







## **OFW** lives threatened

PHL lacks contingency plans for OFW's in Taiwan



MANILA, Philippines — Migrante International, a global coalition of OFW groups and their families, condemned Chinese Ambassador Huang Xilian's statement where they said Beijing "makes it appear that China is holding OFWs in ONLINE Taiwan hostage."

Last month, Huang "advised" the Philippines against supporting Taiwan's independence if it "cares genuinely" about the 150,000 OFWs based there, instead of "stoking the fire" by giving the United States access to military bases.

The group noted that this may expose OFWs to racist violence when armed conflict begins. If China really is against having troops of the United States in the Philippine Philippines, MI said Beijing should stop Cuisine its aggressive actions against Manila.



# Filipina beauty queen claims Singapore 'beggar' approached her with QR code

Anyone who's been to Singapore can attest to the Little Red Dot's affinity for cashless systems — which apparently

does not escape even the few who choose to beg for alms.

Take the case of volleyball player and beauty queen Michele Gumabao, who shared on Twitter that she encountered a local

who approached her for money while on vacation in the city-state for Holy Week.

"Someone begged for money here in SG, I said sorry no cash. He showed me a barcode," she wrote.

"First world problems," one user replied.

Meanwhile, others casted doubt on her claim, adding that people would not get away with begging so easily in the country, which is known for its strict measures.

"Begging is illegal in Singapore! In my 15 years of living here, I have never seen anyone beg. Next time, report it to SG police," one wrote.

"Singapore is practically a cashless society that's why they have codes. But

there are hardly any beggars, they have pride [so they give you tissue in exchange] of what you will give. Tissue costs S\$1 but you can give more than that. Even buskers

have their own code," a Singapore-based commenter chimed in.

"I think that case is very rare in Singapore. They would sell you tissue and other stuff that you would buy even if you don't need it, out of humanity," another added.

If true, people wouldn't need to go far to experience beggars with QR codes. Actress Iwa Moto also shared on TikTok about her experience with street children who begged for money and showed her their GCash account, a popular e-wallet in the Philippines, when she said she didn't have cash on her.

#### Miles Ocampo recounts undergoing thyroid surgery

Actress Miles Ocampo opened up about her recent health issues regarding her

thyroid last March.

The "Batang Quiapo" actress took to her Instagram account to reflect on the surgery she had to undergo to remove her thyroid glands.

Miles began by noting she had not been feeling well since the turn of the year — waking up at night due to breathing difficulties, fatigue, frustrating weight gain, and always felt like suffocating.

Admitting to being afraid of the hospital and needles, the actress decided to have herself checked and do several tests, then ultrasound and biopsy.

The end result was discovering Miles had Papillary Thyroid Carcinoma so she had to quickly undergo a thyroidectomy

According to The Mayo Clinic, Papillary Thyroid Carcinoma is the most common form of thyroid cancer, often small and respond well to treatment even if the cancer cells spread to the neck's lymph nodes.

It adds that a small portion of this type of cancer is aggressive and could

grow to involve structures in the neck or spread to other areas.

Miles proceeded to thank her doctors, her family, her agency Crown Artist Management, her colleagues at "Eat Bulaga!," and her boyfriend Elijah Canlas and his parents.

"A month after my operation, here I am embracing my journey and sharing it to all of you," said Miles, noting she's been getting messages from people who've felt the same way and are inspired by them.

"You are not alone. Sending my love to everyone. Love and prioritize yourself."

She ended her entry with a postscript reminding everyone not to body shame, regardless of a person's current health status, "Be kind. Always. Please."

A number of fellow celebrities showered support for Miles, including Maja Salvador, Maine Mendoza, Bela Padilla, Darren Espanto, Bianca Manalo, Charlene Gonzales-Muhlach, Kakai Bautista, Ryzza Mae Dizon, Michelle Vito, Ashley Sarmiento and Lara Quigaman.

Miles mentioned that she still has one more procedure to undergo and then she will "maintenance na lang for life."

management, same network, and all that."


"So fast forward, when the opportunity presented itself to remake a song that I really like, that I am aware of, and I've listened to countless times before, I took the opportunity to record and sing it,

## Unbelievable, surreal: Kylie Padilla on pairing with Gerald Anderson

"Surreal" was one of the first words that crossed Kylie Padilla's mind on her experience working with Gerald Anderson for the first time.

She couldn't believe it. As it turned out, Kylie used to root for "Kimerald"—Gerald's successful former love team with Kim Chiu—years back. "I'm shy to admit it, but I was a fan," she said at a presscon for "Unravel."

Of course, Kimerald is no more. But once the camera started rolling, Kylie promptly turned her fangirl mode off. I had to be professional.

"Unravel" was shot in Switzerland. There, the two actors got to know each other better—all while enjoying the country's scenic lakes, mountains and villages.

#### 'Very open, generous'

"Masaya ka-work si Kylie. You can see how passionate she is and how much she loves her craft. When you do a shoot overseas, you usually just have a small team, so it's important that everyone is professional. You have to be able to adjust because there are things that are out of your control," Gerald said.

"But everything came together naturally," the 34-year-old actor added.

In hindsight, the fact that they didn't know each other actually helped, Kylie said, because the characters they play are just that. "The characters were strangers to each other, so I used our situation to get inspiration," related Kylie, who found Gerald a "very open and generous" leading man.

As beautiful as the filming location is, the story—which delves into mental health and disorderis anything but.

