

GMA creative writer Suzette Doctolero said this with a laugh when she discussed the origin of her hit infidelity-themed series, My Husband's Lover. This project was touted as the first gay-themed drama series in the Philippines.

Aired in 2013, My Husband's Lover featured Carla Abellana as Lally, Tom Rodriguez as Vincent, and Dennis Trillo as Eric. The show got the attention of the TV audience because of its provocative story about a wife who discovered that her husband has a male lover.

In GMA-7 creative manager RJ Nuevas' scriptwriting lesson vlog on YouTube, Suzette discussed how she came up with the story of My Husband's Lover.

She said the idea came to her while they were in a drama pitching summit with other GMA writers.

Suzette wished to give a new flavor to infidelity-themed shows, especially since these types of shows are known to be winners in the ratings game.

These shows were usually aired in the afternoon slot, which is why she pitched it to Roy Iglesias

Attending concerts helps you live longer

Are you the type of person who loves going out to gigs or see their favorite artists live when they visit your area?This new research might benefit you.

According to a new research, attending to gigs and concerts for live music for at least 20 minutes can increase your feeling of well-being by 21 percent. This was conducted by London's Goldsmith University Associate Lecturer Patrick Fagan with a joint partnership with music and entertainment venue 02.

In addition, another scholarly research saw a direct link in high levels of well-being, meaning a lifespan increase of nine years, with gig-going and longevity.

Concert-goers who attend gigs once every two weeks or more were the most likely to score happiness, contentment, self-esteem and productivity at the highest rate (a score of perfect 10), accompanying research showed.

The test subjects who participated went through bespoke psychometric and heart-rate tests while doing various activities - yoga, dog walking and gig-going. Attending concerts showed the highest in well-being, compared with yoga with only 10 percent and dog walking with 7 percent.

Aside from an increase in well-being, those who went to gigs showed feelings of self-worth by 25 percent, being close to others by another 25 percent. Mental stimulation showed the highest number with 75 percent.

"Our research showcases the profound impact gigs have on feelings of health, happiness and well-being-with fortnightly or regular attendance being the key," Fagan said. "Combining all of our findings with 02's research, we arrive at a prescription of a gig a fortnight which could pave the way for almost a decade more years of life."



Andrea also made sure that each photo was a reflection of her personality. She also added that she worked hard to achieve her desired figure. which she proudly flaunted in the calendar.


"We wanted candid shots that would showcase my personality. I also requested not

CANADIAN CORRUPTION & SCANDAL

When you are in the business of Filipino newspaper publishing, you read a lot about corruption in the Philippines. There are so many that you just feel like giving up. So, let's change the country. Let's talk about corruption and scandals, Canadian-style.

However, we don't always hear the word corruption in Canada. The term used is conflict of interest. And I agree because, when you think about it, you might wonder if it's corruption. To me, my idea of corruption is a politician accepting money from someone, a group or a company and keeping the money to himself. I must have missed it pero I have not heard of a Canadian politician pocketing money, or going to his bank account. Usually, the news is, "a politician awards contract to a company based in his riding. The company donated so much amount in his election campaign." You see, here in Canada, that donation has to be accounted for. You don't hear or read the news that a "politician accepted a donation from that company and he built a big house after the election." Obviously, the company donated the amount to get the contract in the riding. Obviously also, the company is going to hire people and also pay taxes which goes back to the government.

This is what passes for corruption in Canada.

Permanent Residence upon arrival

It's only a "pilot" program that runs from March 4 to June 4 of this year. Pilot, meaning it's just a test run or temporary, not permanent. My guess is, they may run it past June, say, until, September or even October 30, which is

Once re-elected, they will not do it again. MANILA—President Rodrigo Duterte on urged Filipinos, especially parents of newborns, to not be scared of vaccines, as public trust with immunization eroded in the wake of the fiasco involving the anti-Dengue vaccine Dengvaxia.

