



No more 'endo' by 2017 – Bello



MANILA - Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE) Secretary Silvestre H. Bello III wants the anti-labor sector "endo" scheme to be a thing of the past by 2017.

"Endo" or end of contract is a scheme wherein casual workers are not regularized and only hired for about five months without security of tenure and lack of, or inadequate monetary, non-monetary, and social protection benefits.

"Our commitment to President (Rodrigo) Duterte is to reduce 'endo' or '555' by 50 percent in six months. And by 2017, it should be a thing of the past. That is our objective," Bello said.

During a recent consultation workshop, Bello directed DOLE regional directors to ensure that the Department's Labor Law Compliance Officers (LLCOs) are doing their tasks of inspecting all establishments, including contractors and subcontractors, in their regions.

"Do not wait for workers to file a complaint. You should take the initiative and make use of your inspectors. Make sure that your inspectors are really inspecting," said Bello.

The labor chief also instructed DOLE regional directors to be proactive in their approach to reduce "endo."

During the said consultation workshop, the DOLE's regional directors drafted a Regional Action Plan which will ensure the effective implementation and enforcement of workers' right to security of tenure

The DOLE Regional Action Plan in Ending "Endo" is aimed at improving implementation rate of compliance orders; increasing the number of workers regularized and raising the number of workers under legitimate contractual arrangements.

Included in the strategies under Regional Action Plan are joint assessment/compliance visits, cancellation/denial of application and certificates of registration, engagement with stakeholders, enhancement of the labor law compliance system database, assistance to affected workers, development of a communication plan and capacity-building of concerned DOLE personnel.

"It is very clear there are establishments which are violating the law. If the law will be implemented and there will be strict compliance, I don't see any reason the objective of ending 'endo' practice by 2017 will not be achieved," Bello said.

She tried to get public sympathy by gender saying she is a woman whose honor has been trampled on and she also claimed that the President's attacks were brought on by her decision to lead the Senate inquiry next week into the administration's war on drugs, and the extrajudicial killings.

She said she will resign if Duterte's evidence is authentic, but she did not deny the allegations, which makes people think they are true. In a way, she is hoping there is no evidence, or that they are flimsy.

When De Lima was in power, she found nothing wrong with President Benigno Aquino III publicly berating officials of three government agencies during his State of the Nation Address (SONA).

De Lima said "corrupt officials in these agencies have 'makapal na mukha."Tama lang iyong isapubliko ni Presidente iyong kanyang frustration at galit sa mga ahensiya na iyon na nasa negative list.'

"Tama lang iyong 'naming and shaming' kasi mukhang hindi nga sila natatablan kahit nagfa-file tayo ng mga kaso, mayroong mga administratively charged, mayroon din mga criminally charged," she added.



PNP chief warns 911 prank callers:

See you in jail

MANILA - The country's top cop warned the public not to make prank calls to hotline 911 after the emergency hotline received hundreds of such calls during its launch on Monday.

Philippine National Police (PNP) Chief, Director General Ronald "Bato" dela Rosa said of the 2,475 calls recorded from 12:00-7:00 a.m., at least 1,356 were prank calls, 304 of which have already been validated.

"The Chief PNP is warning the 304 prank callers and the would-be callers. The 911 system is currently tracking the prank callers and we will make sure that you will be unmasked and arrested," dela Rosa said in a press conference Monday.

The police chief also warned would-be

pranksters.

"Refrain prank calls and test calls. You clog up the lines and prevent people with real emergencies to reach us," said dela Rosa.

Presidential Decree No. 1727, s. 1980 prohibits the malicious spread of information made by "any person who, by word of mouth or through

the use of the mail, telephone, telegraph, printed materials and other instrument or means of communication."

If convicted, the prankster will be "punished with imprisonment of not more than five (5) years, or a fine of not more than forty thousand pesos (?40,000.00) or both at the discretion of the court having jurisdiction over the offense herein defined and penalized."

Various Emergencies

Dela Rosa said he has ordered police officials to swiftly act on calls to 911.

"All Chiefs of Police to be alert and respond to the calls routed to you by the 911 call centers and immediately provide police assistance to our people when needed," said

Officials said at least 75 were "legitimate handled calls" while around 1,119 were dropped calls.

Various calls were responded to by forces from PNP, Bureau of Fire Protection, and the Department of Health.

Some of the calls sought assistance for health emergencies, accidents, harassment, arrest of trouble makers, and riots.

