WRITING ON THE WALL BARELY NOTICED: Old surveys' public opinion tilting in Marcoses' favor

MANILA, Philippines—"You, the people, have spoken. By your vote, you rejected the politics of division.'

These were some of the words of Ferdinand Marcos Jr. on Thursday (June 30) in a speech following his inauguration as

the Philippines' 17th president.

"I am here not to talk about the past. I am here to tell you about our future," he said.

That views on the Marcos family shifted dramatically more than 36 years after the late strongman Ferdinand Marcos

was ousted from power could have been predicted by results of past surveys on people's opinion about the Marcoses.

The change in opinion, as mirrored by results of the survey mainly by the polling firm Social Weather Stations (SWS), has not yet factored in the promises of Marcos Jr.

"A future of sufficiency, even plenty of readily available ways and means to get done what needs doing by you, by me. We do not look back, but ahead," he said in his inaugural speech.

Franz Imperial, who headed one committee for the inauguration, described the ceremony as "solemn and simple."

It was a stark contrast, however, to the inauguration held for the late strongman Marcos

COVID-19 rising in Philippines

MANILA - All regions in week growth rates with some the country continue to see an increase in COVID-19 infections, with 88% of prov- however, have no effect on inces, highly urbanized cities, and independent charter cities showing positive growth rates, according to the Department of Health (DOH).

Based on its regular COVID-19 situationer released to the media, most areas are showing a sharp increase in cases, with the National Capital Region reaching almost 450 cases daily.

While a slight rise in cases was observed in Mindanao in mid-June, it is now showing signs of plateauing with 50 cases recorded per day.

Despite increasing infections, all regions remain under low-risk case classification. This is even if all regions have seen positive tworeaching over 200%.

The positive growth rates, decisions made by the Inter-Agency Task Force as to what a region's alert level may

Recently, the IATF decided to heed the recommendations of experts to remove the two-week growth rate as an indicator to determine a region's risk classification and subsequent alert level.

Former Health Secretary Francisco Duque even said that the two-week growth rate has lost its significance and relevance and may in fact just be an "alarmist" metric.

In a message to reporters, DOH spokesperson and National Vaccination Operations Center chair Maria

Make Filipino medium of instruction, not English

MANILA - Students should be taught using the language that they best understand.

The Alliance of Concerned Teachers (ACT) Philippines, in a statement issued Friday, July 1, said this in reaction to a part of the inaugural address of President Ferdinand "Bongbong" Marcos Jr. pushing for English as a medium of instruction in schools.

ACT Philippines Vladimer Quetua noted that while the metrics of international assessments like the Program for International Student Assessment (PISA) and Trends in International Mathematics and Science Study are questionable, "language barrier is a basic reason why the Philippines lag behind and our students are at a disadvantage in these tests."

Quetua pointed out that countries that usually take the top tier of these assessments are those whose main medium of instruction is

Mo Twister exerted 'no effort' to support daughter with disability, Bunny Paras says


Former actress Bunny Paras spoke about the condition of Moira, her daughter with Mo Twister, and revealed that the radio personality exerted "no effort" to support

Robredo launches NGO for Angat Buhay programs

MANILA - Last July 1, former Vice President Leni Robredo announced the launching of Angat Pinas Incorporated that will continue the works of the Angat Buhay program, which she started during her vice presidency.

The NGO's name will be Angat Pinas Incorporated due to the existence of another company named Angat Buhay. However, the program's name will remain as Angat Buhay.

Angat Buhay NGO is poised to become the widest volunteer network in the country.

The establishment of the organization was driven by the hundreds of thousands of people who volunteered during the campaign of Robredo, who will now chair the NGO.

"Hindi dapat masayang yung magandang

nasimulan natin. Hindi man tayo nagwagi, nagtagumpay pa rin tayo. We really started something very very special during the campaign," said the former vice president. The NGO will primarily have four pillars: health, education, disaster relief and rehabilitation, and community engagement. At the height of Covid-19 crisis, Robredo, through the Angat Buhay program, managed to provide free transportation service as well as dormitories to frontline workers. Her office also provided vaccines to market vendors and drivers, and free health consultation to those in need. In terms of education, Angat Buhay provided, among others, free dormitories to children who live far away from their schools. While

in disaster relief and rehabilitation, Robredo's office responded to bring basic necessities in areas affected by typhoons, earthquakes or volcanic eruptions. Angat Buhay will have its own phone application, where interested individuals can donate. There are three choices: patron-based donations, which will be done on a regular basis; project-based donations, the funds of which will be dedicated for a certain project; and disaster relief fund, which will collect funds for future disasters.

