

Chinese militia ships swarm Julian Felipe Reef in WPS



Marcos catches COVID-19 for 3rd time

MANILA — President Marcos has caught COVID-19 for the third time, but remains healthy enough to carry out his duties, Malacañang said yesterday.

As advised by his doctors, Marcos is under a mandatory five-day period of isolation for COVID-19 patients, the Presidential Communications Office (PCO) said.

"The President remains fit to carry out his duties and will be continuing his scheduled meetings via teleconference. Updates on his health will be provided as available," the PCO said.

The Senate, meanwhile, is again allowing a hybrid public hearing after Sen. Cynthia Villar tested positive for COVID-19 while other senators fell ill.

Marcos, through the PCO, has urged the public to remain vigilant and continue observing health protocols during the Christmas season.

"During this holiday season, President Marcos encourages the public to take precautions to safeguard their health, such as vaccinating and voluntary mask-wearing when entering crowded places," the PCO said.

Marcos, 66, was last seen in public on Saturday for the Family Day celebration of the Office of the President in Malacañana.

The President cancelled his activities yesterday, including visits to Mindanao to attend to the victims of the bombing at the Mindanao State University on Sunday and the magnitude 7.4 earthquake in Surigao del Sur late Saturday.

Marcos tested positive for COVID-19 in July 2022 and in March 2020. He received his second COVID-19 booster dose in August 2022.

The Philippines logged 1,340 new COVID-19 cases from Nov. 28 to Dec. 4, the highest number of fresh infections in 19 weeks, according to the Department of Health (DOH).

But Health Secretary Teodoro Herbosa said at a Commission on Appointments (CA) hearing yesterday that he is not recommending yet the mandatory wearing of face masks, in response to a question from Sen. Nancy Binay.

"We recommend the optional wearing of masks for people of high risks, elderly and people in an enclosed place like here in this meeting room where there are too many people, especially if you are prone to illness," Herbosa said.

In October 2022, Marcos issued Executive Order 7 lifting the mandatory wearing of face masks indoors, except in medical facilities and public transportation.

Mask-wearing, however, is still encouraged for the elderly, individuals with comorbidities, immunocompromised, pregnant women, unvaccinated individuals and symptomatic individuals, the EO stated.

Villar positive In a message to reporters, Villar said she tested positive for COVID-19 four days ago but her antigen test yesterday turned out negative.

"I was positive last Thursday. (The test was held at) I p.m. I'm negative today as per antigen. I'm waiting for the RT-PCR result," Villar said. She had her first COVID-19 infection in August 2022.

Also at the CA hearing, Sen. Bong Go cited the need for "response measures" in the face of rising global cases of influenza.

"Another issue is the rising cases of influenza, this walking pneumonia. There are reports of a surge in cases of respiratory illnesses in China. The Netherlands has also reported cases related to the bacteria that causes walking pneumonia," Go said.

He said Filipinos should learn from their experience during the pandemic years.

"Cases of flu are increasing. We should learn from what happened during our COVID-19 pandemic lessons; you (Herbosa) became a big part of the COVID response. Of course, other DOH officials, thank you for your sacrifice during the pandemic, we don't want to waste what we all worked for." Go said.

While acknowledging the rising cases of flu, Herbosa said there is no outbreak yet. "It's true that there are many flu cases not only in China but now in other countries in Europe and reported increased respiratory illness in children. But it's not attributed to the new virus, previous microbes, mycoplasma pneumonia, the respiratory syncytial virus, influenza," Herbosa said.

"In the Philippines, there is no outbreak yet according to our Epidemiology Bureau, although there are many cases because this is a season of respiratory illness," he pointed out.

"And my advice is the same. What we learned during COVID, social distancing, wearing face masks to avoid getting infected, if a child is sick, don't let them go to school," the DOH secretary added.

"There are many parties, many Christmas celebrations. If you have a cough or a cold, don't attend the party because you might infect other people at the party, let us watch our health, just reminders, especially during the Christmas celebration," he said.