"Iyung Dengvaxia, simula nu'ng nagkaroon ng gulo dito, maraming mga pamilya dito sa Pilipinas, hindi lang sa Malabon, na natakot ng mga itong vaccination, at ayaw na, 'wag ho kayong . . . do not be complacent about it kasi ang sanggol talaga kailangan. Iyung Dengvaxia lang, kung ayaw niyo OK lang," Duterte said in a speech at the groundbreaking ceremony of the new site of the San Lorenzo Ruiz General Hospital at Barangay Panghulo in Malabon.

From at least 70 percent in the last few years, immunization coverage in 2018 slid to 40 percent, said Health undersecretary Eric

Last December, the government recalled the anti-dengue vaccine Dengvaxia after its manufacturer, France's Sanofi-Pasteur, said it could cause severe symptoms if given to those who have not had the mosquito-borne disease.

Health experts have warned against a possible outbreak of measles in the Philippines, as a disease long under control is fueled by patchy immunization programs and declining trust in vaccines.

Measles cases jumped nearly fivefold to 17,300 in the 11 months to November 2018 versus last year's figure, mostly in conflict areas in the south, said doctors and officials of the World Health Organization (WHO). Last November, an opinion poll by the London School of Hygiene and Tropical Medicine showed just 32 percent of 1,500 Filipinos surveyed trusted vaccines, down from 93 percent in 2015.



Briones tells student journos to sharpen elementary grammar, spelling

PANGASINAN, Philippines — Education Secretary Leonor Briones reiterated on Monday the need to teach students with "sharp" elementary grammar, spelling and punctuation marks.

Speaking before campus journalists attending the National Schools Press Conference (NSPC) in Lingayen, Briones said that a comma, a semicolon, and a question mark, can change an "entire meaning of a sentence or the message you are trying to convey."

"Napapansin ko na ang ating conference is both in English and in Filipino. Siguro napapansin din ninyo, napapansin ng inyong mga



teachers na kailangan pa natin ng dagdag na pagsharpen ng ating elementary grammar, ng ating spelling, ng ating punctuation marks," she said.

"And maraming nakakapansin, na

maski na sa libro, napakaraming grammatical error. And ito, tine-take for granted natin dahil hinahalo natin ang Filipino, ang Bisaya, ang Waray, at English in many of the things

that we write about," she added.

Briones also urged young scribes to always seek the truth, to differentiate real information from falsehood and to distinguish journalism from propaganda.

"A journalist, first and foremost, should have correct grammar, correct usage, correct spelling, correct punctuation marks," the education chief said.

Briones graced the kickoff of NSPC 2019, the largest campus journalism event in the country organized annually by DepEd in pursuant to Republic Act 7079 or the Campus Journalism Act of 1991.

Deport Chinese "Illegals"

President Duterte cautions against mass deportations as there are 300,000 OFW's in China

MANILA - Senators are not supporting President Rodrigo Duterte in his call not to deport illegal Chinese workers for fear that undocumented overseas Filipino workers (OFWs) in Hong Kong and other parts of China might suffer the same fate.

Senator Joel Villanueva said that even with the presence of illegal Filipino workers in other countries, the Philippines should continue to enforce its laws on foreigners who are unlawfully staying or working in the country.

"This is a matter of enforcing our own rules and regulations, not just for the protection of jobs for Filipinos but also the protection of the rights of the workers regardless of nationality," Villanueva said.

"If you are illegal, you have no right and you are not protected by laws," he added.

The chair of the Senate labor committee said the President was apparently being fed with the "wrong data." During the committee's inquiry on the influx of illegal foreign workers in the Philippines, Villanueva, who was also former TESDA chief, used latest government data to belie claims that the country lacks enough local skilled workers to satisfy the jobs being given to the Chinese.

Senate President Vicente Sotto III, echoed Villanueva, also believed that illegal Chinese workers, should be kicked out.

The opposition lawmaker lamented that the Philippines has been indifferent to the "illegal" moves made by Chinese, recalling the shipment of multi-billion peso illegal drugs from China and the giant country's reclamation in the West Philippines Sea.