Switzerland is one of the few countries where physician-as-

sisted suicide is legal, even for nonresident foreigners. Upon learning about this, Lucy (Kylie), a successful company executive dealing with clinical depression, sets off to get herself enlisted. But then she meets a fellow Filipino named Noah, (Gerald), who has her rethinking her plans.

"The subject of mental health is a good conversation starter. People go through this. I hope the movie makes the viewers feel that they're not alone, that there are other chances in life, that we can give other people a chance to give us hope," she said. "That's one of the reasons I accepted the film."

#### Facing your problems

It's a situation that Kylie knows all too well. After giving birth to her second son, Axl, the 30-year-old actress was diagnosed with anxiety and postpartum depression. She encouraged people who find themselves in a similar situation to try and seek help.

> Back then, Kylie dealt with her problems by running away from them, literally and figuratively. "I used to be like that. But after doing that—trying to escape by going somewhere else—I realized that when I came back, things would still be as I left them. So I had to go deep and heal, so that I will be OK no matter where life takes me," she said.

Gerald is the opposite. He's the type of person who prefers to take on problems head on and resolve them as soon as possible.

"If there are problems or obstacles, I always want to get them done and over with," Gerald said. "But the beauty of the film is that it shows that every one of us has a different way of dealing with life challenges."

Whenever Gerald feels down, stressed or unmotivated, he redirects his attention to the things he's grateful for. "I'm happy that I'm still here and being offered to do projects than can make an impact. I'm grateful for everything. When I'm stressed, I try to figure out why it's happening: 'How do I fix this? What did I do wrong?"

"More than the success, it's the failures that helped me grow and shaped me into who I am now," he said.

## DOH: No need to reimpose mandatory face mask rule

MANILA, Philippines — The Department of Health (DOH) said May 2 that reinstating the face mask mandate was unnecessary, and people should adapt to the virus without fluctuating policies.

President Ferdinand Marcos Jr. on Monday floated the idea that the government might bring back the mandatory face masks following the recent rise in COVID-19 cases, depending on the recommendations of the DOH and Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases (IATF).

DOH officer-in-charge Maria Rosario Vergeire said the health department and other members of the IATF have already submitted their recommendation not to bring back COVID-19 restrictions, including mandatory face masks.

"We already have recommended to the Office of the President, based on the agreements coming from the IATF discussions, that there is no need to return the mandate, we need to shift the mindset

of our countrymen," said Vergeire.

Viral presence and self-protection

"Cases will increase and decrease in our country because the virus is here, it will not disappear, and the virus will mutate and produce variants every now and then," she added.

Vergeire explained that what the public needs is for each individual to know how to protect themselves and their family by choosing to wear a mask when going to high-risk places, especially if they are unvaccinated, immunocompromised, senior citizens, or pregnant.

"Our policies do not need to be back and forth, we all need to help each other to overcome this situation," said Vergeire.

Vergeire, in the same briefing, explained that the current increase in COVID-19 infections does not compare to the numbers recorded during the height of the pandemic in 2020 and 2021.

We need to raise the level of our risk tolerance to COVID-19. This increase in cases did not translate to more hospital admissions, and it did not translate to more severe and critical cases and even deaths," said Vergeire.

"Our health utilization rate remains at low risk because of the wall of immunity due to vaccination," she added.

Based on the DOH's COVID-19 online tracker, as of April 30, the country currently has 5,875 active COVID-19

The has so far logged a total of 4,093,421 cases, with 4,021,102 recoveries and 66,444 deaths.

## Filipinos Need P1.3 Million a Year to Be Happy

The study's authors say that while money isn't everything, it still provides a cushion that you need to "build a masterplan for being happy." '

## Dolphy's family engages in a legal battle against Banayad Whisky


The family of Dolphy will be pressing charges against the liquor company. Actor Eric Quizon revealed that his

"This is to inform the public that: BAN-AYAD WHISKY as shown in the photograph above and/or any product or merchandise having the same brand, is NOT ASSOCIATED, AFFILIATED, OR CON-NECTED with RODOLFO 'DOLPHY' VERA QUIZON and/or the HEIRS OF DOLPHY. Any complaint or transaction related to BANAYAD WHISKY shall not be acknowledged by the heirs of Dolphy. Please be guided accordingly," the statement went. Meanwhile, netizens and fans of Dolphy showed their support for the family in the comment section. Netizens shared how wrong it was for the liquor brand to use the image of the late actor without the permission of the family.

"You should send a cease and desist letter," one netizen suggested.

## Marcos, Biden affirm 'ironclad' alliance during meet

WASHINGTON, D.C.— As President Ferdinand "Bongbong" Marcos Jr. sought to redefine the Philippines and United States (US) relationship amid rising tensions in the Indo-Pacific region, US President Joe Biden said the US maintains its "ironclad" commitment to the Philippines' defense and security efforts.

Marcos and Biden met at the White House on May 1 (US time). It was the first visit of a Philippine president to the White House in many years.

Marcos has been constantly saying that the situation in the region was changing, thus, the need to evolve the current Mutual Defense Treaty between both coun-



The President was finally able to raise this, personally, to Biden.

He told Biden that the Philippines found itself in "arguably the most complicated geopolitical situation in the world right now."

"And so it is only natural that — for

the Philippines to look to its sole treaty partner in the world, to strengthen and to redefine the relationship that we have and the roles that we play in the face of these tensions that we see now around the South China Sea and the Asia-Pacific and Indo-Pacific region," Marcos said in his opening statement.

Marcos further told the US President that there were many new issues that need to be assessed.

"And again our role as partners in the world— in our worldview of what we are hoping for the future of peace, not only in the Asia-Pacific and Indo-Pacific region but in the whole world," he said.