Pacquiao could suffer same fate as Donaire if he makes a boxing comeback

MANILA - Retired eight-division champion Manny Pacquiao would be courting disaster and could suffer a similar fate to Nonito Donaire Jr. should he decide to make a boxing comeback according to veteran boxing analyst Atty. Ed Tolentino.

Donaire, 39, suffered a second-round demolition at the hands of Japanese superstar Naoya Inoue earlier this month. Pacquiao, meanwhile, last fought in August when he was defeated by Yordenis Ugas, and it is rumored that he is looking

to make a comeback.

"It is always, always a possibility," said Tolentino answered if Pacquiao could suffer the same fate as Donaire Jr.

"When a fighter has been caught by Father Time, he is courting this kind of ending. That is the sad story of boxers, the one fight too many syndrome. They cannot admit to themselves that the reflexes are no longer there. They find it hard to accept that."

According to the respected analyst, even some of the greatest fighters in boxing history



had to exit the sport with a loss after they fought past their prime. According to Tolentino, it is about knowing when to hang it up for good.

"Whan a boxer becomes champion, the machismo is he is the toughest guy in the world. They cannot accept that is gone. They cannot accept that it

has been taken off and there is no more cloak of invincibility," Tolentino noted.

"That is hard for a boxer to accept when he was once the king of the world. Few won in their farewell appearance. They did not beat Father Time, they were wise enough to avoid Father Time."



Grand International

Despite being body-shamed by Miss Grand Thailand 2019 Coco Arayha Suparurk in 2019, Miss Universe 2018 Catriona Gray does not believe that the Philippines should withdraw from Miss Grand International.

It can be recalled that in a viral photo, the then Miss Grand Nakhon Phanom 2019 Suparurk posted a photo of Catriona next to Miss Grand International (MGI) 2018 Clara Sosa and described Clara as "fit" and Catriona as "fat."

Suparurk has since suffered the consequences, breaking down at a press conference and admitting that she had a "feeling of suffering for a long time" due to social media bashing following her controversial post.

Since then, Catriona has been vocal against body-shaming, saying in defense of Miss Universe 2021 Harnaaz Sandhu who was also recently body-shamed: "It affects not just Miss Universe titleholders, but all women. And by extension of that, all people in a way. It sends a message that you're not beautiful if you don't meet this criteria for a body type or weight, and it's just a horrible message to put out there."

The weight-shaming of Catriona, plus allegations that MGI is reportedly biased in

in 1986, just hours before he and his family fled as a bloodless people power revolt was starting to reach the doorsteps of Malacañang, the seat of power.

Public opinion then was heavily stacked against the Marcoses.

In a survey conducted in May 1986, just two months after Marcos' ouster, SWS said 51 percent of Filipinos agreed with the statement that the late strongman, during his 21-year rule, had stolen billions of government funds.


Over 20 years later, if the votes—31.6 million—received by Marcos Jr. last May 9 were any indication, Filipinos' perception of the Marcoses has indeed "softened". As Sen. Imee Marcos said in 2018, "we don't need to keep hating for a very long time."

All for 'reconciliation, unity'

In 2010, Marcos Jr. ran for senator and won with 13.1 million votes. Six years later, he launched a bid for the vice presidency. Although with 14.2 million votes, he lost to Robredo.

His sister, Imee, after governing the province of Ilocos Norte for nine years as governor, won a seat in the Senate in 2019. She received 15.9 million votes in the elections then.

This, even if in 2016, the SWS said that 44 percent of Filipinos



agreed that there was oppression when the late Marcos declared martial law in 1972 until he was ousted from Malacañang in 1986.

SWS said from 1986 to 1998, Filipinos' perception of the late Marcos with regard to corruption allegations shifted from unfavorable to neutral. With regard to oppression, opinion shifted from neutral to favorable.

Leaving the past behind?

There was no explanation on why perception about the Marcos family has "softened" through the years. Critics said the Marcoses,

since they went back home in 1991, have engaged in a bid to restore the family's image.

University of the Philippines (UP) Prof. Danilo Arao, convenor of election watchdog Kontra Daya, said last February that when the Marcoses returned to the Philippines, there was no "sorry" for excesses committed.

He said that without clear recognition of the past and with an appeal to "give us a chance," the Marcoses successfully paved the way for their political comeback, especially to the seat of power. But Dr. Froilan Calilung, a political science professor at the University of

Santo Tomas, told government network PTV-4 last May that Marcos Jr.'s massive lead in the elections was because of his "simple" message of unity. He said Filipinos got "sick and tired" of the divisiveness that has defined politics in the Philippines for a "very, very long time". He said, "In the midst of this, the message of unity from Marcos Jr. came."