Customs collections short under Lina

MANILA - Former commissioner Alberto Lina has left the Bureau of Customs in bad shape, failing to hit any of its revenue targets for the six months of the year, records show.

All ports under the bureau's supervision were also unable to hit their respective goals in April and May this year.

For the first half of the year, the bureau collected only P190.27 billion out of its P238.32-billion target, for a P48.05-billion shortfall.

Weeks before Lina stepped out of office, then incoming President Rodrigo Duterte identified the bureau as among the three most corrupt agencies in the government, along with the Bureau of Internal Revenue and the Land Transportation Office.

Last month, President Duterte ordered new Customs Commissioner Nicanor Faeldon to rid the agency of corrupt officials and personnel

"I already have the raw information but I still have to validate it... I hope Faeldon



would do his thing and stop corruption in Customs," the President said, adding that unscrupulous Customs officials and employees have "long lived in luxury."

The same collection downtrend was registered in May after the BOC's top ports again suffered huge collection deficits, contributing to the agency's P8.83-billion shortfall for the month.

The Port of Zamboanga was the lone port to exceed its target of P84.6 million, with collections reaching P109.4 million for the first six months of the year.

With the agency's whopping shortfall, Duterte said Faeldon has a lot of work to do to reverse the downtrend in the revenue collection for the rest of the year, in particular in undertaking a no-nonsense campaign against smuggling of commodities, including

agricultural products.

Citing discrepancies between United Nations data of countries reporting shipments bound for the Philippines and local agency's monitoring of inbound cargo, agriculture stakeholders said smuggled onions alone may have ballooned sixfold.

Data from the United Nations Commodity Trade Statistics Database showed that China, India, The Netherlands, the United States and Hong Kong shipped a total of 49.3 million kilos of onions but the Philippine government counted only about 31 million kilos.

The difference of 18.3 million kilos could only mean the rest was brought in illegally, said the Samahang Industriya ng Agrikultura (Sinag), an umbrella organization of agricultural stakeholders.

The UN data also showed China sent 138 million kilos of garlic in 2015, but the Philippines monitored only 23.6 million kilos—a difference of 114.4 million kilos.

Sotto files Senate bill requiring private sector employers to give workers 14th month pay

Is he just trying to win over the public?

Would this bill be enough to make everyone forget all his iffy shenanigans?

MANILA - Senate Majority Leader Tito Sotto has filed a bill that would require employers in the private sector to give their employees 14th month pay.

"Senate Bill No. 2 provides that all non-government rank and file employees should be entitled to 14 month pay aside from the regular 13th month pay they receive every year," reports Maila Ager on Inquirer.net.

The bill's explanatory note indicated: "The 13th month pay shall be paid not later than June 14th and the 14th month pay shall be paid not later than December 24th of every year provided however that the frequency

of payment of this monetary benefit may be the subject of agreement between employer and employee or any recognized/collective bargaining agent of employees."

The noted added that "the minimum amount of the 14th month pay shall not be les than 1/12 of the total basic salary earned by the employee within the calendar year."

PRESIDENT DUTERTE WARNS COMPANIES

'Stop contractualization or face closure'

MANILA - President Rodrigo Duterte has warned companies to stop contractualization or face closure.

Duterte threatened to cancel the permits of companies that insist on hiring contractual employees.

"My message to them is very simple: Do not wait for us to inspect. I will be unforgiving. You will not only lose your money, you will lose your pants," the President warned.

"This was my promise to the people and I will do it. Stop that practice, pay your employees right, stop contractualization. It will not do good to our country," he added.

The President specifically called on employers of security guards, who he said sometimes work



for 24 hours straight. Duterte said companies

should give their employees all the benefits mandated by law.

"If you do not take care of the workers, then I cannot take care of you," he said.

"I'm sorry, whether SM or all companies, I will close the entire Republic of the Philippines and we can all go into hunger strike," Duterte

SM Investments Corp. in April maintained that it does not practice contractualization

but hires seasonal workers.

The President urged contractual workers to air their complaints by calling 8888, the 24-hour government hotline.



Putting 'half rice' on the menu

Why 'half rice' should be offered for rice-loving Philippines

MANILA, Philippines-"Why should we offer half rice? We barely mind rice wastage. What matters more is we get more sales with full rice."