Biden, on the other hand, said Washington remains "ironclad in our commitment to the defense of the Philippines, including the South China Sea and we're gonna continue [supporting] the Philippines' military modernization."

"Our countries not only share strong partnership. We share deep friendship, one that has been enriched by millions of Filipino-Americans and the communities all across the United States," Biden added.

This was Marcos' and Biden's second bilateral meeting. They first met on the sidelines of the 77th Session of the United Nations General Assembly (UNGA) last September 2022 in New York.



## Did Journey's Neal Schon Call Arnel Pineda a 'Nobody?'

In case you're not aware, all is not well in the rock band Journey. There has been infighting between members of the band, particularly between founding member Neal Schon and current frontman and lead vocalist Arnel Pineda and keyboardist Jonathan Cain. The drama has been playing out on social media.

The conflict between Schon and Pineda began after the band reunited with founding member Gregg Rollie recently. Schon's wife Michaele defended the reunion and called out both Cain and Pineda saying they should "know their place" since they were both recruited by Schon. Michaele further stoked the fire when she said both band members "should learn some spirituality."

Pineda responded with a tweet saying that if the band was tired of him, they could fire him "anytime."

Meanwhile, Schon's beef with Cain is related to money. After the two set up a company to handle the band's finances, Schon accused Cain of setting up a new American Express credit card without his knowledge and demanded access to the credit card statements. But according to the website Rockcelebrities, Cain filed a counter suit, alleging that Schon wanted to increase his spending limit on the card to fund his "extravagant lifestyle."

On Wednesday (April 12), comments made by Schon on Twitter seemed to indicate a more hostile approach toward Pineda. When a fan advised Schon to let Pineda and Cain go and called them "nobodies," Schon seemed to agree.

After reports of Schon's tweet began making the rounds on news sites and social media, Pineda tweeted a reply. "He (Schon) may be right. Like I said, if they're tired of this #nobody, I'm just a phone call away..."

But Schon quickly replied to Pineda's tweet to clarify his earlier statement. He also apologized to Pineda.

Pineda has since expressed gratitude for the life he was able to provide his family thanks to Journey.

Pineda was handpicked by Schon as Journey's vocalist in 2007 after seeing clips of him performing covers of the





band's songs. The band is at the tailend of its Freedom tour in the U.S. The tour began in February in Pennsylvania and is set to finish on April 25 in Palm Springs, California.

When a fan asked what the band would do in the event both Pineda and Cain quit after the current tour, Schon's answer was a firm, "Won't happen."



I don't know where the cameras are so it's nice kasi you're always ready."

Aside from her co-stars, Lovi says that she is delighted to make action scenes in her latest project. "I'm grateful for doing action scenes. As an actress, you like to complete your wish list. I've done drama, romantic comedy, and happy stuff. And now finally, it's happening. Nagstart 'yung mga actions scenes sa 'Flower of Evil.' And I hope the action roles get bigger here. Sa pilot episode pa lang I was blown away. Napakaganda," Lovi said.

She even noted that if she had to pick one food for the rest of her life it will be a Filipino dish.


Currently, Saweetie is busy working on her new album.

that are also being claimed by the Philippines," the coalition said in a statement.

"With its actions, China has presented itself as a convenient bogeyman that requires US presence and intervention in the region – a notion that is incorrect, even as it is influential." Washington has continuously expressed its commitment to its Mutual Defense Treaty with the Philippines. At a recent dialogue with Manila's top foreign and defense officials, both countries called on China to comply with the 2016 Arbitral Award on the South China Sea, which held that some areas China is claiming is already under the Philippines' exclusive economic zone.

Beijing has continuously called the award "illegal, null, and void" and has harassed Filipino fishermen and Philippine vessels while in Philippine waters. Foreign Affairs Secretary Enrique Manalo in a forum last week said the "repeated infringements" on the Philippines' sovereignty "necessitates the enhancement of our defense capabilities."

program and the non-inclusion of OFW concerns in crafting international policy also put the OFWs in Taiwan at risk. It called the Philippines out for its supposed "puppetry to the US" and opposed the US military presence in the Philippines

"Faced with China's aggressive assertion of its claims on Philippine territory, the Philippine government should exhaust all peaceful means of asserting Philippine sovereignty, and not look for militarist solutions which only lead to de-

pending on the US," it said in a separate statement.

Beyond the US, the Philippines has sought to expand defense ties with "like-minded" nations such as Japan and India.

# DOH: 54 Omicron XBB.1.9.1 cases detected in Philippines

MANILA, Philippines — Fifty-four cases of the Omicron subvariant XBB.1.9.1 have been detected in the country, the Department of Health (DOH) said before the weekend.

The latest COVID-19 Biosurveillance Report of the DOH showed the XBB.1.9.1, a XBB sublineage, was recently added to the list of variants under monitoring by the World Health Organization (WHO) last March 30.

"The variant was initially flagged due to its increasing global prevalence and higher growth advantage," the report noted. "However, currently available

evidence for XBB.1.9.1 does not suggest any differences in disease severity and/or clinical manifestations compared to the original Omicron variant."

The report added that limited information is available for the variant and researchers are currently characterizing the variant in terms of transmissibility, immune evasion and ability to cause more severe disease.

The Philippines is on the right track as far as COVID-19 response and measures are concerned, an official of the WHO said.

#### US nuclear power firm wants ot invest in PH

WASHINGTON D.C., United States — A US-based nuclear power firm has expressed interest to invest in the Philippines after its officials met with President Ferdinand "Bongbong" Marcos Jr. .

