Philippines eyes 100% vax target

DOH says inoculating all will stop community transmission of variants

PHILIPPINES - The Philippines may increase its COVID-19 immunity vaccination target from 70 percent to 100 percent of the country's population to prevent community transmission of emerging coronavirus variants, a Department of Health (DOH) official said.

Health Undersecretary Leopoldo Vega said the 70 per-

cent target would only protect people from severe infection from the original coronavirus strain.

"With the new variants, we need to raise the herd immunity to 90 percent or possibly 100 percent," Vega said in Filipino.

Over 55.4 million individuals have already received at least one

COVID-19 vaccine dose.

Some 37 million individuals are already fully vaccinated, the National COVID-19 Vaccination Dashboard, as of Dec. 4, showed.

With the threat of the Omicron variant, Vega urged the public to get inoculated, saying that vaccines are effective against severe infection even

with the variants.

"This is one of the ways to stop transmission or viral loads of COVID-19," Vega said.

The new variant, which was first detected in South Africa, has been recorded in Europe, United States, and some parts of Asia.

China tells Philippines to leave Ayungin shoal

Meanwhile, two maritime experts asserted that Ayungin Shoal belongs to the Philippines and China has no right to demand the removal of the BRP Sierra Madre from the area, which a UN tribunal affirmed in 2016 is part of Manila's EEZ in the South China Sea.

China's ambassador to Manila expressed confidence that the relationship between Beijing and the Philippines could withstand differences following the incident last week at the Ayungin Shoal.

In a Facebook post, Chi-

nese Ambassador Huang Xilian said it was "normal" for differences to occur "even among best friends and neighbors."

"What matters is how we handle and manage those differences in the spirit of seeking common ground while shelving differences," he added.

However, the Philippines will fully exercise its sovereign rights in the West Philippine Sea, Malacañang reiterate.

"President Duterte has repeatedly reiterated this in various summits, as well as in his speech before the United Nations. We refer to the UNCLOS and arbitral award that Ayungin is within our EEZ (exclusive

the number of new coronavirus disease-2019 (COVID-19) cases had declined, the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) said last November.

DILG Undersecretary Jonathan Malaya said that persons

Enchong Dee sued for cyber libel

Enchong Dee is in hot water.

Congresswoman Claudine Diana Bautista-Lim, party-list representative of Drivers United for Mass Progress and Equal Rights or DUMPER, has filed a cyber libel case at the Office of the Provincial Prosecutor in Davao Occidental against him.

This was allegedly due to Enchong issuing supposed “malicious” and “defamatory” statements against her via social media following her wedding to businessman Jose French Lim Feb. 20 this year in Balesin.

According to Claudine’s complaint, Enchong “went as far as saying that I used public coffers to fund my wedding by categorically saying that ‘The money for commuters and drivers went to her wedding’, to the detriment and injury to my honor and name...”



She added, “The posts were meant nothing more than their malicious intentions of maligning my person, depicting me as a corrupt public official.”

Claudine is seeking moral damages amounting to P500,000,000 as with exemplary damages amounting to P500,000,000 due to the same.

Although she admitted to having learned about Enchong already issuing a public apology about the whole issue prior, she maintained it wasn’t enough.

“He was not sorry to me and for the damage that he has done. He just wants to deflect, albeit unsuccessfully, this criminal charge against him...”

“This does not do any good for him. It only bolstered and magnified his admission of guilt beyond reasonable doubt for his un-provoked and baseless libelous remarks.”

Enchong is yet to issue a statement on the matter.

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'The strong must not trample on the weak'

PRESIDENT Rodrigo Duterte invoked the rule of law in maintaining peace and stability in the South China Sea, stressing there can be "no real peace if the strong trample on the weak."

"Excellencies, we all want progress and prosperity for our peoples. And we know that peace and stability are the preconditions for these to happen. There can be no real peace if the strong trample on the weak — just because it can," Duterte said in his speech during the Asia-Europe Meeting (ASEM) Summit last November 26.

"There can never be another acceptable basis for a just maritime order but the law, particularly the 1982 United Nations Con-

vention on the Law of the Sea (Unclos). All countries — big and small — must adhere to the rule of law faithfully and consistently. Otherwise, there will be chaos," he added.

Duterte reaffirmed the Philippines' position favoring peaceful resolution of territorial disputes despite China's continued aggression in the region.

"Ours is a region full of promise but fraught with potential flashpoints. These include disputes in one of the world's most important sea lanes of communication. The Philippine position is clear and unchanging — disputes must be settled peacefully in accordance with international law," Duterte said.

"The South China Sea must remain a sea of peace, stability and prosperity, where the vital interests of stakeholders inside and outside the region are recognized and respected," he added.

Duterte was grateful for China's willingness to discuss territorial issues.