In a rice-loving country, these words are what some food establishments would argue why they refuse to offer half-cup of rice in their menus. But in General Santos, the local government is turning the tables to promote responsible rice consump-

"If I haven't attended the meeting, I wouldn't have known the magnitude of rice wastage in the country," said Aizabelle Iris Mangao, a manager of a restaurant franchise that offers grilled Filipino and Asian food.

In early 2015, Mangao attended a consultative meeting organized by the legislators of the city government of General Santos about the then proposed GSC Riceponsible Ordinance.

The policy took effect on December 2015 and mandated that the city "shall adopt measures, which shall ensure responsible rice consumption and rice conservation." It also aims to educate consumers to not waste rice to help attain rice self-sufficiency in the country.

Over 80 representatives of small to large scale food stores learned that Filipinos waste about P23 million worth of rice a day, enough to feed nearly 2.6 million poor Filipinos. This reality awakened Mangao and her colleagues to make a conscious effort. They already started walking the talk long before the ordinance took effect.

Immediately, Mangao informed her restaurant's owner, who also owns at least 8 food franchises in the city about the ordinance. They then talked to the head office of the franchised restaurant that promptly approved its implementation. The half-cup of rice, roughly 80 grams, were incorporated at the point of sale (POS) which is also half the price of a full cup of rice (P30) as mandated by the ordinance.

"Before we started advocating for the half rice in our store, we started with ourselves. We asked our staff to responsibly consume rice," Mangao

Downscaling the policy

The year 2013 was declared as the National Year of Rice (NYR) through Presidential Proclamation No. 494. The Department of Agriculture -Philippine Rice Research Institute (DA-PhilRice) enjoined rice producers, consumers, and policymakers to achieve rice self-sufficiency, specifically to promote less rice wastage.

Pursuant to the proclamation, the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) encouraged cities and municipalities to pass ordinances that will require the food service industry "to make a half cup

MANILA - So-called vigilante killings claimed at least nine more drug suspects in separate incidents in Olongapo City, Cagayan and the Bicol Region.

All victims were found with notes written in Filipino: "I'm a collector and pusher of shabu," "I am a pusher" and "Don't emulate pushers-Bicol vigilantes."

Arthur Mangohig, 43, of Barangay Manggahan, Subic, Zambales, was found near a lighthouse in Barangay Kalaklan in Olongapo City with three gunshot wounds. His feet and head were wrapped in plastic and tied with wire.

A woman who claimed to be his daughter arrived at the crime scene and identified him. She said four bonnet-wearing men came to their house on Sunday night and abducted her father who was selling food packs at the Hanjin transport terminal in Barangay Manggahan, Subic.

Authorities believed he was killed in another place and his body was dumped in the area.

Another suspected drug pusher, Rommel Rodaste Palma, was shot dead by policemen during a buy-bust in Barangay Banicain.

Report said Palma got suspicious that he was dealing with police authorities and engaged the poseur buyer that resulted in a shootout.

Recovered from him were sachets of shabu and drug paraphernalia, a knife, a gun and other

The third victim, Rodolfo Santillan, was reportedly a known drug pusher in Barangay New

Santillan was being served a warrant of arrest for illegal drugs in his house in Sitio Botolan, Iram, when he engaged policemen from Police Station 4 in a gunfight on Saturday.

Sachets of shabu and illegal drug paraphernalia, a caliber .38 revolver and three 9mm live ammunition were recovered from him.

The Olongapo City acting chief of police, Senior Supt. Jerry Tait Sumbad, downplayed fear of vigilantism in the city and told The Manila Times that the Philippine National Police does not know of the existence of a vigilante group or its involvement in drug-related killings or summary execution in the city.

"It's negative as far as I know," Sumbad said. When asked if he was aware of such group existing in nearby towns, he replied that he does not know if there are vigilantes in other areas.

A number of deaths have taken place in Olongapo and nearby towns of Zambales, particularly in Subic and Castillejos, where bodies were dumped in different places with markings that appear to be the work of vigilantes.

Similarly, vigilante killings of alleged drug violators in Metro Manila and neighboring provinces have reached Bicol Region.

The Naga City (Camarines Sur) police spokesman, Senior Police Office 2 Tobias Bongon, confirmed the extrajudicial deaths after three bodies were found with placards written in Filipino: "Don't emulate pushers-Bicol vigilantes."