According to the Presidential Communications Office (PCO), Oregon-based NuScale Power Corp is planning to conduct a study to pinpoint a site in the Philippines.

The firm is known for developing a small nuclear power system, de-

referring to its small modular reactor technology (SMR).

He said SMR technology is the first and only one of its kind to receive design approval from the US Nuclear Regulatory Commission.

NuScale has existing projects in Utah, Romania, Indonesia, and Poland providing safe, reliable and cost competitive clean energy to consumers.

According to the PCO, NuScale is expected to invest \$6.5 billion to \$7.5 billion in the Philippines to provide 430 megawatts of power by 2031.

President Ferdinand "Bongbong" Marcos Jr. said in his meeting with NuScale that the Philippines "essentially has a shortfall in power supply, and the support of the Oregon-based firm would help address the issue.

This is the second time Marcos met with officials of NuScale, the first of which was held in New York in September last year on the sidelines of the 77th United Nations General Assembly.

t's been nearly three years since we have seen many of our friends in the flesh. Now that we are back to socializing, it's heartening to sit down and talk with well-meaning friends once again.

One dear friend of mine is Jasmine Curtis-Smith, who was my recent guest on Fast Talk with Boy Abunda. It was our first time to see each other in person after the global health scare prevented us from doing so.

I loved how Jasmine described her overall well-being: Just vibing. She exuded an aura of peace and contentment in the midst of the noise created by people who are having a field day throwing hurting words on social media.

Jasmine admitted that some-

times it's difficult for her to simply ignore people who spit out negativity. to exercise every day, especially when you get to read those that you don't want to read, you get rattled and it's hard to convince yourself that you're not hurt or affected," she added.

Jasmine truly appreciates her sister's pieces of advice, especially when she feels to be in a quandary. Aside from the Art of Dedma,

Anne would always remind her not to commit to something that she cannot put her heart into. "Kapag kasi hindi buong puso, huwag mo ng gawin kasi mahahalata at makikita ng tao 'yun. And that goes for work, relationship, friendship, anything kapag hindi buong puso huwag na."

Jasmine began her acting career in 2010. Her role in the indie film Transit earned her critical praise from both local and international critics, and won her the Best Supporting Actress award at the Ninth Cinemalaya Independent Film Festival.

Other award-giving bodies recognized her acting talent as well. She received the Best Actress trophy for her acting performance in the 2016 Cinema One Originals Filmfest entry, Baka Bukas. Jodi Sta. Maria says she doesn't always agree with the decisions her screen characters make and that's when she's able to put her experience and time-honed empathy to good use.

"When you embark on a certain role, you have to learn everything about the person you're playing," the 40-year-old actress told us during our quick one-on-one chat after she and her son, Thirdy Lacson, were launched recently as Chowking's latest endorsers. "What is her background? How does she think?

"The answers to those questions help me justify the hard decisions a character makes. The aforementioned insightful answer was how the lovely actress explained to us when we asked her if she ever takes away life lessons from her characters.

Versatile actress

But it also probably explains why Jodi is always convincing in any role she's tasked to bring to life, whether she's playing the adorable Maya in "Be Careful with My Heart," the vengeful Amor in "Pangako Sa 'Yo," the hunted nun Lourdes in "Aparisyon," careerwoman Trisha in "Labyu with an Accent," or Dr. Jill Ilustre in "The Broken Marriage Vow," for which she won a best actress award at the Asian Academy Creative Awards in December last year.

More opportunities

"When I was offered 'Unbreak My Heart,' which was shot in Switzerland, my first reaction was, 'This is surreal! Is this really happening?' Never did I imagine that a project like this—the first coproduction between rivals, ABS-CBN

and GMA Network—would happen in this lifetime... and I am grateful to be a part of it!

"I want to star in a Hollywood film!" Jodi said with a shy smile. "Medyo nahihiya pa daw, 'no (laughs)? But I am ambitious... I'm driven by goals that keep me in fighting form. The goals that I pursue and the steps I take to realize them keep me going.

"So I dream that it'll happen one day. If it doesn't, that's OK too. What's even more important for me is that I'm able to leave a good legacy as an actress.

"Meanwhile, as a person, I love to travel. This year, I'll see if I can tick off another item on my bucket list... and that is to travel to Antarctica! Look, I've already been to the other six continents... sa Antarctica na lang hindi (laughs). So, I just want to complete all seven."







## Sotto mulls 'Eat Bulaga' network transfer

It seems that the problem in "Eat Bulaga," the longest-running noontime program in the country, is far from over.

This was after former Senate President Tito Sotto revealed plans for the transfer of the show to another network if the problems and issues were not settled.

"That is a distinct possibility if they do not follow what we have agreed upon. Everything was going fine. Bigla na lang isang member ng board kung anu-ano ang sasabihin sa media. Hindi ko naman puwedeng ikaila na may ibang kumakausap sa akin talaga eh," said Sotto, one of the main hosts of the program, when asked about the possibility of transferring the show to another network.

Sotto, one of the founding members of the 43-year-old show, admitted he didn't like what Dapitan Mayor Bullet Jalosjos, Chief Finance Officer of Television and Production

Exponents Philippines (TAPE) Inc., said about "Eat Bulaga" in recent interviews.

"Isa sa mga board member ng TAPE nagpa-interview at yung mga sinabi nun, very inaccurate. Nagfuel ika nga ng hindi magandang response doon sa aming mga member ng Eat Bulaga," the former Senate president said.