DOJ junks tax evasion charge vs. actor Richard Gutierrez

The Department of Justice (DOJ) has junked complaints of tax evasion filed by the Bureau of Internal Revenue (BIR) against actor Richard

Gutierrez and his production company.

Assistant State Prosecutor Christine Perolino dismissed the case for lack of probable cause.

Gutierrez and his company RGUTZ Productions Corp. have been accused of violating the National Internal Revenue Code (NIRC). According to BIR, the actor allegedly under-declared sales of P39.6 million and evaded P7.4 million in income tax and P11.1 million

in VAT.

Perolino said there is no sufficient evi-

Perolino said there is no sufficient evidence to charge Gutierrez in court, with BIR claiming he did not pay taxes in 2012.

In another resolution, DOJ likewise secured the dismissal of BIR's falsification and perjury complaints, which stated that he allegedly submitted fake Annual Income Tax Return as well as Quarterly Value Added Tax Return (QVATR).

After weighing the parties' evidence, DOJ decided that the charges "appears lacking" in the case.

"Likewise, the subject returns submitted by respondent showed that RGUTZ filed its returns and accordingly paid its taxes," one of the resolutions stated.

Manila-wide CCTV needed to reduce crime

MANILA—The Department of the Interior and Local Government said a project meant to install 12,000 CCTV cameras in Metro Manila and Davao City will help prevent crime and improve authorities' response time to crime incidents.

DILG undersecretary Epimaco Densing said that through the Safe Philippines project, the government aims to reduce crime in those cities by 15 percent and improve response time by 25 percent.

"In other countries where they have a CCTV monitoring system they've already improved their crime prevention by at least 20 to 30 percent," Densing told ANC's "Future Perfect."

Critics, however, said the project raises national security concerns. Senator Ralph Recto has expressed concern the system could be exploited for spying by China.

Densing, however, defended the project saying there will be safeguards put in place, as the Department of Information and Communications Technology will take part in designing the system.

"They can put in the necessary security, data, security, firewalls to be able to address this issue of China being able to get data from us," Densing said.

The company that will implement the project, however, will have to be from China as officials there insisted that, "since they will be financing the project, the contractor should come from them."

House SALN rules go against transparency

MANILA - While the House of Representatives is demanding transparency in the budget process, it is doing the opposite with regard to its members' financial statements and net worth, according to Sen. Sherwin Gatchalian.

The House's new proposed rules for the release of its members' statement of assets, liabilities and net worth (SALN), an accountability document, have drawn flak for making it more difficult and expensive to obtain these public records.

P300 per document

Among the new rules is the P300 fee for each document in a House composed of 303 members, and the requirement of majority approval of the request in plenary session.

Gatchalian said the Senate had no plans to

revise its own rules, while Senate President Vicente Sotto III said the chamber followed the same rules as the Supreme Court in releasing these documents.

In an interview with reporters, Gatchalian said all public servants should be ready to disclose their finances, and the disclosures are meant to be shared with the people.

He said the process for members of the public and the media to secure copies of public officials' SALNs must be simple and transparent.

This goes with the territory when running for public office, Gatchalian pointed out.

"Every time you become a candidate, you should be ready to show all your assets and income sources through your SALN. That's a standard for all officials," he said.

Palace urges review

Malacañang said that while it would not meddle with the legislative branch, it was urging a review of the House rules on releasing SALNs to avoid any possible challenge to the legality of those rules.

"We hope the House deliberates more on this because it may be running the risk of being questioned later on," presidential spokesperson Salvador Panelo said.

He pointed out that the House resolution setting out the new rules may be challenged in court by taxpayers if it turns out to be a violation of the 1987 Constitution.

"The taxpayer can do something about it, question it if it's in violation of the Constitution," Panelo said.