Bongon identified the first victim as Alan Castro, 38, who was shot dead by unidentified assailants riding a motorcycle in Barangay San

The second happened in Barangay Pacol where the body of Michael Reyes, 39, was found with gunshot wounds and his face wrapped with a masking tape. The placard, apparently left by the killer said he was a hold-up man.

The third victim was Ariel Bucacao, 29, whose body bore stab wounds and dumped at the entrance of Saint James Subdivision in Barangay Concepcion Grande.

Since July 1 when "Oplan Tokhang" was implemented, the police regional director, Chief Supt. Melvin Buenafe, said the number of drug suspect killed, pushers arrested and surrenderers multiplied fast.

The Bicol Region has been in the news for having a serious problem in drugs since the early

Police records showed Camarines Sur and Albay topped the lists of drug violators arrested and surrenderers, followed by the provinces of Masbate, Sorsogon, Camarines Norte and Catanduanes. The two cities that topped the lists of having drug violators are Naga City and Legazpi (Albay).

Buenafe said they are eyeing at least 100,000 drug suspects to surrender within three months.

Naga City Mayor John Bongat said he does not condone vigilante killings but admitted it is a big deterrent against criminality.

Meanwhile, in the province of Cagayan, three bodies were recovered by the police in a cemetery in Barangay Tapel in Gonzaga town.

The victims were suspected to be involved in illegal drugs.

Police Senior Insp. Edgar Manuel, Gonzaga chief of police, identified the victims as Jovit Baclig, Bonito Sebastian Jr., and Obet Valderama, all residents of the town.

Manuel said Valderama is No.8 on the drugs watchlist of Gonzaga police as pusher, while Baclig and Sebastian were listed as drug users.

Police also recovered a caliber .45 pistol from the crime scene and two sachets of shabu from Valderama.

Intelligence gathered by police revealed that

the three duped the supplier of the drugs who allegedly retaliated by killing them.



Barbie Forteza Superstar Student

Barbie Forteza suddenly found herself enrolled in a master class in acting, with the Superstar herself, Nora Aunor, as her mentor.

In Derick Cabrido's "Tuos," an entry in this year's Cinemalaya, La Aunor plays a binukot, epic chanter and keeper of the tribe's traditions, who must grapple with the decision of her rebellious granddaughter, portrayed by Barbie, not to follow in her footsteps.

In their scenes together, Barbie said the internationally acclaimed actress was a consistently generous coworker.

"Although the theme was heavy, work was made easier because Ms. Nora was very supportive," Barbie recalled. "She helped me out. In one scene, she whispered to me: 'Deliver your dialogue slowly, so you can feel it."

The Superstar wasn't the type who would dish out acting tips indiscriminately, so Barbie had to listen closely and observe just as assiduously. "She made me realize that less is more. The simpler, the better—the more effective your performance would be. In the movies, big movements are not necessary... which is different from television."

On TV, she admitted, she often had to resort to loud and unrestrained acting. That was why indie films offer a refreshing change of pace for her, she explained.

Her latest indie film gave her the chance to learn from seasoned veterans like La Aunor, who likewise shared practical advice on longevity and surviving the business of show.

"She told me that I shouldn't let success change who I am. That I should always be professional. That I shouldn't be the cause of delay at work," Barbie related. "That I should do my homework."

To prepare for "Tuos," she watched the 2004 "I-Witness" documentary, "Ang Huling Prinsesa." The docu was a big help because it gave us a peek into the life of a binukot," she clarified.

She also had to learn the Kinaraya language. "There were Tagalog translations on the margins of the script, and a dialogue coach was on the set to make sure our pronunciation was correct. Since we shot in live sound, we couldn't afford to make a mistake."

Her director was a perfectionist, as well, she noted. "Even though he wanted everything to be flawless, the shoot went smoothly.'

Cabrido's "enthusiasm" for his craft was "contagious," she remarked. "He won't settle for 'OK lang.' He pushed us to give our best."

She is grateful that her home studio, GMA 7, permits her to act in independently produced films.

"GMA Artist Center isn't really that strict," she pointed out. "I am happy that my handlers allow me to do what I want-especially since we all know that

'Annihilate Abus to the last man'

MANILA, Philippines - President Duterte vowed there would be no let up in the fight against the Abu Sayyaf, calling on government forces to kill the bandits down "to the last man."

"There will never be any peace negotiation. You have to destroy them. That is the order: Destroy them," Duterte told the troops last Friday night at the Armed Forces of the Philippines' Central Command in Camp Lapu-Lapu in Cebu City.