Sotto also said that TAPE boss

Tony Tuviera was forced to retire, adding that TAPE still allegedly owes "Bulaga" co-hosts Vic Sotto and Joey de Leon big sum of money.

"Sabi nila wala raw utang ang TAPE kay Vic at Joey (De Leon). Hindi tutoo 'yun. Malaki ang utang. They owe Vic and Joy a big sum. If I'm not mistaken at least P30 million each ang kakulangan," he revealed.

It was reported that Tito and Joey were also trying to prevent Vic from talking about the issue.

"Ang nirereklamo ni Vic sa amin is tinatanggalan siya ng VAT pero hindi niya natatanggap yung supposed na sahod," Sotto also said.

Sotto also belied reports that the

Sotto also said that TAPE does not own the right to "Eat Bulaga," currently being aired on GMA Network.

"Ang TAPE producer. Hindi sila 'Eat Bulaga.' Ang 'Eat Bulaga' iba. Bakit kamo. Why am I saying this? In 1979, we started 'Eat Bulaga.' Joey invented the name. Vic and I agreed. Tony Tuviera agreed. Yun ang ginawa namin na it was produced by Production Specialist Incorporated. Pagkatapos ng ilang buwan, naubos and puhunan ng Production Specialist Incorporated. Ang TAPE pumasok lang noon 1981. Two years after at tumatakbo na ang 'Eat Bulaga.' Mali yung mga kinuwento kila Boy Abunda at Cristy (Fermin)," the actor-politician

Bullet, son of Romeo Jalosjos, said their family owns 70 percent of the company that produces "Eat Bulaga" while Tony owns 20 percent.

The mayor has yet to respond to the fresh statements of the senator.

#### Dolly de Leon will be busy this year

here was hardly any triangle of sadness seen on the forehead of award-winning international actress Dolly de Leon before the Gabi ng Parangal awards night of the first Summer Metro Manila Film Festival (MMFF).

Dolly became the first Filipino actor to win at the Los Angeles Film Critics Association Awards and Sweden's Goldbaggage Awards, their equivalent of the Oscars, for her role in Triangle of Sadness.

The Cannes Palme d'Or-winning film also earned Oscar nominations for Best Picture, Best Director and Best Screenplay for Swedish filmmaker Ruben Ostlund. Dolly became the first Filipino to be nominated at the Golden Globe and BAFTA (British Academy Film Awards).

The fact that she announced she will be busy the entire 2023, projects apparently kept coming one after another.

She admitted she learned a lot from her experience being on the international spotlight with Triangle of Sadness.

"That experience was valuable to me, I felt that I grew

"The secret is not to wait for things to happen," emphasized Dolly about her Triangle of Sadness experience. "I guess it's all about just working and working and doing the best that we can do. You really need to work to widen your reach."

She refused to quantify the offers that will keep her busy the whole of 2023. She just wrapped up the filming of Grand Death Lotto in the US (California)

last March, with director Paul Feig at the helm and John Cena and Awkwafina as stars.

"The more memorable experience for me was working with Paul Feig, our director. He directed Bridesmaids (2011). He is a very

good director. That was a wonderful experience working with him and the whole crew. That was fun," she

She also finished Between Temples with Jason Schwarztman.

On the local front, Dolly is expected to work with Kathryn Bernardo in Star Cinema's forthcoming offering, A Very Good Girl.

"I'm very, very excited about that," Dolly said. "I'm a huge Kathryn Bernardo fan and she's a lovely person, as well, although we have not met yet. I'm excited with the project. Petersen Vargas will be our director."

"The project is not the usual story. It's very unique and exciting to do. That will be my chance to really sink my teeth into a character, together with a great actress like Kathryn," she shared.

They previously worked together in a teleserye. "She was still very young then," Dolly recalled. "I was a teacher and she was my student. She played a young Marian Rivera. Kathryn was still with the other network then. I couldn't forget working with Kathryn because that early, she

was already very professional, very sweet and kind."

Dolly refused to label herself as a Hollywood star, despite the projects and offers that she has been getting lately.

"I'm not very comfortable with that term," she admitted. "I am an actor. I don't consider myself a star. I'm just a working actor. I'm an actor who works everywhere. I'd like to think that way."

Already, Dolly has started using her fame to drum up interest and support for her chosen advocacies. Apart from the UN Refugee Agency, she recently supported Project Hulmahan to help the Marikina shoemakers and other communities nationwide.



about Filipinos' fishing rights in the South China Sea, Marcos said, adding he has told the Philippine Coast Guard (PCG) and the Department of Foreign Affairs (DFA) "to put together... a map of these fishing grounds" that will be presented to Beijing.

In remarks made to reporters Sunday while enroute to Washington, Marcos also said a Philippines-China "direct communication line" must be finally adopted. "The overall priority is to safeguard our maritime terri-

tory," he said in remarks issued by his office.

The Chinese embassy in Manila did not immediately respond to a request for comment.

Coast guard team

There have been numerous reports about Chinese ships preventing Filipino fishermen from fishing in the West Philippine Sea. PCG spokesman Rear Admiral Armand Balilo said, "I know that a team from the Philippine Coast Guard is being organized and we are very much

willing to cooperate in the regional fishing agreement" and that they have received "guidance" from Marcos.

Balilo also believed that under the planned regional fishing agreement, Filipinos would be free to engage in fishing activities in the West Philippine Sea, but admitted that there are sometimes reports reaching their office about alleged attempts to stop Filipino fishermen from fishing.

ippine Coast Guard is being organized and we are very much is there to protect our fishermen and show our presence to them (China) and also to our country," he added.