Cristy Fermin also feels 'vindicated' after Kath-Niel confirm split

Apart from Ogie Diaz, TV host and showbiz columnist Cristy Fermin likewise feels "vindicated" after Kathryn Bernardo and Daniel Padilla's breakup was confirmed — as she noted that her earlier allegations were indeed true.



Canadian senator aims to project Filipinos as 'talented professionals, achievers'

The first female Canadian senator with Filipino heritage would use her voice and position in the Parliament to break the stereotype on the Filipino people as she noted that a lot of young Filipinos in Canada are now dreaming bigger than ever.

Speaking with reporters at a reception held by Canadian Ambassador to the Philippines David Hartman, Senator Flordeliz 'Gigi' Osler said she wants to ensure that back in Canada, Canadians would "appreciate all of the talents, all of the skills, all of the potential" that Filipinos are able to bring to the table. "We are more than nurses. We are more than migrant workers. We are talented professionals. "And I think that's a dream we all have

Trillanes accuses Duterte of destabilization, coup plot vs Marcos

MANILA, Philippines — Former senator Antonio Trillanes IV has accused former president Rodrigo Duterte of supporting efforts to destabilize and stage a coup against the Marcos administration.

Duterte has denied fomenting destabilization.

Trillanes told "The Chiefs" on Cignal TV's One News on Nov. 11 that Duterte is a "coward" and a power-hungry man who has been laying the foundations for

an uprising.

"At this point in time, I think it is clear that there are plans to return to power by any means. If you're talking about Duterte and Gloria Macapagal-Arroyo, GMA has done it with (former) president Erap (Joseph Estrada)," he said in a mix of English and Filipino.

"Duterte has not experienced a life without being in power. He cannot breathe until he has returned to power. Plus the fact that he is under threat by the International Criminal Court. It's a matter of survival for him and physical freedom. He has the motive to do all these things," he added.

Trillanes, a former soldier who led mutinies against the Arroyo administration in 2003 and 2007, said he agreed with military chief Gen. Romeo Brawner Jr., who said that destabilization and coup plots are two different things – as the for-

mer is mostly political while the latter involves the military with political support.

Citing his experience, Trillanes believes that destabilization and coup plans are currently at the agitation phase with the political component being prepared while online trolls feed agitating issues.

The Marcos and Duterte forces will inevitably have "a head-on collision and one party will either be obliterated or weakened significantly," he said.

TAPE loses 'Eat Bulaga' trademark in favor of TVJ

The Television and Production Expo-(TAPE), Inc. said it will appeal the ruling of the Intellectual Proper-Office of the Philippines (IPOPhl) dismissing its trademark registration for "Eat Bulaga" in favor of its erstwhile hosts, Tito and Vic Sotto, and Joey de Leon, collectively known as TVJ.

Atty Maggie Garduce, counsel for TAPE said the production outfit has vet

receive a copy of the IPOPhl' Bureau of Legal Affairs' decision, but based on reports, it will likely file a motion for reconsideration.

"If this is true, under the rules, TAPE can appeal this decision to the director of the BLA of IPO," Gar-

Garduce said TAPE will exert all efforts to appeal to the IPOPhl's ruling.

"If still unsatisfied with the decision of the director, they (TAPE) can still appeal it to the director general of the IPO. TAPE will avail of all legal actions/ remedies to reverse this decision." she declared.



"People can destroy your image, damage your personality, create rumors about you but they can never take away your good deeds," the message said. "Because no matter how they describe you, you will always be admired by those who know you best."

The next day, Carmina posted a graphic that read, "Mom knows best," and on November 29 yet another graphic, this time of a man peering out of lake dock, which said: "Protect your peace."

The same day of Carmina's initial post, her husband and fellow actor Zoren Legaspi posted a video on his Instagram account of a dinner he had with his two kids and Winwyn Marquez, Dasuri Choi, and Arra San Agustin.