"Just wait. When I was mayor, I said: 'There will be a reckoning for all of these cruel and brutal things that you are doing. We will collect someday.' Just wait because we are just assembling our troops," he told the troops over the weekend.

He said he has no tolerance for the Abu Sayyaf, notorious for kidnap-for-ransom activities and beheading its hostages.

"Finish the problem, finish them to the last man," he said.

Duterte noted how terrorism would remain the biggest threat to the country in the next decade.

"I am warning you, five to ten years from now, the biggest problem would be terrorism," he said.

Duterte promised the troops and the police he would take care of them as long as they do their duty to the country well.

He stressed the military should be loyal to the country and the Constitution, and no one else, not even the President.

"I feel strongly for the soldiers. I don't need anything from you. I do not need your personal loyalty for me. Just love your country. Obey the Constitution, period," he said.

Duterte said the military and the police are his partners in combating the apparatus of the illegal drug trade in the country.

He admitted giving the military and the police the go signal to hunt down all illegal drug syndicates in the country.

"And I feel for my soldiers and Davao City really improved to what

it is now because of the police and the military. To tell you the truth, who killed the criminals there? It's the military and the police," Duterte said.

In exchange for the soldiers and cops' support for his leadership, Duterte vowed to be loyal to them.

Duterte said he would back all his men against criticisms and legal challenges that may arise from his strong anti-drug campaign.

"I had the full cooperation. And in return I was also loyal to my men... The soldiers and the policemen are confident because I was there to protect them," he said.

Duterte said Defense Secretary Deflin Lorenzana has requested a budget for the recruitment and training of 20,000 new soldiers.

"And I told him, 'it would be difficult, perhaps I could only provide a budget for 10,000 new soldiers and 5,000 more policemen.' I will have to prepare the Philippines' defense... next year, we will be... The Philippines' (defense) is actually okay. But under my term, we will be better," Duterte declared.

The President has been visiting military camps over the weekend in his effort to lift the morale of the troops and explain the administration's programs to talk peace with the rebel groups, including the Communist Party of the Philippines-New People's Army, the Moro National Liberation Front and the Moro Islamic Liberation Front.

Duterte, however, stressed he would never negotiate with the Abu Sayyaf, saying "the time of reckoning will come."

The United States and the Philippines have both listed the Abu Sayyaf as a terrorist organization for kidnappings, beheadings and bombings.

The bandit group emerged in the early 1990s as an extremist offshoot of the decades-long Muslim separatist rebellion in the south.

Do A-List users shrug off Duterte's drug war?

MANILA - As President Duterte's war on drugs intensifies, hordes of substance abusers around the country have voluntarily surrendered to the police, showing remorse and willingness to undergo rehabilitation.

However, many affluent, if not A-List, users seem oblivious to threats of arrest and news of summary executions.

A source from Kaya Rehab Asia, a treatment center in Baguio,

observed: "People from the lower-income groups were motivated by fear. That's why they turned themselves in. For the affluent, what's the fuss? They can't relate to the police knocking at their doors, looking for suspects."

The source, who requested anonymity, said Kaya hasn't experienced any increase in inquiries or enrollment since Duterte launched his campaign. "It hasn't affected us that much."

Kaya, which means "can do" or "will" in Tagalog, was patterned after Dara, a luxury rehab in Thailand. Kaya works like a hotel, where clients either have a twin-sharing room or a solo suite. The rates for a 28-day program range from P140,000 to P200,000 depending on the room.

Affluent addicts will turn to rehab upon realizing they've hit rock bottom in their health and relationships.

"Even if the police go after high-profile or high-income personalities or celebrities who do drugs, it's not Duterte's campaign but the extreme difficulties in life that will drive them to make the change," said the source. They tend to be "high-performing individuals with substance-use disorders"—a top corporate executive; a bored, neglected housewife; or an athlete who can't handle sudden fame and fortune.

Recreational drug

Contrary to popular belief that cocaine is the drug of choice of the rich, the source pointed out that, as early as 2000, methamphetamine (the rich call it "meth," not shabu) was already prevalent in that crowd, fetching P5,000 to P7,000 per gram while cocaine was cheaper at P3,000 to P5,000.

Explained the source: "Coke just gives you a buzz. You're energetic and not edgy, unlike taking meth. Because coke is milder, it has become a recreational drug. That's why it's associated with the rich. You need a fix every hour. Meth, however, brings weight loss, extreme mood swings and paranoia."