#### Mockery

"China has repeatedly made a mockery of its diplomatic talks and avowed commitments with the Philippines on pursuing a peaceful settlement of the conflict," Camarines Sur Rep. LRay Villafuerte said.

According to the Marcos ally, "formal engagements" between Beijing and Manila this year "have only become a prelude to

more, instead of less, Chinese intrusions into our territorial waters and EEZ (200-nautical mile exclusive economic zone)."

"The asymmetry between Beijing's rhetoric and action on this thorny territorial issue is as clear as day," he said, pointing out that the trio of Manila-Beijing diplomatic engagements had been followed by "even more intense bullying tactics by China" in the West Philippine Sea.

Manila has so far lodged more than 200 diplomatic protests against Beijing in recent years.







#### UNICEF: Over 1 million Filipino kids missed out routine immunization in 2021

The United Nations Children's Fund (UNICEF) expressed its concern as over one million children in the Philippines missed out their routine vaccine shots in 2021.

UNICEF estimates that globally, 67 million children "missed out entirely or partially on routine immunization" between 2019 and 2021. These are vaccines against polio, measles, diphtheria, pertussis, tetanus, among others, said UNICEF Philippines Immunization Specialist Dr. Carla Orozco in a media forum on Tuesday, April. 25.

In 2021 alone, at least 18 million children globally have not received a single dose of routine vaccines or the so-called "zero-dose children" and the Philippines ranked fifth globally with regards to this matter, said Orozco. "What are zero-dose children? These are children that have not received a single dose of vaccine by the time the child reaches one year old," she said.

India registered the highest number of zero-dose children with 2,711,000 followed by Nigeria with 2,247,000; Indonesia with 1,150,000; Ethiopia with 1,134,000 and the Philippines with 1,048,000.

"In the East Asia and Pacific region where the Philippines belong, for 2021, Indonesia and Philippines are the major

contributors to the high number of zero-dose children," said Orozco.

The top five regions in the country with the most zero-dose children are Calabarzon (146,160), Central Luzon (99,541), Western Visayas (96,774), Bicol (80,905) and the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao (75,671), UNICEF data showed.

"The alarming number may result in possible outbreaks of vaccine-preventable diseases, disabilities, and even deaths of children," said Orozco.

"There was a measles risk assessment done by the WHO (World Health Organization) and DOH (Department of Health) as well with support from UNICEF, in the 2022 measles risk assessment has shown that the whole country is really ripe for an outbreak. That was last year, So, we really advocated---WHO, UNICEF, DOH to really implement immediately supplemental immunization activity or immunization campaign for measles," she added.

Orozco also noted that most of the zero-dose children live in marginalized communities or in communities considered "vulnerable to outbreaks," and often have no access to regular health services.



"Vaccine-preventable diseases affect children's physical and cognitive development and prevent them from becoming healthy, productive citizens," she said.

#### **Factors**

There are a lot of factors that contributed "to this high number of zero-dose children or under-vaccinated children," said Orozco.

"Some LGUs would only have once a month vaccination sessions. And also, there is inadequate tracking of defaulters. Defaulters are those children that have not completed their immunization schedule but they have actually started it--and that is a usual scenario in the Philippines, they don't complete their vaccination schedule in time. There is lack of regular outreach immunization services, inadequate human resource," said Orozco.

Another is vaccine hesitancy. "Like religious beliefs, perceptions that vaccines are not important, misinformation--possible side effects, etc. These have contributed really to the low trust in vaccine's safety and efficacy," she

Covid-19 pandemic also disrupted the routine immunization services, said Orozco.

"Because of the urgent need to end the pandemic, the government and all sectors --the priority, focus is really on the Covid-19 response, which overwhelmed the health system, especially human resources and funding as well. It affected the delivery of essential health services like immunization," she

#### Government should do more

Orozco said that the government should exert further efforts to address this problem.

"We know that the government is doing something of course but I think the government should do more. One, I think, the first step or major step is really on the human resources---to increase the

number not only the number but also the capacity of human resources for health services," she said.

"Also, additional funds for the conduct of vaccination: that would include outreach immunization services, to track defaulters as well, and increase in vaccination services to improve immunization coverage," she added.

It is also important to conduct "coaching" or "mentoring" sessions for health workers. "That would boost confidence and add on their knowledge and skills on vaccination," said Orozco.

In a separate press briefing on Tuesday, DOH Officer-in-Charge Maria Rosario Vergeire said the government will conduct a supplemental immunization activity starting May 2 to 31.

"Kailangan mabakunahan at mahanap natin ang mga kabataan na na-miss nga nating bakunahan (We need to vaccinate and find those children who we missed to vaccinate) during the times of the pandemic and even prior to that. And yung mga batang hindi pa kumpleto ang bakuna ay makumpleto na natin. Para maiwasan ang mga outbreaks na ating pwedeng mapigilan naman katulad ng polio at tigdas (And the children who have not yet completed their vaccination. This is to prevent possible outbreaks like polio and measles)," she said.

#### Bullet Jalosjos on 'Eat Bulaga!' : 'The only thing constant in the world is change'

Television and Production Exponents Inc. (TAPE Inc.) Chief Finance Officer Bullet Jalosjos has finally broken his silence regarding "Eat Bulaga!"

In "Fast Talk with Boy Abunda," the Dapitan City Mayor set things straight concerning rumors that the 43-year-old show will undergo drastic changes.

Bullet admitted there will be changes but this does not include replacing the show's hosts as led by Tito Sotto, Vic Sotto, and Joey De Leon.