"Keep Smiling guys. It's good to have GENUINE FRIENDS. Ingat kayo," Zoren wrote for the post, to which Carmina commented: "Maraming salamat sa mga tunay na nagmamahal sa mga anak namin. Mahal din namin kayo."

Last month, Kyline had posted on at least two social media accounts, "I knew it," which led to many fans speculating she and Mavy have split, some even linking the latter to Dasuri, who co-hosts "Eat Bulaga" with Mavy.

Eleven Filipino-Canadian teachers in the North attended an Indigenous Seminar hosted by the North Caribou Lake Education Authority(NCLEA) on November 28, 2023 at Weagamow Lake, Kenora District, Ontario, Canada. The special session, a professional development event, was conducted with

the theme: "Education: Building on

the Future of the Nation". It was orga-

nized purposely to "provide a professional opportunity for Non-indigenous teaching staff to learn and understand further indigenous culture".

The whole day seminar- workshop was conducted by the North Caribou Lake Education Authority headed by the Education Director, Board of Directors, and Indigenous Leaders. The Filipino teachers and other participants were led by high school principal Richard Llanera of North Caribou Lake First Nation High School. Richard Llanera is the first secondary school principal in Northern Ontario of Filipino heritage.

Among the educators who attended were Philippine-trained teachers Marisol Agaloos, Mirnalin Alforte, Christopher M. Banes, Ophelia Castanares, Sherwin Dela Pena, Herlene Johnson, Richard Llanera, Maripaz Madarang, Maria Divina Melo, Elsa Rey, and Mae Sajorne, and the non-Filipino educators were Shalini Choudhary, Rekha Kirtee, and Orlando Richards. Two other non-teaching staff, namely Anil Kumar, the school website manager, and Katrina Rizaldo, the school nurse, also participated in the seminar-workshop.

The professional seminar focused on significant infor-

mation about First Nation indigenous heritage, history, and culture. Specifically, the day-long workshop and orientation, delivered through presentations and participatory discussion, included interesting hands-on activities and exercises.

The 6 salient topics covered are: 1. Community Building; 2. Perspectives and Demographics, 3. From the Past to Present and Into the Future; 4. Worldviews; 5. Building Meaningful Relationships; and 6. Anchoring Education.

Carla Abellana to women who are in bad relationships: 'Make sure you don't lose yourself'

Carla Abellana has some words of wisdom for women who are stuck in an unhealthy relationship with their partners.

In an interview with Karen Davila on her YouTube channel, Carla recalled her failed marriage with her ex-husband Tom Rodriguez, whom she married in October 2021 after six years of being together and got divorced in less than a year.

The actress confessed that even she was shocked by how quickly their marriage ended.

"At that time, sabi ko nga, this has got to be one of the fastest or the short-

est [marriage]. I'd say like three months, that's very fast, so at least ngayon I can laugh about it," Carla said.

"Of course, it's not a joke. That's not a good thing that it was very short. Talagang I never imagined that I'd end up getting married and have such a short marriage," she added.

"Disrespect and lying" are some of the many reasons their marriage did not work out, but Carla has since forgiven Tom for what he did.

She has now learned from this experience and become more knowledgeable about spotting red flags in relationships.

When asked what advice she can give to women who are with abusive and un-

faithful partners, Carla said, "I guess my only advice is to make sure you don't lose yourself and you respect yourself pa rin. You don't forget yourself."

"It always comes to a point when enough is enough, so hopefully they know kung hanggang kailan nila kaya," she added.

Carla admitted that she reached a point where she lost herself during her relationship with her ex-husband, but only realized it when it was over.

"The red flags pa lang, parang forgetting about them and not minding them. Doon pa lang parang form of disrespecting yourself because you may have boundaries, pero nagko-cross 'yung boundaries,'

she recalled.

She continued, "Of course, it was a choice to forgive the person and all that to stay in the relationship, pero I never listened to myself."

Despite their long romance that only failed, Carla stressed that she doesn't think of it as if her life got stolen.