For instance, 60-year-old construction worker Florencio Collado said that he voted for Marcos Jr. on May 9 because "nothing much has changed" since the year the dictatorship came to an end.



Rosario Vergeire explained that the twoweek growth rate represents the speed of case increase or decrease.

This was also how health authorities monitored the speed of infections during the Delta and Omicron surges.

"However, with very low case numbers observed over the past months, we noted that the TWGR was not a suitable metric in classifying areas' alert levels. Given the very small cases reported, minimal increases in number of new cases may translate to very high TWGRs," she said.

The two-week growth rate, according to Vergeire is still used, but only internally.

"Given that there is the risk of new variants emerging that are more transmissible or immune escaping, we utilize TWGRs as part of our internal monitoring for earlier detection of sudden and large increases that may signal the entry or impact of these emerging variants."

As such the agency has flagged 89 areas for case increases; 57 have shown positive one-week and two-week growth rates and 32 with either a positive one or two-week growth rate. Lucena City, Bohol and Tawi-Tawi have also logged either a moderate to critical risk ICU bed utilization

On a national scale, however, ICU utilization remains low-risk with a 15% oc-

The agency continues to note a decline in fatalities from the peak of the Omicron-driven surge in January with an average of one death per day in May 2022.

Maxene Magalona, on being bullied while growing up, having complex PTSD

Maxene Magalona got real on the bullying she experiended, my so-called friends took my enced while growing up, and expressed appreciation for her "spiritual awakening" as an adult.

The actress, who revealed in 2020 that she was diagnosed with complex post-traumatic stress disorder (C-PTSD), opened up about her experience with bullying in her Instagram post today, July 1.

"I used to spend so much time and energy in pretending to be someone I'm not just to fit in and belong. I used to worry about what other people think of me. I was so scared to be left out," she said.

According to Magalona, she has now learned to appreciate solitude, describing it as "quite underrated." She also considers being alone as a way to connect with her "authentic power."

"I remember being bullied growing up. Some of my schoolmates would mock me by following me around campus while singing some of my Dad's songs," she recalled. "When one of my TV commercials came out, they would make fun of me by imitating my acting and laughing in my face. When one of my relationships

ex-boyfriend's side, stopped talking to me and started gossiping about me behind my back.

Magalona noted that one of the most common causes of C-PTSD is bullying and this can cause someone to grow up "living in fear and doubt."

"You will become a people-pleasing adult who has low self-esteem and no sense of self-worth. We all want to be seen, heard and valued. But often times, we change who we are and do things that we don't really want to do in order to be liked by

others," she told fans. "Now, ever since I went on the path of self-healing [and] spiritual awakening, I've learned to value and respect myself so much that I actually protect my energy by not allowing just anyone to have access to it," she added. Magalona stressed that her self-worth is no longer defined by others and

she no longer wants to be "part of the crowd" just to gain approval. "So please, do me a favor and count me out. I'm here to follow God," she said. Back in 2020, Magalona assured people

who are diagnosed with PTSD that they are not alone and she related to them. The actress then recalled in October last year that she felt like her world "came crashing down" after the death of her father, singer Francis Magalona. She

described that period in her life as "very toxic," but she is now trying to "heal naturally" by adding yoga and meditation to her lifestyle.







their national language, "that is why learning is well facilitated, and they perform better in the tests which were conducted in their own languages."

The assessment is done in English as it is the main medium of instruction.

"This is a big impediment to student learning because they have to master the English language first before they can learn science and math concepts," he explained. "In the classroom, they also cannot freely express themselves because English is not their vernacular,"

he added. Quetua added that dilemma also clips the learners' ability for "critical thinking and in formulating arguments."

While there is the Mother Tongue-Based Multilingual Education (MTB MLE) Law and the Bilingual Education Policy, Quetua said that the "reality is that English remains to be the language predominantly used in our educational system" noting that subjects such as Mathematics at Science are taught in English. Quetua pointed out that materials used in teaching written in local languages remain limited.

ACT urged the Marcos administration to strengthen the use of Filipino as a medium of instruction in schools to help students learn and understand the lessons bet-

Filipino as a medium of instruction, the group said, should also be institutionalized and the efforts to strengthen it should also be given sufficient funding.

ACT also reacted to Marcos' push to "rethink the education curriculum so that students will get better jobs" - noting that the focus should also be centered on national development.