Filipinos urged to sharpen English proficiency for 'Al age'

MANILA - While Education Secretary Leonor Briones Briones reminded campus journalists the need to strengthen lessons and efforts in enhancing the grammar and spelling skills of stu-



dents, saying "You need to sharpen your grammar and spelling because the comma, semi-colon, [or] a question mark can change the entire meaning of a sentence or the message you are

trying to convey," she said.


But not just journalists.

Filipinos need to sharpen their English proficiency to be able to adapt to the jobs of the future, an education advocate said.

Too Much Sleep May Bring Heart Disease, Death Risk

Adults who get more than the recommended amount of sleep have an increased risk of heart disease and death, a

Rates of heart disease (such as stroke or heart failure) and death were 7.8 per 1,000 among those who slept the recommended six to eight hours per night, compared with 8.4 per 1,000 among those who slept eight to nine hours, 10.4 per 1,000 among those who slept nine to 10 hours, and 14.8 per 1,000 among those who slept more than 10 hours a night. That translates into a 5 percent, 17 percent and 41 percent increased risk, respectively, CNNreported. The rate among people who slept six or less hours a night was 9.4 per 1,000, or 9 percent higher than those who got the recommended amount of sleep, but this was statistically insignificant, according to Chuangshi Wang, McMaster and Peking Union Medical College, China, and colleagues.

They said the increased risk of heart disease and death in people who sleep more than the recommended amount may be because they have underlying health problems that cause them to sleep longer.

The authors of the study published Dec. 5 in the European Heart Journal also found that daytime napping was associated with an increased risk of heart disease and death among those who slept more than six hours a night, but not among those who got less sleep.

"Even though the findings were very interesting they don't prove cause and effect," Julie Ward, a senior cardiac nurse at the British Heart Foundation, who was not involved in the study, told CNN.

"It's not that long sleep causes death or ill health," but that poor health causes an increase in sleep, Francesco Cappuccio, professor of cardiovascular medicine and epidemiology, Warwick University, U.K., told CNN. He was not involved in the study.

TORONTO - Weed has been legal across Canada for nearly six months but Toronto's medical officer of health is sounding the alarm over cannabis edibles and kids.

The federal government is expected to loop edibles into legalization later this year but

Dr. Eileen de Villa is calling for a ban on the sale of ones that look like candy — such as gummy bears and lollipops.

She said other jurisdictions that have candy-shaped edibles on the market, such as Colorado and Washington State, have seen problems, including accidental ingestion.

"They noted that accidental ingestion of cannabis products increased post-legalization and that a significant number of those cases were, in fact, due to products that were appealing to youth and young children, mistaken as just regular candies and in fact were cannabis containing candies," she said.


De Villa noted that she is in favour of the legalization of marijuana, as well as the introduction of edibles into the market, she just wants there to be certain restrictions.

Despite, her helpers also get benefits like contribution to the Social Security System (SSS), Philhealth, and Pag-ibig. When the host, Boy, asked what the reaction of the helpers were when she brought up the idea of a contract?

'They were very touched," she answered. "Because they didn't feel they deserve one." "Also if something happens, you can't be mad at them when you forget your charger when that's not their job," she related. "It also gives them dignity to have a piece of paper. Of course, people are always scared to lose their jobs, right? So I also had to exto my helpers that 'Listen, I can't fire yo I'm in a bad mood or I'm hungry."

On the other hand, Isabelle also encourages her housemaids to save up.

"I gave them a bank account, I said 'Okay, 'pag December na titignan ko kung magkano na naipon mo and dodoblehin ko," she shared. "I think that gets them to have a target also. And that makes them feel that this isn't finite, this amount, every month."

"I'm going to be very busy. For my television project, instead of love story for a TV series, I changed genre. Now, it's family drama...issues and problems surrounding members of the family. There will be a bit of romance but it will not be highlighted that much," JM revealed.

"We're trying to do away with romcom especially in movies. I wanted to do offbeat characters. I think, the management is allowing me to do that," he added.