"As much as I would like to think and believe na seven years of my life were stolen from me, no naman kasi I was part of that relationship. It was my choice, it was my decision to stay that long," she said.

Rumors about their separation began circulating in January 2022, with Tom confirming that they had ended their relationship in June of the same year.

But at the end of the day, it's really destiny."

Gloria then compared Michelle to her mom by saying, "Michelle is beautiful, she's tall. She's everything. Her mother, on a scale of one to 10, is a 10. Michelle is an eight, but she had a good chance of winning. Why do I say this? It's like if you bought a lotto ticket, you definitely have a chance at winning," she

"I would always tease them, 'Don't worry, if you don't get chosen, I would come up the stage and raise hell. They would always say, 'Mama, that's the No. 1 reason we will never join.' They're not into it. One of us joining a beauty contest is more than enough," she pointed out. "They all look like their father, although Belle got some of her features from me. Belle now has three kids and has lost a lot of weight. She loves to do films. I hope producers have a good role for her."

is the Public Relation Specialist of the Ontario College of Teachers, the professional licensing body for teachers in the province.



located 324 kilometers (175 nautical miles) west of Bataraza, Palawan province, well within the country's exclusive economic zone (EEZ).

This prompted National Security Adviser Gen. Eduardo Año, who also chairs the National Task Force on the West Philippine Sea (NTF-WPS), to order another maritime patrol in response to the "alarming development," PCG spokesperson for West Philippine Sea Commodore Jay Tarriela said.

The PCG's BRP Sindangan and BRP Cabra challenged the Chinese ships on radio during a patrol on December 2 but they received no response. The

ships were "dispersed and scattered" around the reef.

Diplomatic protests

Julian Felipe Reef is considered a low tide elevation within the territorial sea of relevant high tide features in the Kalayaan Island Group, including Chigua Reef, over which the Philippines has sovereignty, Tarriela said.

Chinese militia vessels have been aiding China Coast Guard (CCG) ships in harassing Philippine boats on a resupply mission to Ayungin (Second Thomas) Shoal.

The Philippines first called attention to the "swarming" on Julian Felipe Reef

in 2021. At the time, China said the vessels were only taking shelter due to rough sea conditions.

Several diplomatic protests have since been filed over the presence of Chinese ships in these waters.

Use of water cannon

Early last month, a Chinese vessel again used a water cannon to drive away a Philippine boat on a resupply mission to Philippine troops stationed in Ayungin (Second Thomas) Shoal.

It also said CCG vessels and suspected Chinese maritime militia ships "recklessly harassed, blocked, executed dangerous maneuvers in another attempt to illegally impede or obstruct a routine resupply and rotation mission to BRP Sierra Madre."

Systematic harassment

Last August, the CCG also used water cannon against PCG vessels escorting boats delivering supplies to BRP Sierra Madre, which was grounded on Ayungin Shoal in 1999 to assert Manila's claim on the sandbank that is located about 194 km (105 nautical miles) from Palawan.

"The systematic and consistent manner in which the People's Republic of China carries out these illegal and irresponsible actions puts into question and significant doubt the sincerity of its calls for peaceful dialogue," the task force said.

Pokwang filed a petition for deportation against Lee in June this year. According to entertainment reporter MJ Marfori, her camp "claims that O'Brian was using a tourist visa while working in the country for the past eight years."

Lee, meanwhile, filed his reply to the deportation complaint on June 26. In an interview shared by Marfori, the actor appealed to the Philippine government and the Bureau of Immigration to look at the case in line with his deportation and visa cancellation "fairly and with justice" as he noted that the complainant is "very well-known" and "very influential" in the country.

The former couple got to know each other in 2014 while working on the film Edsa Woolworth. They welcomed Malia in 2018, and separated three years later.

While Pokwang initially said they were on good terms, she later revealed in a February interview with Boy Abunda that a business problem led to their fallout and that they were no longer speaking to each other even before their confrontation.