Still, the source quoted a woman telling a client, "Why take shabu? Your maid uses that. Do you want to be baduy?"

On dealing with substance abuse, Kaya counselor Vicente Macasaet observed that the rich will opt for geographical change. The parents will send their children to Baguio, Thailand or America.

"The family will not worry about being exposed because of the confidential nature of the program," he said.

Macasaet knows of affluent users who have been attending fellowships such as Alcoholics Anonymous and Narcotics Anonymous.

He noted: "If these people get arrested, they

can always say they are attending AA or NA. They play cat-and-mouse. That's the mentality of the user —try to beat the system."

Classic pattern

Macasaet added that Duterte's drugbusting campaign platform hit the spot with many families: "Parents felt helpless. They hoped Duterte's campaign would solve the problem."

Asked why people get into drugs if they've got everything in life, Macasaet explained the classic pattern of hardworking parents who are not always available for their children who, in turn, succumb to peer pressure. This is aggravated by a society and culture that seek immediate gratification.

Added the confidential source: "It's complicated. The executive and the taxi driver may be taking the same drug, but their histories and challenges are different."

Although Kaya's rates may seem steep for the average Juan, the rehab center volunteered its 12-step program to the Baguio city government to aid drug personalities who have surrendered.

The program is an action plan in which the individual acknowledges that his situation has become unwieldy, hence the need to surrender to a higher spiritual power and promise to adopt a new set of attitudes and behavior to help himself and, consequently, other people in his life.

FM burial on September 18

MANILA, Philippines - All is set for the burial of the late president Ferdinand Marcos at the Libingan ng mga Bayani in Taguig City on Sept. 18, his son and namesake, former senator Ferdinand Marcos Jr., said.

Their family has, in fact, started preparations for the interment rites that include military honors, according to Marcos.

He said President Duterte has given the gosignal for his family to finally bury his father at Libingan during a meeting with him.

"My sister Imee is taking care of the rites in Ilocos because Ilocanos would get angry at us if they would not be able to pay their last respects to him. We'll bring him first to Sarrat, then to Paoay, before taking him by plane for the burial here at Libingan," he said.

Meanwhile, he has been coordinating with the AFP protocol and learned that aside from military honors – a 21-gun salute – and horseridden funeral cortege, they must conform with the tradition of burying the remains at exactly noon. Asked why Sept. 18 and not Sept. 11 or the birth anniversary of the elder Marcos, the former senator replied: "Because we want

another day to celebrate, and not only on his birth or death anniversary."

During the campaign, then Davao City mayor Duterte and former vice president Jejomar Binay replied "yes" to a question on whether they would allow the burial of former president Marcos at the Libingan.

Duterte praised Marcos as "the most brilliant president" that the Philippines ever had.

He lauded the Masagana 99 rice production program of the late president as trailblazing, among other long-range plans and programs that propelled the country to where it is now.

"Ang ganda ng patakbo nya, nasira lang ng asawa," the President said.

Though he did not name her, Duterte was obviously referring to Marcos' widow, former first lady Imelda Romualdez-Marcos, who has been reelected for a third and last term as representative of the second district of Ilocos Norte.

"I will allow the burial of President Marcos at the Libingan ng mga Bayani not because he is a hero. He was a Filipino soldier, period. That can be arranged immediately," Duterte said.



Dead Judge on the list

Duterte names 158 government officials as allegedly involved in the illegal drug trade. How accurate is this list?

TACLOBAN CITY — One of the alleged drug protectors named by President Rodrigo Duterte has long been dead.

Judge Roberto Navidad of Regional Trial Court 32 in Calbayog City, Samar was killed by a lone assailant on Jan. 15, 2008 inside his vehicle after he bought his medicines in Calbayog.

His family has not attained any justice for his death since the killer remains unidentified and at large.

Eight years later, his relatives were shocked last month, August 7, Sunday when Duterte named Navidad as a drug protector.

"That is a big lie. The reason why he was shot to death was because he fought with the drug lords in Calbayog City," said his nephew, Elias Navidad Acosta, who works as court sheriff at the Regional Trial Court-Branch 7 based in the city.

"He was my uncle. He was not a drug protector. He was a drug eliminator or a drug buster. That is why he was shot dead by these syndicates," Acosta said.

