't want to talk about sex when I think we should, in order to educate people about the issues related to it."

The director proudly added: "How do you intelligently do it if we can't even talk about it? This is actually a sex film with a heart."

Lorenzana and Duterte gives different advice to PMA grads

FORT DEL PILAR, BAGUIO CITY, Philippines — The problems faced by cadets, who were immediately assigned to fight secessionists in Mindanao and communist rebels in the 1970s, are still the same confronting members of the "Mabalasik" Class of 2019 of the Philippine Military Academy (PMA) who will graduate on Sunday, Defense Secretary Delfin Lorenzana said.

So Lorenzana's advice to them during a pregraduation ceremony here was: "Please stay alive."

Mabalasik is an acronym for "Mandirigma ng Bayan, Iaalay ang Sarili, Lakas at Tapang, Para sa Kapayapaan."

Lorenzana said the cadets, who will be commissioned as junior officers of the Armed Forces of the Philippines, will be better equipped than when he graduated from PMA :-- 1050

He said his 1973 class composed of 61 members lost its first "mistah" (classmate), Jan Vincent Muyargas, within six months after they were sent to Mindanao to face the war triggered by the secessionist Moro National Liberation Front (MNLF).

More complex issues

But Mabalasik class has more complex issues to deal with such as the West Philippine Sea dispute, terrorism and climate change, Lorenzana said.

"All of us were sent to Mindanao as platoon leaders—even those assigned to the Air Force. Classmates who became members of the then Constabulary joined the [Philippine Constabulary] battalion there. The Navy joined the Marines," he sai

"Earlier [in 1973], we almost lost Cotabato City to the MNLF had government troopers rallied under the late Gen. Fortunato Abat of PMA Class of 1951," he said.

"Unfortunately, some of the challenges we faced before are still there... They remain and you will be facing them whether you are in the Army, Navy or Air Force," he said, adding: "There are more challenges and these are more complicated."

"The communist insurgency is still with us after 50 years. A lot of you in the Army will be facing the New People's Army. Luckily, the secessionist problem in Mindanao is moving forward to its final resolution with the enactment of the law creating the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region," he said.

Duterte tells PMA cadets: Die for country if needed BAGUIO CITY -- President Rodrigo Duterte

BAGUIO CITY -- President Rodrigo Duterte urged graduating cadets of the Philippine Military Academy to "die for your country" if necessary.

"Serve your country well. Die for your country if needs be. Remember the young Filipinos yet to come," Duterte told members of the PMA "Mabalasik" Class of 2019.

"If you think the country is not run the way it is, and if it will destroy your country, you should know what to do," added the President, who was guest of honor at the event.



Today, Shaun Chen, Member of Parliament for Scarborough North, on behalf of the Honourable Carla Qualtrough, Minister of Public Services and Procurement and Accessibility, announced that The Filipino Centre Toronto in Scarborough North has received financial support through the Government of Canada's Enabling Accessibility Fund.

This support will allow the Accessibility Renovations for Inclusivity project to improve accessibility for Canadians with disabilities.

With programs such as the EAF, the Government of Canada is breaking down the barriers that prevent persons with disabilities from fully participating in all aspects of Canadian society, ensuring that everyone has equal access and equal opportunity.

Through the 2018 EAF Call for proposals for small projects, eligible organizations could apply for project funding for up to \$100,000 per project under two funding streams: Community Accessibility and Workplace Accessibility.

The Workplace Accessibility stream gives eligible organizations across Canada funding for projects that improve accessibility and safety for persons with disabilities through renovations, retrofits or construction of workplaces, including the provision of accessible information and communication technologies for work use.

The Community Accessibility stream provides funding for projects that help improve accessibility and safety through renovations, retrofits or construction of community facilities and venues so that programs and services can be accessed by persons with disabilities. This includes the provision of information and communication technologies for community use that eliminate systemic accessibility

Providing support to help persons with disabilities access their communities and workplaces is a key part of the Government's plan to create a more inclusive and accessible Canada. By tabling the proposed Accessible Canada Act in 2018, the Government is taking concrete steps towards the realization of a barrier-free Canada where all Canadians have the same rights and opportunities to contribute to society.





The Filipino accent has been ranked first as the sexiest in Asia and 21st in the world, according to a travel site survey. Big 7 Travel disclosed Sunday the results of the poll conducted to their readers from all across the globe.

'Gentle and soft, the accents you'll hear when in the Philippines are simply lovely," Big 7 Travel described. Vietnamese and Indian accents followed 25th and 26th in the world (second and third in Asia), respectively.

Weight loss diet: This one drink can burn fat fast - how does it work?

MOST people know to lose weight they must eat less and move more. As well as this, some slimmers may cut back on how much alcohol they drink, but one tipple could be the surprising way to boost the metabolism and help burn fat

Having a fast metabolism means the body burns calories more quickly and those with a high metabolism are also less

The study used a group of mice to test the results and they were given either gin or water.

Those who were given gin showed an increase in their metabolic rate by an incredible 17 percent. The mice who consumed water saw no changes in their metabolism.

Drinking gin boosted the metabolism due to an 'afterburn effect', as the liver tried to break down the spirit.

The author of the study, Thisa Lye, concluded 'the spirit may have a slimming effect on the body', although further tests would be needed.