The actor, who is doing a movie with Arci Muñoz, which he describes as a "romcom within a romcom," said he's glad that his management is very supportive of his effort to give his fans and supporters something fresh, new, and different.

"In this movie, Arci is a purist, she doesn't like romcom, she didn't want to do formula films until she gets employed by a production company where her main assignments are to do romcom films. So, it's like she's thrown into a situation that she didn't like but she's forced to do it kasi kelangan sa trabaho," he explained.

In speaking of doing films, JM personally wants characters that would highlight his passion for acting. If given an opportunity, he would like to portray challenging characters like that of James Mcvoy's role in Split, where he plays a man suffering from dissociative identity disorder (DID), who has 23 prominent personalities.

"It's interesting if I'd portray a role with multiple personalities. I'd really love to do psycho thriller films. It's when you really get into your character and stretches your limits as an actor," he shared.

KATRINA during her Suklay Diva days The 24-yearsinger Katrina through Velarde went before meriting a blip on Philippine celebrity radar. She's been her family's breadwinner starting at six years old. She would join singing contests here, there and everywhere - sometimes six contests in a week - with umphs mingling equally with the tears. Life for Katrina was

so hard then that there were days they could only afford to buy cup noodles for their meals. She would also sell sampaguita on the streets in leaner times. She was forced to stop schooling at second year high school.

"I was super stressed out," she remembered. Then she turned to YouTube. Her "gimmick" was to do versions of her favorite songs while holding a comb. This would later earn for her the moniker "Suklay Diva."

"But my videos weren't noticed right away," she pointed out. "In the beginning, hardly any-body watched the videos. It was hard. It took years before the number of views and subscribers started climbing."

Things turned around when she did a video of herself performing Beyonce's "Dangerously In Love." The international superstar's bass player saw it and shared it on Beyonce's Facebook, which, of course, got the video going viral.

In a sea of vloggers, Katrina stands out by researching on fan favorites, then tweaking it to fit her vocal style and range.

"It's important to reinvent the songs or it will just be one of so many online," she pointed out. So, was it happily-ever after from then on?

Well, to be fair, she got her share of breaks. Recall that she first appeared on TV via the ABS-CBN singing competition "Little Big Star." Katrina also made it to the grand finals of the second season of "Talentadong Pinoy" in 2010. After that, she competed in the first season of "The X-Factor Philippines" as member of all-girl vocal group AKA JAM under the tutelage of Gary Valenciano.

But when she got pregnant three years ago, she also got Bell's Palsy; a condition in which the muscles on one side of the face becomes weak or paralyzed, thus, causing it to droop or become stiff on that side.

For a professional singer who needs full control of her mouth, lips and cheeks to enunciate the words of a song and move these three to hit the notes correctly, to have Bell's Palsy is nothing short of devastating.

Katrina remembers turning down so many opportunities in that period of her life, simply because the singer can't sing at all.

"I was afraid I wouldn't be able to sing again," she said. "And if that's the case, I thought, 'What would happen to my family? My baby?"

Fortunately, her condition continues to improve, thanks largely to therapy. Yes, she still has Bell's Palsy but hardly anyone can tell by the way she hits those high notes and just wows everyone who hears her sing.

"It's a struggle but I'm learning how to make

the best of my situation - I have to."

Indeed, because of all the things she had gone through, Katrina knows how to manage her expectations.

"I don't aim for myself to become a big star though, of course, I have dreams too," she said. "It's just that I'm not the type of person who expects too much. As they say, less expectations, less disappointments.

"I'll just go with the flow and count my blessings as they come."

Miss Universe on rising HIV-AIDS cases:

'Get tested'



Reigning Miss Universe Catriona Gray has encouraged the public to have themselves tested following an alarming increase in the number of HIV-AIDS (human immunodeficiency virus-acquired immune deficiency syndrome) cases in the Philippines.

"If you've never been tested before for HIV, I have my first testing experience up on my YouTube channel in partnership with @ loveyourself.ph. If I can do it, you can too. Get tested, know your status. Love yourself," said Gray on Instagram.