He noted the three, whom he described as "pillars" of the noontime show, have accepted the upcoming changes and are "very cooperative about it."

Bullet also noted how everyone is in the loop and that they communicate, share ideas.

"I was given the green light by the board to talk openly kasi I think we have the responsibility sa taong bayan as well. Ang daming speculations and I don't think it will ever stop unless someone addresses this concern. So now we just want to assure the public and everyone else that we're coming up with a more

improved 'Eat Bulaga!' Think bigger prizes, more exciting segments."

Bullet also talked about the meeting the executives had with show employees months ago.



According to him, it was requested by his dad, Romeo Jalosjos, who is TAPE,

Bullet related that Tito, Vic, and Joey, were present at the meeting along with Tony Tuviera, among others.

"Even the security guard," Bullet

"We had a meeting on the studio sa APT. And du'n napag-usapan na it's about time na maging involved yung

mga board sa decisions sa loob ng kumpanya. And it was also said there publicly that Tito Tony Tuviera would retire already. So parang tinanggap lang ng pamilya yung retirement; ni dad.

And that's one way of confirming to everyone that my brother, Jon-Jon Jalosjos will now take over the daily operations of the show," he said, relating that his congressman brother is now the president of TAPE Inc, while his dad would still be the chairman.

"So dinadaan pa rin sa kanya - back then up to now - ang mga decisions,

whatever pagbabago, new portions, new segments - ganun ka detalyado."

He shared that after the meeting Tito, Vic, and Joey did ask to clarify things with his dad.

So what did his dad told them?

"Well, they've (TVJ) always been a part and they will always be a part of Eat Bulaga.' So kahit baligtarin natin hindi talaga sila pwedeng mawala sa 'Eat Bulaga.' And 'Eat Bulaga!' cannot live without TVJ. And I think, personally, in my opinion also, that TVJ also cannot live without 'Eat Bulaga.'

"And just to be fair sa kumpanya at sa pamilya, It's also fair to know that even my father, or our family, has also sacrificed even before when the show was not doing well. Nag re-invest na naman si dad to ensure na maswelduhan yung mga talents. Nag-pick up naman. That's why we believe talagang it's a collective effort; ang success ng 'Eat Bulaga."

Bullet also tackled their relationship with GMA, relating they still have a twoyear contract with the network.

Bullet also maintained that they're financially stable contrary to rumors.

"The company is okay. We're doing good. We can pay our talents. We can pay GMA. So wala po talagang problema when it comes to money."

He could only hope that the show's hosts will also be given the chance to be interviewed "to assure everyone that we're in good relation."

On the other hand, he teased about welcoming new celebrities to the show.

And there would be improvements in terms of content.

Asked about the speculations that circulated, Bullet thinks it boils down to fear of change.

"The only thing constant in the world is change. With the change, as with life and everything in it, there's always some sort of transformation - we have to accept that. We also need to understand that we have to adapt. We always have to adapt. And people who don't adapt,

who don't understand, sometimes sila yung naiiwan e," he said. "I really think the fear, it's all about fear of change. Pagbabago. Almost 43 years, it's so hard to see something different after 40 years being relevant."

#### Tito Sotto breaks silence on 'Eat Bulaga' issue: 'I am disappointed'

Not so fast.

Just when everyone thought everything is now okay regarding the country's longest-running noontime show, "Eat Bulaga," one of its original hosts, Tito Sotto, has come out to express his disappointment over what's happening with the show.

In an interview on "Updated with Nelson Canlas," Tito zeroed in on an interview relating "one member of the corporation, an officer of the corporation," noting it wasn't "accurate."

"As a matter of fact, there were false statements that were made," he added.

Although he didn't name names, the only one interviewed about the show prior was Bullet Jalosjos, chief finance officer of Television and Production Exponent (TAPE) Inc.

According to Bullet, everything is well with the show, their production company, and their finances.

"I want to assure everyone that we are financially stable," he said on "Fast Talk with Boy Abunda."

"The company is okay. We're doing good. We can pay our talents. We can pay GMA so wala po tayong talagang problema when it comes to money."

He also insisted talk about them owing show host Vic Sotto 2 billion pesos is untrue.

"That's why maganda po talaga kung sana pwede rin makausap all the talents, maimbita natin sa show din to assure everyone that we are in good relations," he said.

But Tito seemingly belied this. According to him, TAPE Inc. not only owed Vic but co-host Joey de Leon as well.



## The flourishing of Filipino cuisine

The distinction between an American party and a Filipino party, according to friends and relatives who have been at both types of parties, is that in Filipino celebrations, the center is the food offerings. Guests are encouraged to eat more and are even offered to take home some of the food that is served. According to the doyenne of Philippine cuisine, the late Doreen Gamboa Fernandez, in Metro Manila and large urban centers, parties serve traditional Filipino offerings and other cuisine like Chinese style noodles, Spanish paella, American burgers and steaks, Japanese sushi and sashimi, Korean barbecue, British fish and chips and other cuisines native to Thailand, Singapore, Malaysia, Indonesia, India, Italy, Middle East, Mexico and other nationalities.

The food selections in the upper class Metro Manila household may be considered as eclectic. But Fernandez has observed



that even decades ago, away from major urban centers, it is still mostly native cuisine in all its regional variations that are the daily fare. However, in the last decade or so, it has been observed that Filipino cuisine has increased in stature and has even begun to be internationally recognized.

Several decades ago, Filipino cuisine was considered as food for daily consumption. Today, we have television shows that

focus on Filipino cuisine with its different variations.