"We acknowledge China's reaffirmation of commitment to an early conclusion of negotiations on a substantive and effective Code of Conduct on the South China Sea," he said.

The President also thanked ASEM for facilitating dialogue and cooperation among leaders of the two continents.

"We thank our ASEM partners that have issued statements of support on upholding the rule of law in the South China Sea. We also welcome their interest to enhance cooperation, including in maritime security. We are encouraged by these developments," Duterte said.

Duterte's statement came a week after Chinese Coast Guard vessels blocked and water cannoned Philippine boats on a mission to resupply the grounded BRP Sierra Madre at the Ayungin Shoal, a territory being claimed by China.

The Unclos as well as The Hague's 2016 ruling on the South China Sea stated that the Ayungin Shoal was within the Philippines' 370-kilometer exclusive economic zone.

China rejected the ruling.

Rabiya Mateo on ex-BF Neil Salvacion: 'If he needs me, I'm gonna be there as a friend'

There is no bad blood between Rabiya Mateo and her ex-boyfriend Neil Salvacion.

This, even after Neil seemingly used Rabiya's name while auditioning to be part of a show prior, maintaining the beauty queen left him for the Miss Universe Crown.

In a recent interview, Rabiya related that Neil already apologized for it and that they remain friends.

"Hindi basta-basta pinagdaanan namin. But now, I know he's happy. I am happy. I'm happy kung saan kami ngayon," she said.

Pasig City Mayor Vico Sotto was praised after the city government switched hot cocoa brands for its annual Christmas packs to save costs. The city replaced Goya Marshmallow for the more affordable Swiss Miss chocolate, cheaper by a mere peso.

The mayor posted a copy of the city government's purchase order, revealing that Pasig City saved P375,000 in costs.

In a Facebook post, Mayor Vico noted they did not include rice in this year's Pamaskong Handog (Christmas gift) packs to avoid discrepancies.

"Wala pong bigas ang Pamaskong Handog 2021; sa bigas kasi madalas nagkakaproblema kapag ganito karaming packs. Dinamihan na lang natin yung ibang items—mas mabigat to kaysa sa last year!" (This year's Pamaskong Handog does not have rice in its packs; we often run into problems with rice when it comes to these many packs. Instead, we increased the quantities of other items—this bundle is heavier than last year's!)

The mayor also said that the Pamaskong Handog program was proof that it is possible to have governance where people are seen and treated equally, allies or not.

While praising a local government for its transparency is akin to praising a dog for walking on four legs, it's hard not to admire honest governance in this political climate.

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'Outrageous but fun': Claire Castro on her viral, campy scene in 'Nagbabagang Luha'

In a now viral scene from the GMA 7 series "Nagbabagang Luha," the character Cielo, played by Claire Castro, gets busted for faking her pregnancy. And then, in a span of a minute, Cielo gets her hair pulled, slapped around silly, doused in vase water, and had her face shoved repeatedly into a red cake by her boyfriend's mother, Calida (Gina Alajar).

The newbie actor, whose parents are 1990s celebs Diego Castro and Raven Villanueva, thought that the sequence was "outrageous" when she first read the script. But then again, outrageous is par for the course in the sleepy afternoon timeslot, and the scene ended up being watched 2.4 million times on YouTube.

"I was taken aback because some of the things needed to be done were outrageous. But it was fun doing such scenes, compared to just the sweet ones, because you get to express more," she said in a recent Zoom

conference. "I was already sleepy when we did that scene, so I was just happy and running on adrenaline."

Plus, getting manhandled by an award-winning artist like Gina Alajar is a badge she proudly wears. "It's an honor to be slapped by a great actress and director like Direk Gina," she quipped, adding that scene, mercifully, took only one take.

One take

"The setup was long and the blocking lasted an hour. But we did it in one take. Before the scene, Direk Gina told me, 'Claire, this is just a job. I'm sorry, but we have to do it.' After that, someone yelled, 'Action!'" Claire related. "I couldn't open my eyes after because there was so much cake on my face. Three days after, I feel like there's still some left in my ears!"

Looking back, intense scenes like that can be quite therapeutic especially for

someone like Claire who doesn't voice out her feelings often. "I'm the type who gives others many chances, even if they have done me dirty. So, I don't let it (the pain) out immediately. I feel like it's my chance to release those emotions when I do those scenes," she said.

Because she has only been in show biz for two years, the 23-year-old Kapuso talent said she still has much to learn. And working with someone like Gina was exactly what she needed.

Veteran techniques

"I have this process where I curl up in a ball and wait for the tears to come. And Direk Gina was concerned about that, because she believes it would be too draining for me, especially if I have to shoot a lot of crying scenes in one day," she said. "She taught me techniques I could use."