Grav cited a report from loveyourself. ph that showed an alarming increase in the number of HIV cases in the Philippines for the past 10 years.

"In the last ten years, we've seen the cases of new HIV cases in the Philippines rise exponentially from only 1 a day in 2008 to 32 a day in 2018." she said.

Loveyourself.ph is a community of volunteers in the country that conducts HIV counseling, testing, treatment, and life coaching. The HIV-AIDS is one of the advocacies of the Miss Universe Organization.

Gray said: "While the numbers appear alarming, the data shows us that we've been able to reach the affected population and increase the access to testing, which is a key step to stop the rising epidemic."

"To accelerate our vision to eradicate HIV, it starts with educating ourselves and then taking steps to get tested and to continue to take steps to care for ourselves,"

The Filipino-Australian beauty queen said that she has been tested for HIV-AIDS and yielded negative results.

"If you've never been tested before for HIV, I have my first testing experience up on my YouTube channel in partnership with @ lovevourself.ph." she said.

Gray called on the public to check out the websites of loveyourself.ph and Department of Health for the HIV test sites in Metro Manila and in the provinces.

She also said that the only way to prevent HIV-AIDS is by early detection through testing and early treatment. "Testing in the Philippines is free."

Campaign urges men to share house work with women

In interviews with 541 respondents from Eastern Samar, Leyte, Cotabato, Maguindanao, and Sultan Kudarat, it appeared that women spend up to 12 hours a day on "unpaid care work," meaning household tasks like meal preparation, laundry, and childcare. With at least half a day spent on these chores, women and girls are often hindered from taking up pursuits in education, employment, political engagement, and leisure activities.

The WE-CARE (Women's Economic Empowerment and Care) Project, implemented by Oxfam in the Philippines and its partners, sheds light on this overlooked issue with "I LABA YU," a campaign to encourage men to share in household chores, particularly laundry, and counter the false notion that domestic work is solely a woman's job. The WE-Care project study also finds that the burden of unequal care work is not just a household issue, but also needs to be prioritized by communities and across institutions, including the Philippine government and the private sector.

The work of women is often invisible and so there is a need to resurface and recognize this issue as it limits the rights and opportunities of women. This is especially true for women living in poverty," said Amparo Miciano, Executive Director of PKKK, a national coalition of rural women, and a partner in the WE CARE Project.

I LABA YU believes that by sharing household chores and responsibilities, like washing clothes, husband and wife also spend quality time together, working and communicating, thereby strengthening their marriage.

The campaign pushes a four-step method called the "4Rs" to address care work overload: Recognition. Reduction, Redistribution, and Representation;

"The "4 Rs" to address disproportionate burdens on women will involve: recognizing the value of care work and shifting negative attitudes toward gender roles; reducing hours spent on care tasks; redistributing care work responsibilities equitably across all sectors in society; and ensuring carers are represented in decisionand policy-making," said Maria Rosario Felizco, Country Director of Oxfam in the Philippines.

In the Philippines, the City of Tacloban and the Municipality of Salcedo in Eastern Visayas have enacted ordinances on unpaid care work, which means that this issue will be included in their planning and budgeting, and will improve women's access to safe water and childcare centers.

Avoid Washer-Dryer Combo

The washing aspect works fine, but drying takes a couple hours longer than a separate machine would.

But brand after brand has tried to make all-in-one laundry happen, yet decades later, the machines are still not popular. You can't wash new loads while you wait for the dryer, either, so laundry day slows to a crawl. All-in-ones also have high repair rates and aren't much cheaper to buy than separate machines, so they'll almost always cost you more in the long run.

Steve Sheinkopf, owner and CEO of Yale Appliance says: "I hate these things," he told us. The repair rate is sky high—over 70 percent within the first year.

If you have no other practical choice for washing and drying your laundry, you could consider getting an all-in-one washer-dryer combo.