My favorite show is "Chasing Flavors" hosted by Claude Tayag, the well-known Filipino and Kapampangan food gourmet. His show centers on his travels to various regions where he goes out of his way to look for distinctive regional variations. There are now more authors that have written about our native cuisine. There are even authors that have explained and written narratives on Philippine culture as defined by the food that is indigenous to the culture. Some of these authors are Felice P. Sta. Maria and Fernando N. Zialcita.

However, the pioneer in Filipino culinary history is Doreen Gamboa Fernandez. Among her books are Tikim (Taste), a collection of essays on Filipino book and culture written before her death on June 24, 2002. This was revised and updated in 2020. It is amazing that the essays in the book have remained relevant to the Filipino culinary scene as of this date.

Alfred Yuson wrote in the introduction to the book: "Throughout this collection

of food essays, features and formal papers culled from a quarter century ot authoritative writing, the author repeatedly stresses

that what we eat has history behind it, is premised on setting and has a meaning beyond its taste and flavor."

Fernandez, in her book, also quoted from cultural icons like E. Aguilar Cruz and Martin Tinio. Among her most quotable quotes are from her co-author for several books, cultural researcher and food expert, the late Edilberto Alegre, who said, "... that if Ilocanos favor the bitter (as in pinakbet and the famous pinapaitan, a goat dish with the bile sauce), the Tagalogs the sour (katamtamang asim in sinigang) and many Bicolanos the hot (Bicol express is a dish of sautéed chili peppers), the llonggos have their own predilection. For them, no large dominant flavor but layers and nuances

prized over predominance of flavor."

In this collection of essays, Fernandez dedicates it to her parents, Dr. Alicia Lucero Gamboa of Cabanatuan, Nueva Ecija and Aguinaldo S. Gamboa of Silay, Negros Occidental. The essays are divided into four categories,

namely Food and Flavors; People and

Places; Books and other Feasts and Food in Philippine History. The first essay is

seemingly timeless and one of the most interesting. The title is "Balut to Barbecue: Philippine Street Food " She writes: "Street food in the Philippines is not only a con-

venience for those without time to cook or an economic phenomenon that flourishes during hard times. It is a convenience."

She categorizes Philippine street food from the points of view from place and manner of vending. The first category is the Walking Street Food. Among the examples she gives are the peanut vendors selling in street corners, the taho vendors who sell in residential areas and the vendor on a bicycle moving from place to place.

The second category includes the Sitting Vendors offering baskets or trays of products like rice cakes, syrup-coated bananas or banana cues, pork barbecue and quail eggs.

Food whose food wares depend on the



time of the day. It begins with breakfast, then are replaced by snacks and then lunchtime fare, primarily noodles, fish and meat dishes. It ends with snack foods.

The next are School Street Food, which are found outside every elementary, high school and college. Their offerings range from boiled corn,

"dirty" ice cream, fish balls and cheap lunches with plenty of rice.

The next category is Food at Office and Factory sites. These are jeepneys or small vans from the back of which one can buy a variety of fare, ranging from sandwiches to lunch dishes.

Today, office workers refer to these as Jollijeeps.

Among the other interesting essays are the Flavors of Negros, the Filipino Kitchen, the Restaurant of Yestervears and Mother Cuisine.

From a historical point of view, Fernandez also wrote a lengthy essay on Philippine foodways answering the question, what is Filipino food? Among the most typical and widespread examples of Filipino cuisine, she cites two. The first is the sinigang, which is meat, fish or seafood stewed in sour broth with vegetables. The second is kinilaw which has uncooked fish marinated in vinegar or lime juice.

At the end, Fernandez states that Filipino cuisine persists despite efforts by colonization and neo-colonization, unchanged in its traditional ways or slightly changed with its contact with other cultures. She says: "Its vigor augurs well and offers much hope for the folklore, the folkways, the folk art and the folk culture which many have feared are too fragile to survive modernity and global tides."

"So, right now, I think we're finding our momentum. We've gotten on the bike, we removed the training wheels.

And the Eraserheads, to be sure, have left mementos for their fans to remember them by-vinyl records (Ultraelectromagneticpop! and the EP "1995"/ "Sabado"), a book documenting their successful reunion concert in 2009, and merchandised items bearing the band's name and

Ely himself, through his own record label, Offshore Music, had overseen various Eraserheads-related projects designed to preserve the band's legacy.

Now 52 and grateful, he has gained a deeper appreciation of the band's music and its continuing influence on Filipino listeners.

"So I'm grateful that, for the first time, I can start enjoying the music and be a fan of our music."

To this, Marcus joked, "Ang suwerte nung audience na mapapanood nila kami live, kasi kami hindi pa namin napapanood sarili namin ng live."

Buddy thanked the fans for keeping the band's songs relevant, never mind if the Eraserheads is no longer an active group for two decades now.

Some of the songs that the Eraserheads popularized during their reign include "Ligaya," "Pare Ko," "Alapaap," "Magasin," "Torpedo," "Huwag Mo Nang Itanong," "Spoliarium, to name only a few.

Reflecting, Buddy continued, "It's not every day that a lot of people enjoy the music that a band makes, much less this band. It makes it all the more special,"

"We have music appreciators who've grown with us. Some have grown up, some have grown older, some have families.

"Their kids are listening to our music and some kids' grandkids are listening to our music. We're really grateful.

"Ako, I'm happy kasi I have kids who'd come up to me and say, 'Hey, I like this song, I like the bass line you did on that, I like the guitar part on this song.'

"So if that means that our music creates more Filipino fans for OPM, then I'm really happy."