Acosta is sheriff of RTC Branch 7 in Tacloban where Navidad was presiding judge for 10 years before his transfer to RTC Branch 32 in

of rice available and visible in their menus."

At the time of its celebration, then Senator Ferdinand Marcos Jr. authored the Anti-Rice Wastage Act of 2013. It seeks to penalize those in the food industry that refuse to serve half rice orders to the customers. At the House of Representatives, Congressman Agapito Guanlao filed a counterpart bill to address food security. He proposed the Food and Food Staples Consumption and Zero Food-Wastage Management Act of 2013.

Taking off from the NYR celebration and supporting the bills filed in the Senate and the House of Representatives, the Be Riceponsible Campaign was launched to continue advocating for responsible and healthier rice consumption.

In 2014, the campaign urged LGUs to support rice consumption responsibility. General Santos City vice mayor Shirlyn Nograles zealously responded to the call of the national government.

"With the issues on rice shortage, importation, and the health of the consumers, we felt that initiatives to address these issues were direly needed," Nograles explained.

Nograles, together with councilor Brix Tan, chairperson of the Committee of Agriculture, co-authored an ordinance that instituted policies for responsible rice consumption in their city.

The legislators made sure that the ordinance was relevant. It compelled food stores to annually record their rice wastage for a week to continuously monitor the rice conservation status in the city.

Progress

According to the vice mayor, the food business sector responded positively. In fact, some food establishments, including that of Mangao's, immediately posted promotional materials given by the LGU.

However, Mangao said that the ordinance has had little impact in their restaurant. Based on their data, only one out of 10 customers

'Narco-congressman' named by Duterte never

a legislator

ILOILO CITY, Philippines — Jeffrey Celiz, who was erroneously identified by President Rodrigo Duterte as a "congressman, partylist, Panay chapter," has never been a legislator. He was former chairman and spokesperson of the Bagong Alyansang Makabayan in Panay before he left the militant group several years ago and served Iloilo City Mayor Jed Patrick Mabilog as his political consultant, spokesperson and executive assistant. Celiz said he ceased to hold any position at city hall starting February this year.

"It is very obvious that the information being fed to the President is unverified and short of being a rumor-mongering style," Celiz said in a statement.

He was earlier dragged into a controversy after an alleged log book of a gun club firing range in Iloilo City showed his name along with other suspected drug personalities. He has denied the allegations.

"Because of this raw and unverified information which the President made as a public pronouncement, my life and that of my family are now in grave and serious danger," he said.

If only his ex-girlfriends can see him now. After four kids and 25 years of marriage, Ariel Ureta is still happily attached to wife Boot (nee Roa, Boots Anson-Roa's niece) and their chil-

dren, aged 32, 30, 20 and 15.

He still gives women a second look, but not up to the point of asking them out just to prove that he's still got what it takes to win one girl after the other the way he did at the height of his popularity in the '70s. On weekends when he's free from his work as host of DZMM's Todo Todo Walang Preno with Winnie Cordero, Ariel is home, whipping up meals with Boot or driving his family around time.



Cyberporn goes mobile to evade authorities

CEBU CITY—Cyberporn operators have found a way of avoiding detection from law enforcers: mobile phones

An 18-year-old girl was caught using her mobile phone's webcam as her niece was posing nude for an American client who was online.

"Jamie" (not her real name) was arrested by National Bureau of Investigation members who raided her house in Barangay Cogon, Cordova town, Cebu past 2 p.m. on Saturday.

Also arrested was her mother-in-law "Nena" (not her real name) who was with four other minors in an adjacent house.

The five rescued minors were turned over to the Department of Social Welfare and Services for counseling.

The agents proceeded to the Mactan Economic Processing Zone in Lapu-Lapu City where they took into custody Jamie's 22-year-old live-in partner "Arnold" (not his real name).

Conspiracy

Arnold reportedly conspired with Jamie in running their cyberporn business at home.

The three will be charged with violations of Anti-Trafficking in Persons Act of 2003 and of the Cybercrime Prevention Act of 2012.

Two cellular phones—one owned by Jamie and the other by Nena—were confiscated by the NBI and would be subjected to forensic examination to secure possible evidence.

Lawyer Czar Eric Nuqui, head of the NBI-Anti Trafficking Division in Manila, said the suspects were using mobile phones in their cyber pornography operations so law enforcers would have a hard time going after them.