For example, if you live in an RV or on a boat, a very small home, space is at a premium and hang-drying your clothes is not practical, so an all-in-one combo is probably the only good option.

But if you have the space for a separate washer and dryer—even a compact pair—skip the combo unit. But as far as we can tell, the downsides aren't worth it for most people who can avoid it.

Arjo Atayde rolls with the punches — but he throws some, himself



Arjo Atayde has a secret to his upward trajectory in show business: He tries everything at least once.

Never picky with roles, Arjo has done comedy, action, drama, and even romance movies and TV shows. For his efforts, he had won several Philippine Movie Press Club (PMPC) Star Awards for Television trophies from 2012 to 2016 as Best New Male TV Personality, Best Drama Supporting Actor, Best Single Performance by an Actor, and Best Drama Supporting Actor.

"I don't want to be boxed into a certain role," he told Bulletin Entertainment in an exclusive interview. "If there are 275 types of roles, I'd like to do each of those. I want to do it all, do something different all the time - not to impress or prove anything, but just to feed my dreams, meet my standards as actor."

It takes effort and time to reinvent oneself, he pointed out. And to do it from time to time could be tiring but ultimately gratifying.

In past months, Arjo has been doing three different characters for various projects. His

upcoming movies are "Tol," a comedy about brotherhood; and "Stranded," about two people with opposite views in life locked up

He is currently seen on television series "The General's Daughter" where he's been getting good reviews. On the show, Arjo is Elai, a young man with autism.

At one point, he was doing three different characters at the same time and every day. Did it get confusing at times?

"Honestly, I don't know how I did it," he said, laughing. "I guess I just have to be true to what I'm doing. I just have to believe that each of the characters I play is real. It has to sink in. I have to smell the place, I have to feel

the table, I have to feel everything. I'm that kind of learner."

Once, the method actor went to a place for people with mental condi-

tion. It was his way of researching a character with similar health predisposition.

Another technique he uses is to come up with a make-up story in his head about the background of the character he plays. This way, he said, he "knows" where the character is coming from.

"Like, when I was doing Joaquin on 'Ang FPJ's Probinsyano' I was having a difficult time getting mad because I hardly get mad in real life. So, I had to find out how my character got conceited. I invented his backstory from his high school years onward. After that, it was easy," Arjo said.

The actor also analyzes his similarities and differences with the character he plays.

He shared that despite being relatively new

in the business, he has never felt insecure. "My only competition is myself," he said like a mantra.

Call him a good actor and he'll throw the compliment to the ground.

'We're always learning, either from your co-actors or when you watch yourself," he said. "You can't allow yourself to think you're already good at your craft."

Lessons learned

Is it hard growing up as son of an established actor, Sylvia Sanchez?

"Well, I was exposed to the industry because of her," he began. "But also, because of how good an actress she is, I think people have so much expectations from me. There's a little pressure there but that's it."

There was a point Arjo was getting rejected in auditions. He hibernated for a year until Sylvia encouraged him to take acting work-

"But my ego as a teenager resisted at first. I said, 'No, I'm not gonna join (any workshop).' Eventually, I realized I've got nothing to lose. Besides - I told myself - I want to meet girls," he said with a laugh. "Of course, those were all in my younger days."

The most important advice from her mom is to "always respect everybody."

Asked if he gets affected by criticisms he gets online, Arjo shrugged his shoulders.

"No, because how can I fight nameless, faceless, brainless people? You face me, you tell me the problem. Don't do it on social media," he said.

"Actually I find them (bashers) funny. I tell them to keep it coming."

He has this to say to those still wondering if coming out of the closet is worth it or not.

First, come out only when you're ready. Remember to do it for yourself, and not for the sake of other people.

Along the way

He is the grandson of the late Inday Badiday, and

the son of entertainment personality Dolly Anne Carvajal. He was male child actor in the '90s who starred in films as "Darna," "Pido Dida 3: May Kambal Na!" and "Pretty Boy," among others.