According to many, the swimming area resembles the one that John Lloyd has



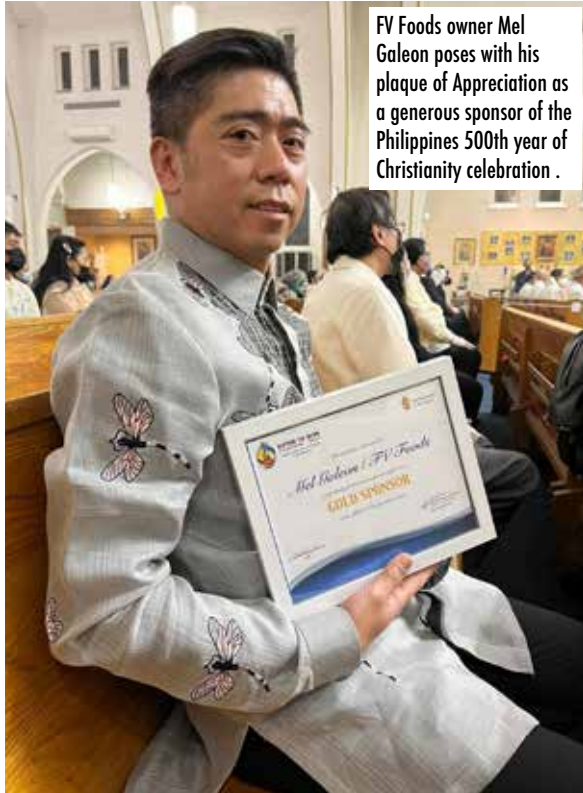
at his rest house in Batangas.

“I like doing offbeat roles because I’m a quiet person and I get to express things I can’t in real life. But I have been told by more experienced coactors that playing pitiable characters is actually challenging. I will study and prepare if I get something like that, because I want to be better.”

must be vaccinated against COVID-19 before conducting caroling indoors, which is subject to the establishment’s capacity.

“Under Alert 2, caroling is allowed provided that (minimum public health standard) is strictly followed and subject to the operational capacity of the venue of the caroling: 50 percent and vaccinated individuals only if indoor, and 70 percent if outdoor,” Malaya said in an interview on ABS-CBN News.

He pointed out that the carolers must wear face shields “as of now” but the policy may change as the Inter-Agency Task Force Against COVID-19 is set to meet on Nov. 11

to decide on the matter in selected areas.

The Metro Manila mayors earlier had strongly pushed for lifting of face shield use except in hospitals and medical facilities with Manila Mayor and presidential hopeful Isko Moreno already implemented the proposal.

Moreno noted that the Palace should ‘go to court’ for Manila to revoke the no face shield policy

Last year, the traditional practice was banned in a bid to curb the spread of the respiratory disease which has so far killed over 44,000 in the country as of Nov. 8.

On Nov. 5 Metro Manila was placed in the more relaxed alert level 2 until Nov. 21 from the previous stricter alert level 3.

via the 24/7 stream of PBB season 10 on Kumu.

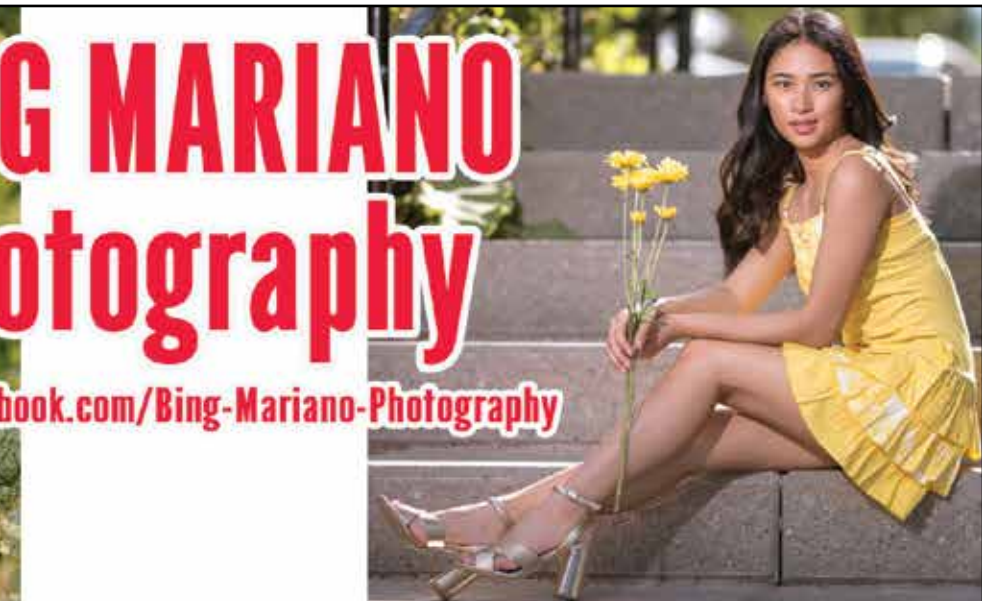