"Instead of using laptops or desktop computers which are apparent, they use mobile phones in cyber pornography operations," he said

"That scheme is actually new and is aimed at avoiding possible detection and for security precaution. Perpetrators know they could easily transfer from one location to another, making it hard for investigators to track their location," he added.

Online racket

Jamie, a mother of a one-year-old boy, started her cyberporn business last year when a foreigner whom she met in an online dating site, asked if she could pose naked and perform lewd acts.

She agreed and was paid P1,000.
Since then, she dealt with at least four other Americans who exploited her in an online pornography racket.

Upon the request of her foreign clients, Jamie asked her 10-year-old niece to pose naked in front of her cellular phone's webcam. "They wanted children aged 11 and

below. So I tapped my niece. I told her I will give her allowance for school. She agreed," she said.

Lawyer Augusto Isidoro, NBI Central Visayas assistant director, said they learned about Jaime's operation from United States' Department of Homeland Security.

"Some of her (Jamie) clients were already arrested in America. And the Homeland Security were able to trace the source of the pornographic materials recovered from the foreign suspects to Cebu," he told the Inquirer.

Isidoro said the Department of Homeland

Security forwarded all pieces of evidence that include the lewd photos and videos of the victims, to the Inter-Agency Council Against Trafficking and then to the NBI central office in Manila.

A poseur customer transacted with Jamie who accepted the request to have her niece perform lewd acts online in exchange for \$60.

The money was sent to a money transfer company in Cebu and was received by Jamie.



Widow of murdered drug user in 'Pieta' photo speaks up

The widow of an alleged drug user who was a victim of an extrajudicial killing in Manila on Jul 24 has finally spoken up about the viral photograph that showed her cradling her dead husband in her arms.

President Rodrigo Duterte had been dismissive of the photograph, which landed on the front page of the Philippine Daily Inquirer, and made available to international publications through wire agency Agence France Presse, during his State of the Nation Address.

He called it "melodramatic" and accused Inquirer of deliberately making it appear like the image of Virgin Mary carrying the body of Jesus Christ after his crucifixion.

Speaking to Inquirer, the widow, Jennilyn Olayres, acknowledged that her late husband, Michael Siaron, was a drug user, but not a dealer. She also said that her husband voted for Duterte.

The couple lived in a shack in the rundown part of Pasay City, the report said.

When a friend told Olayres that her husband, a pedicab driver, had been shot, she ran barefoot to Taft Avenue.

"Recalling the moment she found her husband's body, she said she thought he was just hit by a stray bullet and could still be alive. But he was dead. When I was cradling him, I was thinking, 'How long have you been lying here?' Nobody bothered to help him. I was furious," said the report.

Meanwhile, Senator Ping Lacson disagreed with the way Duterte handled the situation. He said the president should have ordered a thorough investigation instead.

order half rice, in addition to their full cup of rice.

"Right now we're taking baby steps [to make a] gradual impact. It's an advocacy worth pushing. We believe this remains relevant and we need to think of its long-term benefits," said vice mayor Nograles.

Nograles added that intensifying the campaign is their top priority. "The value of rice conservation should enter the consciousness of the consumers. Only then can we see changes in their eating lifestyles," she said.

Local legislators are looking at tapping schools to raise awareness and involve students. One activity planned is a poster making contest.

"These posters may be used by the food establishments in their respective stores. We can also put other collaterals such as stickers so they can paste it on their menu boards," said Ronan Villagonzalo, who works as a legislative assistant of councilor Tan.

The legislators also want to mandate the posting of information materials as a prerequisite for securing business permits and licenses in the local food service industry.

Creating synergy

Today, there are over 40 LGUs who have already passed ordinances mandating the offering of the half rice option.

The Be Riceponsible campaign is taking huge strides for healthier and food secure Filipino communities, including advocating for the consumption of healthier rice, specifically brown rice.

"We are now tapping major fast food chains to support our advocacies. In this way, downscaling a directive to their branches across the country can expedite its implementation," said Hazel Antonio, campaign director.

Antonio added that they are partnering with other policymakers, meeting with hotel and restaurant owners, and promoting the campaign at various food festivals.

The elusive goal of achieving rice self-sufficiency is every Filipino's riceponsibility. With strong political will, multi-stakeholder collaboration, and responsible rice production, consumption, and conservation, we'll surely get far and reach the finish line. Only then can we achieve a rice secure Philippines.