He posted a series of screenshots of his inbox that had been bombarded with




questions from fans asking him the reason behind KathNiel's separation.

"It is very difficult to impose rules on everyone since we have freedom of speech, but I guess it is more of a responsibility as an individual." she reasoned. Alodia traced people's brass and boldness to post unverified information on social media to lack of control and accountability and to their freedom to choose to be incognito:
"I know a lot of people are hiding behind usernames and whatnot.

but as a creator, we also get affected when people try to push this cancel culture. So, we need to be more careful with other people's mistakes, so I am also cautious when I present myself and post."

Alodia, who has now stepped into a new role as wife to fellow online personality Christopher Quimbo, also expressed major concern about those who take advantage of the social platform to make some quick bucks by scamming their way to other people's accounts. She urges authorities to make them accountable for their actions.

"That's really crossing the line. Official rules should apply to them because this process also hurts other humans. Offended parties should subject these offenders to due process," she emphasized.

On the so-called "clout chasers," or those

who issue controversial, often irresponsible, comments on more popular personalities, Alodia had this to say: "I'm not sure what their motives are; it's just riding the clout to get a response from other creators. It's harassment. Hopefully there's due process on this kasi nakakasakit siya ng ibang tao."

In the end, it is refreshing to see how her continued popularity, both on digital and traditional media, has gone into Alodia's head in a very positive way through her mature and responsible declarations on the proper use of socials: "I encourage the next generation to be more responsible creators," she concluded.

university gymnasium in Marawi, which was besieged by Islamist militants for five months in 2017.

The Islamic State group, which wields influence in the country's south, said on Telegram its members had detonated the explosive.

Earlier on December 3, before Islamic State's claim, President Ferdinand Marcos Jr. condemned "the senseless and most heinous acts perpetrated by foreign terrorists." Police and the military strengthened security in

the country's south and around the capital Manila.

In Rome, Pope Francis offered prayers for the victims during his Sunday address, and, in a separate written message, appealed to "Christ the prince of peace (to) grant to all the strength to turn from violence and overcome every evil with good".

Law enforcement operations to bring to justice the perpetrators of the "terrorist activity" will "continue unabated," Defense Secretary Gilberto Teodoro said.

There were "strong indications of a foreign element" in the bombing, Teodoro said, refus-

gation.

High alert

The blast in Marawi, capital of Lanao del Sur province, followed a series of military operations against local pro-Islamic State groups in the southern Philippines, the military chief said.

One on Sunday in Lanao del Sur led to the killing of a leader of the Dawlah Islamiya-Maute group.

"It is possible that what happened this morning was a retaliatory attack," Armed Forces Chief Romeo Brawner told the press conference. The Islamic State-linked Maute seized Marawi on May 2017, seeking to make it a Southeast Asian "wilayat" – or governorate – for Islamic State.

In the ensuing five-month battle, Islamist fighters and Philippine forces killed more than a thousand people, including civilians.

Police offices in Mindanao and the capital region were placed on high alert and police checkpoints tightened "to prevent possible follow-up incidents", police official Peralta said.

The coast guard directed its districts to intensify pre-departure inspections at ports.

Mindanao State University

said in a Facebook post it was "deeply saddened and appalled by the act of violence that occurred during a religious gathering". "We unequivocally condemn in the strongest possible terms this senseless and horrific act."

(UPDATE Dec. 5) POLICE in the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region for Muslim Mindanao (BARMM) said they have two persons of interest in the bombing attack at the Mindanao State University (MSU) in Marawi City that killed at least four people last Sunday.

BARMM police chief BGen. Allan Nobleza did not name the persons of interest.

"We have persons of interest, but the investigation is still ongoing, so in order not to preempt the investigation, we will not divulge their names," Nobleza said.

'We'll just keep it to ourselves na muna'


Kim Chiu is choosing to remain tight-lipped about the status of her relationship with Xian Lim.



Ocampo and Canlas made their romance public in May 2022, a year after they started dating. Both were cast members of the 2020 drama series "Paano ang