Gin in a favourite of many, although it was not clarified

how much of the drink is needed to feel the benefits. According to NHS guidelines, men and women are

advised not to drink more than 14 units of alcohol a week. Another drink that can help burn fat and promote weight loss is apple cider vinegar.

By drinking two tablespoons of this a day, dieters in one study saw an increased average weight loss of 3.7 pounds over those who did not have any.

The bitter drink can be taken on it's own or mixed in with water and honey to mask the taste.

Some people will lose up to 10lb in the first week follow-

ing this, and can expect a steady weight loss to continue the following weeks.

That's not the case now.

At least 5,000 people have been forced out of the mostly rural coastal areas north of Manila in recent decades as the bay water has moved further inland, regional disaster officials told AFP. The fate of towns such as Pariahan provides a preview of the problems that may await some of the capital's 13 million people. Sections of Manila along the shore of the bay are sinking too, with excess groundwater pumping being the most likely cause, Eco, the researcher, told AFP. The subsidence there though is at a slower rate than the northern coastal communities, potentially due to less pumping or differences in the soil, he

added. A moratorium on new wells in the greater Manila area has been in place since 2004. But enforcing that ban as well as shuttering existing illegal wells, falls to the National Water Resource Board and its roughly 100 staffers who are responsible for policing the whole country.

"We have insufficient manpower resources," the board's director Sevillo David told AFP. "It's a very big challenge for us, but I think we are

doing the best we can."

- Things will get worse -

The demand for water has soared as Manila's population has nearly doubled since 1985, and the size of the nation's economy has expanded roughly ten-fold over the same peri-

This explosive growth has created a ravenous demand for water, especially in the agriculture and manufacturing industries to the north of the

capital. "The sinking is a very serious threat to people, their livelihoods and cultures," said Joseph Estadilla, a spokesman for alliance seeking to protect Manila Bay coastal communities. "This is only going to get worse in the near future," he insisted.

Manila and its surroundings are among several major cities, especially in Asia, under threat as the land collapses beneath them, though the causes for this vary.

Cities such as Jakarta -- which is sinking 25 centimetres (0.8 feet) each year -- Bangkok and Shanghai risk being inundated within decades as a mixture of poor planning, more violent storms and higher tides wreak havoc.

In Jakarta, a city of 10 million people that sits on a confluence of 13 rivers, half the population lacks access to piped water, so many dig illegal wells to extract groundwater.

Yet in Pariahan the residents who remain are doing what they can to stay in a place they call home.

San Jose explained: "Every year we raise (the floor) of our house. Now my head almost reaches the ceiling."







Why Filipino nurses are a huge presence in U.S. health care

pines seemingly exported care to the hands of Uncle Sam. From 2012 to 2017, 92,277 nurses left the Philippines in search of opportunities abroad. Others would argue that in the United States, RNs could earn more in a day than they'd make in a month back home. The average annual salary of RNs in the US was \$73,550 in 2017—about \$35.36 per hour.

The employment of Filipino nurses in the United States was made more convenient due to the colonial relationship shared by the two countries from 1899 until 1942 during the

Japanese occupation but it wasn't until 1946 when the Philippines was granted independence by the U.S. During the American occupation, several programs ultimately led to the surge of Filipino nurses in the U.S.

Pensionado Act of 1903

A sudden need for local health care professionals led the U.S. Army to recruit Filipinos to work as Volunteer Auxiliary and Contract Nurses. Filipinos were sent to the United States as government-funded scholars otherwise known as pensionados.

Some of those who stayed for employment as nurses in the U.S. established the Philippine Nurses Association of New York in 1928.

As pensionado nurses returned to the Philippines, they helped set up and manage the 17 nursing schools that were established in the country from 1903 until 1940. Due to this, most of those who finished their nursing education were inspired to fly to the United States since they can do so with little restrictions. Filipino nurses were considered "U.S. nationals" and

even traveled with U.S. passports.

Exchange Visitor Program of 1948

As the U.S. State Department set up an Exchange Visitor Program to "combat Soviet propaganda," more nurses from the Philippines availed of the opportunity. The Philippines -US agreement that highlighted the importance of financing educational and cultural exchanges. A large percentage of the exchange visitors came from the Philippines, and many of them were nurses or nursing students.

1965 amendments to U.S. immigration laws Immigration laws were liberalized to allow Filipino nurses and other professionals to immigrate to the U.S. and permitted Filipino nurses to come to the U.S. on tourist visas without pre-arranged employment, allowing them to adjust their status once they set foot in the U.S. During this period, the number of nursing schools in the Philippines soared from 17 in 1940 to 170 in 1990 to more than 429 at the present time. Many of these nursing schools

were diploma mills.

However, the lax regulation resulted in a problem since only 15-20 percent of the Filipino nurses who immigrated to the U.S. after 1965 could pass the state nursing board exams. As a resolution, the Commission on Graduates of Foreign Nursing Schools (CGFNS) was established in 1977 to stop graduates of foreign nursing schools who come to the United States to work as nurses but couldn't pass the nursing board exams in the U.S. Today, there are many steps one must pass through in order to become a licensed nurse in the United States, even if they are licensed back in the Philippines.

After graduating, tests, and working for 2 years, they then apply to a state's Board of Nursing and taking the National Council Licensing Examination-Registered Nurse (NCLEX-RN).

History suggests that the Philippines and the U.S. are linked beyond the nurses that step in to fill the latter country's demand for that special health care. The connection between the two countries continues to show itself to this day.






